

Because of background is potentially dangerous; or has been identified as member or participant in communist movement; or has been under active investigation as member of other group or organization inimical to U.S. 4. U.S. citizens or residents who defect from the U.S. to countries in the Soviet or Chinese Communist blocs and return. 5. Subversives, ultrarightists, racists and fascists who meet one or more of the following criteria: (a) Devidence of emotional instability (including unstable residence and employment record) or irrational or suicidal behavior: (b) Expressions of strong or violent anti-U. S. sentiment; (c) Prior acts (including arrests or convictions) or conduct or statements indicating a propensity for violence and antipathy toward good order and government. 6.
