AT SIX FORTYFIVE P.M., COT, INSTANT AN ANONYMOUS PHONE CALL WAS RECEIVED AT THE OMAHA WORLD HERALD NEWPAPER, OMAHA, NEBRASKA ALLEGING THAT A BOMB WAS PLACED AT THE CAMPAIGN HEADQUARTERS OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

THE OMAHA POLICE DEPARTMENT WAS IMMEDIATELY CONTACTED AND A THOROUGH SEARCH WAS CONDUCTED BY OMAHA POLICE OFFICERS ASSISTED BY MEMBERS OF SENATOR KENNEDY'S STAFF AT BOTH THE SHERATON-FONTENELL HOTEL, WHERE SENATOR KENNEDY SPENT THE DAY AND AT THE KENNEDY CAMPAIGN HEADQUARTERS BUILDING LOCATED AT THREE ONE FIVE SOUTH SIXIEENTH STREET, OMAHA. COMPLETE SEARCH OF HOTEL ROOMS REC'D DE LUAL AVAILABLE TO DE KENNEDY PARTY INCLUDING ROOM NUMBER SEVEN ONE SEVEN INWHICH SENATOR KENNEDY WAS BOOKED, FAILED TO REVEAL ANY

EXPLOSIVE DEVICES.
