on 5/20/68, this SKYMOUR SLOBODKIN called the MYO and said that he is employed at the Blue Fountain Restaurant, 68-01 Rockaway Beach Boulevard, Jamaica, MY, and that he is affiliated with an organization which is setting up vocational and training institutes for school dropouts among others in ghetto areas, and he had devised an approach to people in ghetto areas which he thought would be helpful to agents of the FBI on their investigations.

on 6/12/68, SLOBODKIN called the agent who he spoke with previously and told the agent that he, (SLOBODKIN), was attempting to purchase some batteries in a radio shop and wished the agent to vouch for his credit telephonically to the owner of the shop. The agent refused.

During the early morning hours of 6/13/68, Patrolman KLATZ, 100th Precinct, NYCPD, advised that he then had SLOBODKIN in the Psychiatric Ward of Elmhurst General Hospital for observation based on SLOBODKIN's purported observation of a submarine in Jamaica Bay, NYC

On 8/20/68, the film of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY 5 Cal1fornia campaign which was used on the WALTER CRONKITE Show 6/3/68, was reviewed at CBS, NYC, by SA JAMES P. O'NEIL.

There was no portion of this film in which Senator KENNEDY was standing on a truck or in which an incident similar to that described by MOORE occurred.

However, a "syndicated piece", that is a film clip, distributed 6/3/68 to CES affiliates but not shown on the national network and definitely not on the CRONKITE Show, does show Senator KENNEDY on a truck in a Chinatown District, probably San Prancisco on or about 6/2/68. In this clip, Sanator KENNEDY is shaking the hands of persons standing along the street and pressing up to the truck, and several explosions such as fire crackers can be heard on the soundtrack. However, no one visible is pointing any object at Senator KENNEDY.

SUBJECT: Report on Rumor About Robert Kennedy Being Shot

- 1. This office has been informed of a rumor similar to that reported in our out teletype number 06680 of 8 June 1968.
- 2. On 23 July 1968 our representative in Mogadiscio, Somalia, was contacted (but not deliberately sought out) by a Mr. J. Christian Kinney, a United States citizen, who volunteered information about a rumor of Robert Kennedy having been shot. Mr. Kinney reported that on 18 May 1968 he stopped in Beirut, Lebanon, while enroute to Mogadiscio, with his wife and child. On the evening of May 18th he entered the Phoenicia Bar, Phoenicia Hotel, Beirut, about one-half hour before closing time. This was either 2130 or 2230 hours according to Mr. Kinney. At the bar Mr. Kinney struck up a casual conversation with a Mr. Joseph Strong, a United States citi-During the conversation Mr. Strong inquired if Mr. Kinney had heard that Robert Kennedy had been shot. Mr. Kinney replied that he had not, and Mr. Strong said that he had heard this just before coming to the bar from a man he did not identify. Mr. Kinney and Mr. Strong reportedly felt that if this were true it would appear in the newspapers the next day, which, of course, it did not.
- 3. On 19 May Mr. Kinney left Beirut for Jidda, Saudi Arabia, where his company has business. He questioned some of his colleagues in Jidda whether they had heard a story about Robert Kennedy having been shot. The colleagues disclaimed having heard this so Mr. Kinney attributed the story to being a "typical Middle East coffee house rumor", and fore got about it. Mr. Kinney also met Mr. Strong in Jidda during the week of 19 May, and no mention was made by either party about the rumor that Robert Kennedy had been shot.

4. According to our representative in Mogadiscio Mr.

J. Christian Kinney is employed as a consultant by the Middle West Service Company, 69 West Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois. He presently is assigned to Mogadiscio as the chief consultant to the Mogadiscio Water Agency on a United States

Agency for International Development (USAID) project. Mr. Kinney is described as being a bright, pleasant, young man in his early thirties who appears to know his business, and is well thought of by USAID officials in Mogadiscio. His wife is reported to be Ecuadorian, and they have one child.

- 5. The files of this office contain no identifiable information on J. Christian Kinney. Our representative in Mogadiscio reports that Mr. Kinney presently is undergoing a security check for the purpose of permitting him to have access to "need-to-know" classified information in connection with the USAID Mogadiscio water project. It is possible, therefore, that USAID Washington may have information on Mr. Kinney.
- 6. Our representative in Mogadiscio reports that Mr. Kinney described Mr. Joseph Strong as being the Middle East Sales Manager for Raytheon. According to Mr. Kinney, Mr. Strong is based in New York and travels to his sales territory several times a year. It is possible that Mr. Strong may be identical with Joseph Addington Strong who was born on 5 October 1911 at Chattanooga, Tennessee. According to information dated mid-1967 Joseph Addington Strong resided at 743 Wellesley Street, Weston, Massachusetts. He was employed by the Raytheon Company, Wayland, Massachusetts, as International Sales and Projects Manager, Surface Radar and Navigation Operation. He has been employed by Raytheon since 1950.
- 7. This office conducted national agency checks on Joseph Addington Strong in 1964. The checks included the Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI); Department of State, Passport Section; House Committee on Un-American Activities; and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The checks developed no unfavorable information. In 1962 ONI completed a favorable background investigation on Strong. The investigation was predicated on his civilian duties in a contract capacity.



KENNEDY, said it looked like one of the shots taken of Senator KENNEDY at the Los Angeles International Airport sometime in March, 1968, shortly after Senator KENNEDY announced he would run for President.

KENNEDY was returning to los Angeles on a charter plane from San Francisco which stopped several places in Central California. The arrival time was around mid-day or early afternoon. He did not recall the name of the air line or the terminal where Senator KENNEDY came in: KENNEDY usually chartered through American Airlines. There was a large group of fans who met KENNEDY at the time. If an organized group was present SCHAPIRO did not recall any names. The young man in question who is pictured about to attempt to shake hands with Senator KENNEDY was not known to SCHAPIRO and in the opinion of SCHAPIRO, based on study of photograph of SIRHAN SIRHAN, was definitely not SIRHAN SIRHAN.

WILLIAM BARRY, KENNEDY Party aid was the only person recognized in the photograph besides KENNEDY. SCHAPIRO said he expected to be in Los Angeles about a week and while here could be contacted through SALLY POWERS, 1221 North Genesee Avenue, Number 654-2883 or at her employment Screen Gems Inc. where she heads the new talent department phone HO 6-3141.





> On 8/8/68,\STEPHEN ALTHEIM, case worker, Queens Welfard center, 30-20 Northern Boulevard, telephone 830-8256, telephonically contacted the NYO and advised as follows.

ALTHEIM stated that he has a client, MARGARITA HASSAN, who is the wife of DAQUD ABDALLA HASSAN. He stated that, HASSAN, who is approximately 35 years of age, was born in Jordan, immigrated to Columbia in 1960, subsequently married MARGARITA, and lived in Bogeta, Columbia, until 1964. In 1964 they moved to the United States, port of entry, Miami, Florida, arriving 8/14/64. Mrs. HASSANS alien registration receipt card reflects . She stated that they subsequently flew to San Francisco and took up residence with a cousin of HASSAN'S, ALI MAHOOD (PHONETIC), who lived on Hampshire St. Shortly after arriving in the U.S., HASSAN advised his wife that he wished to get a divorce and that the only reason me had married her was to get to the U.S. Apparently HASSAN'S cousin had also come from Jordan to Columbia, subsequently married a Columbian girl, immigrated to the U.S. and divorced her. HASSAN persisted in his desire for a divorce and in June, 1968, just prior to the Kennedy assasination, abandoned his wife, and has not been seen to date.

Mrs. HASSAN advised ALTHEIM that during the period of her residence with HASSAN, she never met any of his friends and further stated that he was gone most of the time at some kind of meetings. ALTHEIM has theorized that because of the disappearance and the fact that HASSAN is Jordanian, ne may have some conncection with the Kennedy assasination.

Mrs. HASSAN also advised ALTHEIM, that: while in San Francisco, HASSAN worked for his cousin, at Ali's Grocery Store, on Mission. She further stated that they had a residence at 1270-B Hampshire St. from 1964-1966, and 1039 Hampshire St., from 1966-1968.

# Sirhan Wants To Air His Anti-Zionist Views

By GEORGE LARDNER JR.

WASHINGTON—Sirhan Sirhan intends to "go to the gas chamber—silent" unless he is permitted to turn his trial into an anti-Zionist forum, Ramparts magazine says.

The accused assassin of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy has told one of his brothers that he wants to make the trial "a public and political forum for the Arab position," the magazine says in an article in its current issue.

"In fact," the story continues, "he has confided to his family that he will never make any statement unless special provi-

The article, in the magazine's Sept. 7 issue, was written by Mahmoud Abdel-Hadi, an Egyptian correspondent for Akhbar Elyoum. As an Arab, he was said to have secured exclusive interviews with members of the 24-year-old suspect's family.

### He Told His Brother

According to the article, Sirhan told his brother, Adel, that unless he gets his way, "then I shall go to the ges chamber—silent."

But if he gets his forum, Abdel Hadi reports, Sirhan and his attorney, Russell Parsons, plan to argue that the shooting of Robert Kennedy was "a political gesture and that Kennedy to Sirhan was merely a symbol."

The startling claim, a virtual justification, for assassination, also happens to be what many Arab and Arab American spokesmen have been pressing as a thesis since Kennedy's death June 6. Baldly put, it blames "Zionism" rather than Sirhan for the killing. And it sees the trail as a golden opportunity to present the Arab case.

The Ramparts story maintains that Sirhan's strategy is "his own . . . something he developed after thinking about it for long hours in his specially made jail cell."

#### He Was Bitter

Sirhans family, Abdel-Hadi writes, is confused and bitter; surprised that they have not gotten any financial help from Arab consulates in Los Angeles. The suspect himself is described as disappointed that the Arab people have not greeted him as a hero.

"Everything in this country was pushing him to the danger point," Sirhan's mother, Mary,

reportedly said. "Everything, the propaganda of the Zionists, everything was against his country, against his people."

Adel is quoted again: "In Sirhan was just an assassin, he could have done it another way, just by having a gun with a telescope. He went to the Ambassador Hotel expecting to get caught; that is why he left his notes at home. I believe that Sirhan wanted to get caught so that he could say what he believes."

In the back, with Senator KENNEDY, was his wife, ETHEL KENNEDY; his sister, JEAN SMITH; FRED DUTTON; and one ambulance attendant. FRED DUTTON was in the back, up front near the partition in back of the driver which would be at Senator KENNEDY's feet.

BARRY does not recall the exact location of the others in the back other than ETHEL KENNEDY and JEAN SMITH were near Senator KENNEDY.
