PRESS WITH RESPECT TO THE QUESTION OF FBI JURISDICTION.
EXCEPT THAT THE FBI IS RENDERING ASSISTANCE AS INDICATED ABOVE.

Supervisor TED RUSHING, Division 5, called at 8:58 AM today and requested that all sources be alerted immediately for any plans of extremists to foment violence occasioned by the attempted assassination. RUSHING requested that I call the following offices and have them alerted to the above.

I called ASAC MOORE in Dallas and advised him of the above and requested he call El Paso, Albuquerque, and San Antonio and alert them. I also called the SAC in Denver and requested that he advise the SAC in Phoenix. I also called the SAC in Oklahoma City and requested he advise Little Rock. Houston headquarters agents are handling today.

For the information of the RA's, the FBI is rendering all possible investigative assistance to local authorities, including services of the laboratory and Identification Division. If you receive any information concerning this matter, Bureau and Los Angeles should be expeditiously advised and all necessary investigation immediately initiated. No comment should be made to the press with respect to the question of FBI jurisdiction except that the FBI is rendering assistance as indicated above.

As of 11:30 AM the assailant has not been identified.

STEVE HODGES, Port Arthur, Texas, telephone YUkon 5-5154, called this morning and advised that he was in the Moulin Rouge in Market Square, Houston, Texas, about 6 to 8 weeks ago and met an individual at the bar who made the statement during conversation that "We took care of his brother and we will take care of ROBERT KENNEDY." During the conversation, this individual insinuated that he was associated with the Mafia. HODGES stated he does not know the man's name but the man indicated that he owns a booking agency and books entertainers, and he was at that time the agent for BILL HALEY and the Comets. HODGES described this man as a white male, 40-45, medium height and build, full head of hair, almost kinky, well dressed, Italian appearing, good looking, flashy dresser, was wearing a large diamond ring, and had a hoodlum-type personality. The man appeared to be acquainted with the bartender. HODGES stated the above events occurred in the afternoon, possibly around 3 or 4 o'clock.

HODGES reported this in view of the recent attempt on Senator KENNEDY's life.

An anonymous female caller called this morning and advised she was a resident at the Community House, 3703 Fannin, Houston, in September, 1967, during which time an individual known only as PETER stayed at the Community House for a short period of time. She stated PETER resembles the man who shot Senator KENNEDY. She stated PETER was traveling with a male companion and only stayed a short time at the Community House. She stated they left for California she believes around September 15. She recalled that they appeared to be from New York, as she remembers the two of them discussing New York politics. She described PETER in his 20's, medium height, small build on the thin side, dark complexion, possibly Cuban, and spoke with a slight Cuban accent.

At 12:25 p.m., today, ASAC DON MOORE, Dallas, called and advised that Dallas had received information from one ROBERT HOWARD, pilot for Braniff Airlines, who stated that he had seen a picture of the assassin on television and is of the opinion this individual resembles a person he saw at Houston International Airport last night at about 9 p.m. HOWARD stated that this individual claimed to have a ticket on National Airlines for Los Angeles and was inquiring as to the location of the National Airlines office. HOWARD stated this person was observed in the duty free store located in the terminal which handles liquor and other items. He described this individual as wearing a beige suit, white shirt, no tie, and had a slight accent, possibly Latin American or some other foreign country. He was a white male, 32 to 35 years of age, 5'4" to 5'5".

MOORE stated he was telephoning the Bureau and Los Angeles regarding this information, and would advise this office as to what action is recommended. He stated he would call this office as soon as this had been determined.

At 1:10 p.m., MOORE called and stated that he was sending us a teletype setting out certain leads to be covered by this office.

1. Interview person or persons in the liquor store at the airport and try to corroborate the pilot's story.

2. Check all National Airlines flights departing Houston after 9 p.m., which would arrive in Los Angeles prior to the assassination attempt. It is suggested that the manifests of these flights also be checked, since they would be possibly needed in the future.

In regard to this latter lead, MOORE advised that the ASAC in Los Angeles had advised him that they had possibly identified the assassin and that this person's name had already been broadcasted over the radio, however, the Bureau was not putting out this name at this time. This person's name is reported to be SIRHAN/SIRHAN, a native of Jerusalem. He stated that under no circumstances should any open inquiry be made regarding the above name. However, that in checking the manifests, if available, we could just note whether or not this name appears on any manifests of flights to Los Angeles.

The above information was immediately furnished to SA WHATLEY and he was instructed to institute this investigation at once.

A nation shocked, grieved and shamed by the second murder of a high-ranking political figure in less than five years does not recover quickly from that shock, grief and shame. It is all the worse, of course, in that the two men were brothers; one a President, the other a major candidate for his party's nomination for President.

The nation has demonstrated in unmistakable manner its grief and its sympathy for the Kennedy family. Only an infinitesimal minority of Americans, surely, could fail to have experienced those sentiments. And only a minute minority of Americans, we are convinced, could entertain the thought of coldly planning political assassination.

We have heard and read a flood of accusations against our people in the past several days. One might think, to hear some who are reputed to be versed in psychology, philosophy, and even religion, that the American people are prone to violence; that "we, the people" are to blame for these assassinations.

To all who might be influenced by such charges, we wish to point out that neither of the young men who are said to have slain President Kennedy and Senator Kennedy is or was typical of Americans.

Lee Harvey Oswald was a communist who renounced his American citizenship to live for a time in Russia. Returning, he was active in communist causes including the Fair Play For Cuba (Castro) Committee.

Sirhan B. Sirhan is a Jordanian by birth, a fanatic whose notebook shows him to be pro-communist.

Anything but the typical American, both of them.

In regard to the interview requested with DOYLE TRUMAN CHANEY as set forth in referenced communication, the following is noted:

On June 17, 1968, the Houston Office opened an impersonation case on CHANEY based upon telephone call to the Houston Office from the Galveston, Texas, Police Department early morning of 6-17-68, in which CHANEY was arrested by Galveston Police Department, 6-17-68, on a charge of drunk and it was alleged CHANEY claimed he was an FBI Agent and working on the KENNEDY assassination.

The following investigation was conducted by SA CARLOS L. KIRBY, JR., at Galveston, Texas:

On June 17, 1968, Sergeant ANTHONY SOLANDO, Galveston Police Department, advised that in the early morning of June 17, 1968, DOYLE TRUMAN CHANEY, while driving in Galveston, stopped a Galveston

Police Officer and requested that a vehicle he was allegedly was following be stopped. He stated CHANEY appeared to be drunk and was arrested and transported to the Galveston Police Station. SOLANDO advised he interviewed CHANEY and that CHANEY claimed he was working with the FBI in connection with the KENNEDY assassination and had been following a car, license number unknown to CHANEY. SOLANDO stated in his opinion, CHANEY was definitely drunk when arrested and furthermore from his interview and observations, he believed CHANEY to be a "nut." He advised the drunk charge against CHANEY was dismissed.

CHANEY was interviewed on June 17, 1968, by SA CARLOS L. KIRBY, JR., and furnished the following information:

He advised that he resides at Route 8, Box 860, Houston, Texas, and is employed as a maintenance employee at Childers Manufacturing Co., Houston. He stated on 6-16-68, at about 11:30 pm, he was at the Texan Drive-In located on Hempstead Highway, Houston, Texas, when he observed a white Ford station wagon, bearing California license number unknown, parked at a telephone booth near the drive-in. He stated there were two males and 1 female occupants in the vehicle. He advised that it was dark and he does not know their race. He stated that he overheard some of their conversation and one of the male occupants remarked to the driver of the vehicle that "if you don't drive me to Vinton, Louisiana, I'll bring up that California thing." He stated the vehicle then departed from the drive-in and advised that since the vehicle bore California license, he thought it might have something to do with the KENNEDY assassination. He advised that he then followed this vehicle in his car, hoping that he would observe a police officer and continued following the car through Houston on Highway 75 to Galveston, Texas, arriving in Galveston at about 1:30 a.m. on June 17, 1968. He

advised that he did not get close enough to the car to obtain the license number, claiming that he was afraid. He stated upon arriving in Galveston, he observed and stopped a police officer and told the officer to "stop that car, I have been following it." He stated the officer then took him to the Galveston Police Station and charged him with being drunk. He advised that he was not drunk to his knowledge, but had been drinking four or five beers. He stated that he definitely did not at any time claim that he was an FBI Agent and the only thing he told the officers was that he was trying to contact the FBI. He further advised that he is not an employee of the FBI or any other branch of the U.S. Government and has never been an FBI employee. CHANEY stated he had no further information concerning the occupants of the white station wagon, heard no remarks regarding the KENNEDY assassination and that he only assumed that they may have been associated with it. He stated he told the same story to the Judge at the Corporation Court at Galveston and the drunk charge was dismissed.

AUSA RONALD J. BLASK, Houston, Texas, declined prosecution concerning the impersonation matter, stating no violation of the impersonation statute.
