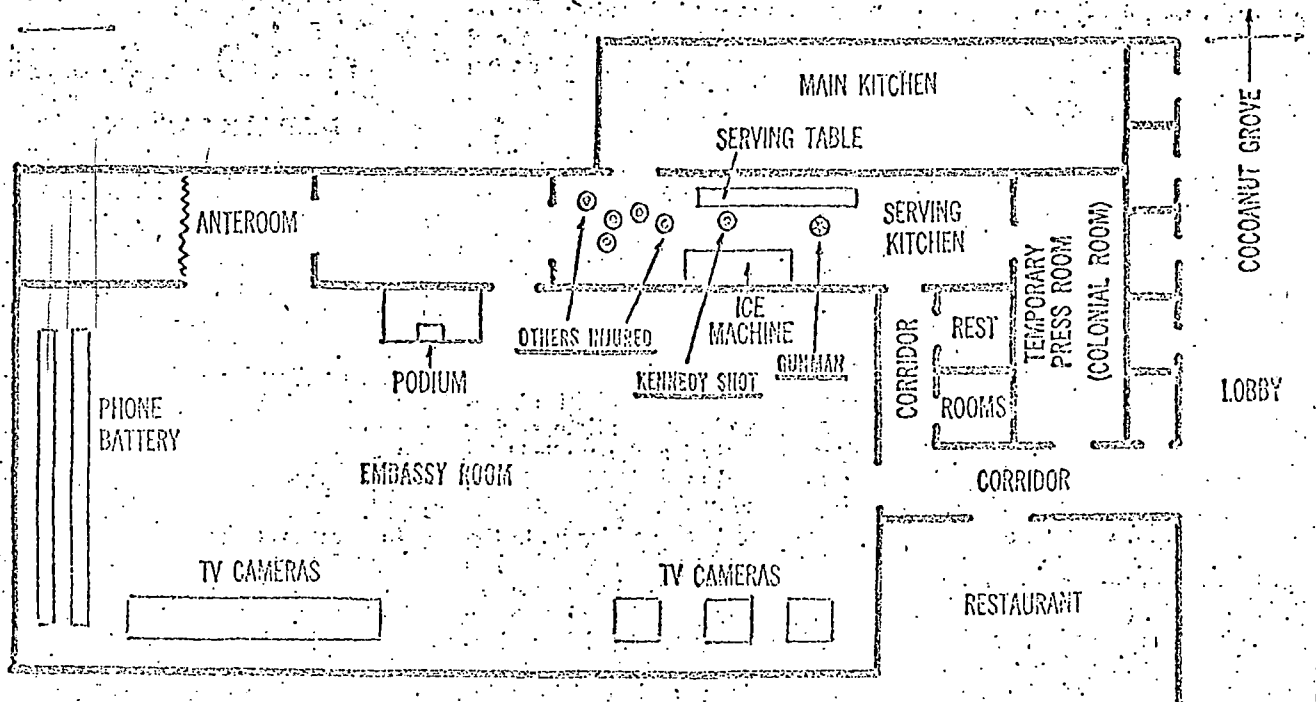


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

At the time of the Kennedy campaign Miss Horenstein worked for the advertising firm of ~~Kxxx~~ Papert, Lois & Koenig which was doing the advertising for Kennedy in California. Their office is located in NYC PH#935-5000.

Miss Horenstein went to the hotel with Barbara Barnett (No interview. Doesn't know how she can be contacted except possibly through Rockefeller campaign headquarters in N.Y.C.). She arrived at the hotel at approximately 8PM and went directly to the Embassy Room. At the time of the speech she was standing about 30' back from the right portion of the stage. After the speech she went to exit through the double doors of the Embassy Room when she heard many screams and people saying that Kennedy Had Been shot.

She does not recall seeing Sirhan or any woman in a polka-dot dress. She did not have a camera and doesn't know of anyone that did.

She has not been contacted by the news media or the F.B.I.

Miss Horenstein is presently unemployed and living with a friend in NY. No permanent address as of yet.

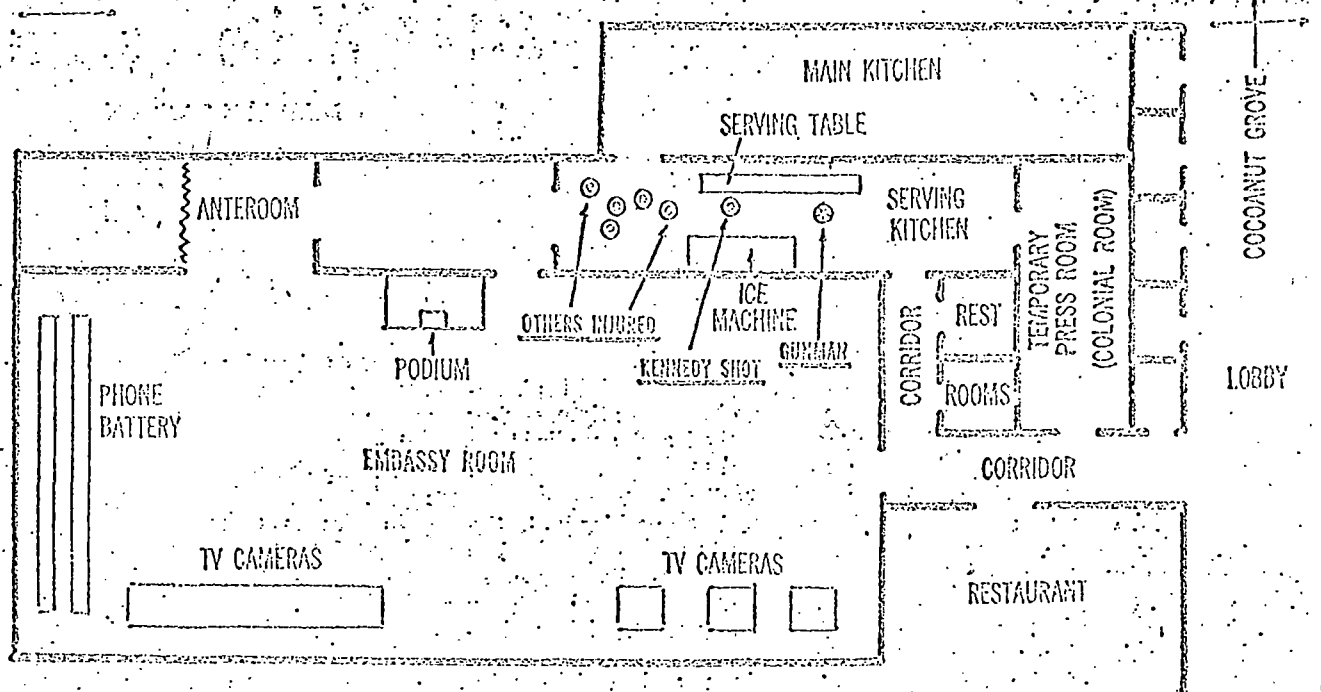


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

She stated that there is a frequent turn-over of residents at 878 East 180th Street and she knows no one who was living here in 1957.

IRA LEEMAN, Attorney, 850 East 180th Street, stated that 878 East 180th Street, was owned by him for forty years up until a few months ago. He reviewed his records and has no record of a RAMISTELLA family at 878 East 180th Street. He does not recall an occupant by that name.

Mr. LOUIS J. REILLY, 775 Garden Street, Bronx, New York, stated that he does not know of RAMISTELLA and knows of no one at this address who would as there is a frequent turn-over of occupants at 775 Garden Street.

Re memo of SA EDWARD P. HOUGHTON to SAC, Pittsburgh dated 7/20/68, Pittsburgh file 100-15042, subject of which is the DCA.

New York received a copy of referenced memorandum for the file of JARVIS TYNER. Briefly, it is to be noted that TYNER, when appearing at a DCA meeting in Pittsburgh on 7/19/68, apparently made the comment that the DCA is planning to go ahead with its law suit against Mayor SAM YORTY of Los Angeles.

It appears likely that JARVIS made reference to a law suit which had been promised to be filed by the DCA against Mayor YORTY for comments he made in Los Angeles concerning the DCA. Mayor YORTY, after allegedly reviewing a notebook supposedly owned by SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, the alleged assassin of Senator ROBERT KENNEDY, claimed that the notebook linked SIRHAN closely with the DCA. Local members of the Communist Party (CP) youth in Los Angeles immediately denied any relationship of the DCA with SIRHAN.

On 9/5/68, SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, JR. contacted RONALD J. ELLENSOHN, the Administrative Assistant to Mayor SAM YORTY, on an extremely confidential basis and was advised that no suit has been filed against Mayor YORTY concerning the above comments. 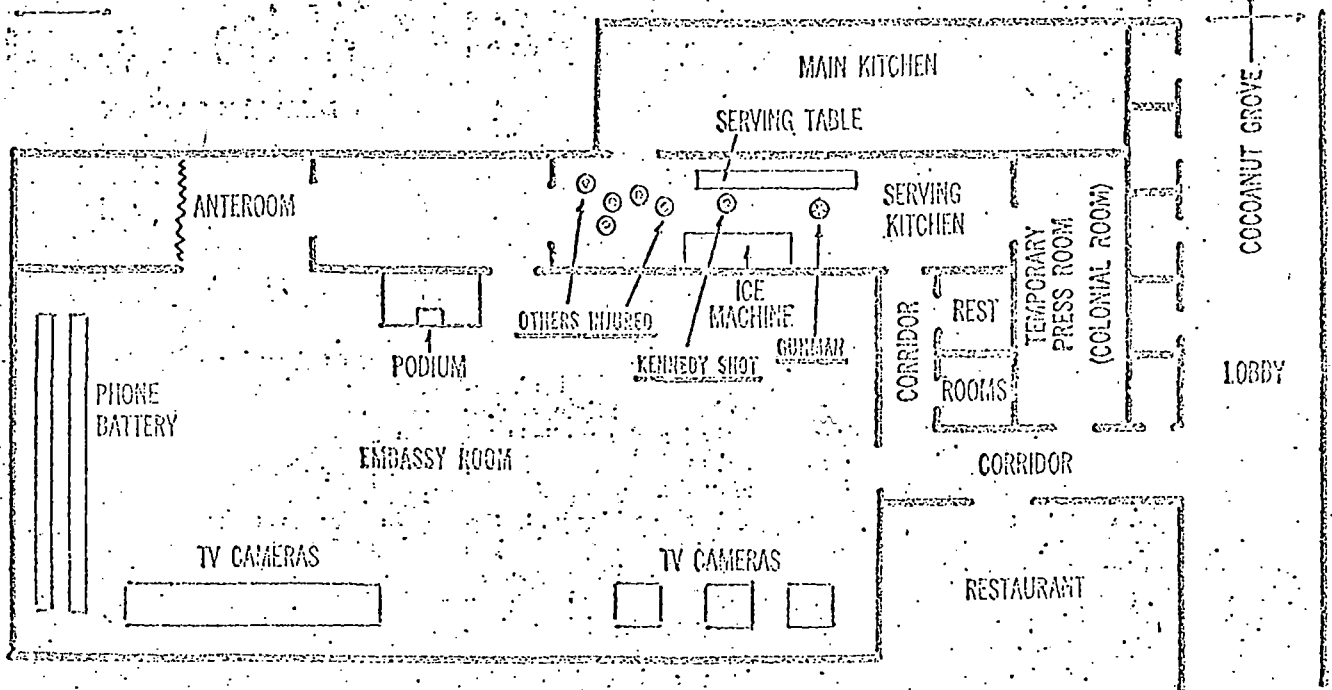


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

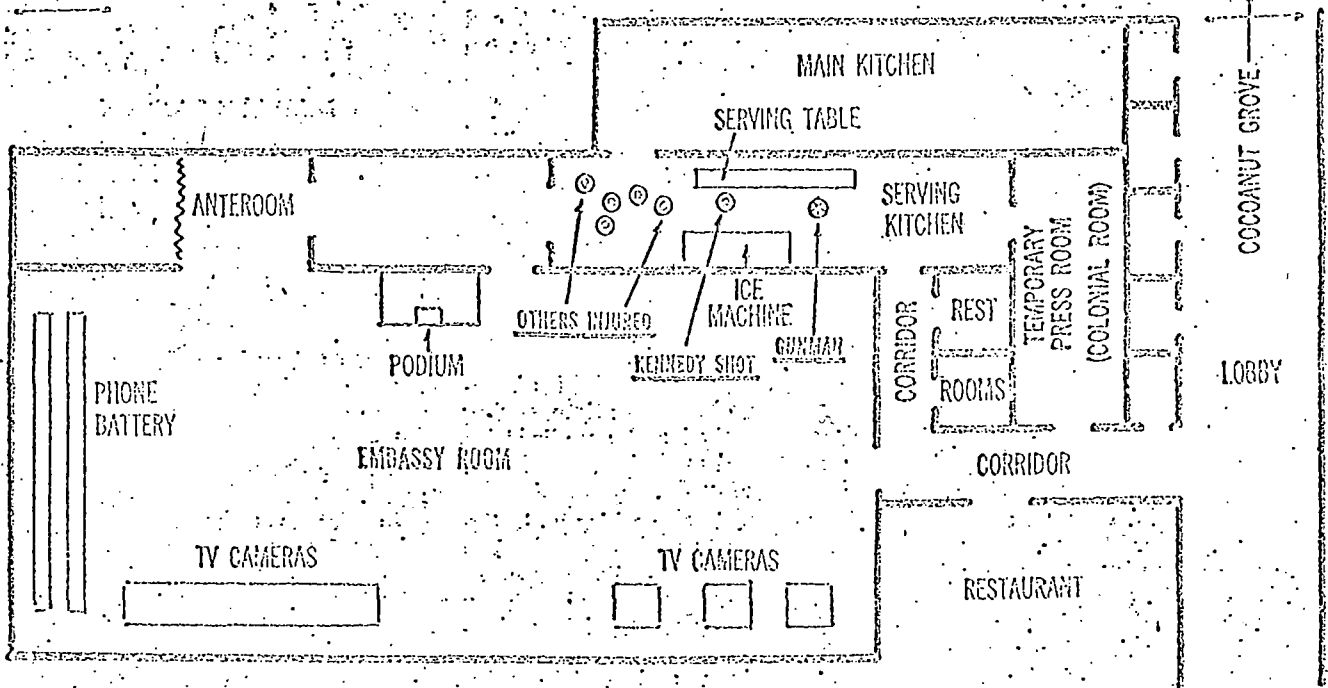


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

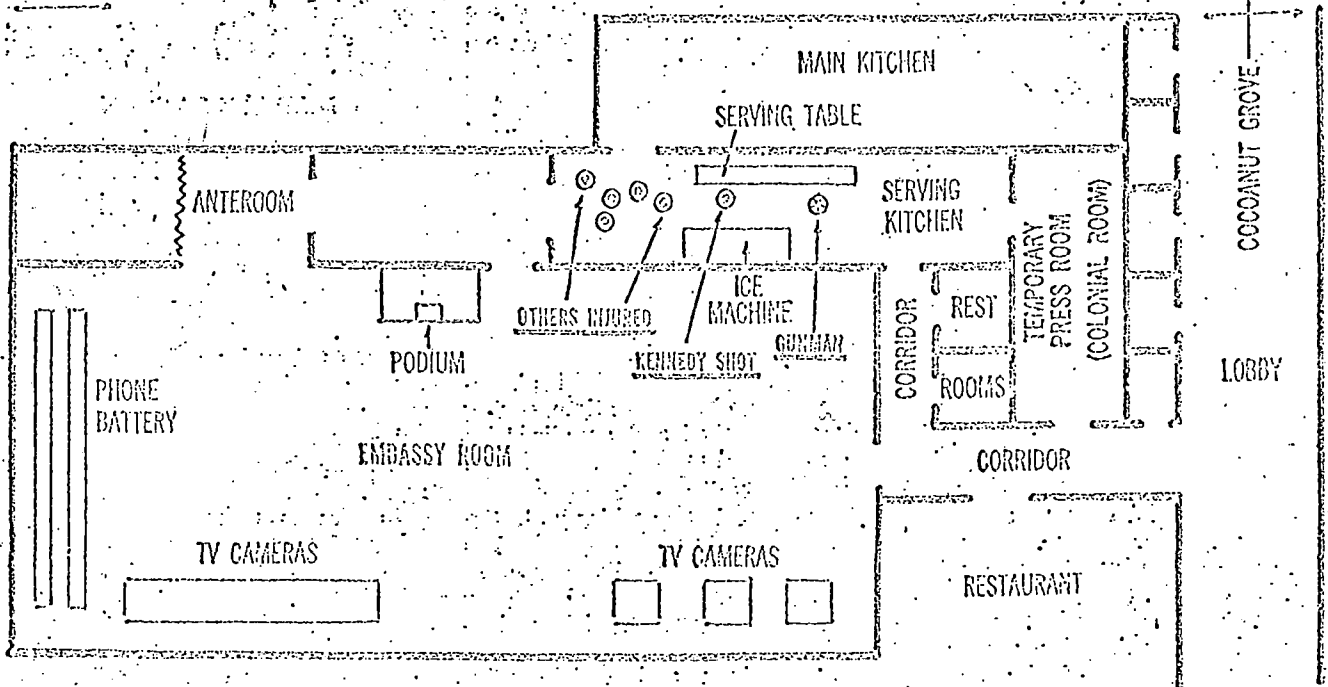


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

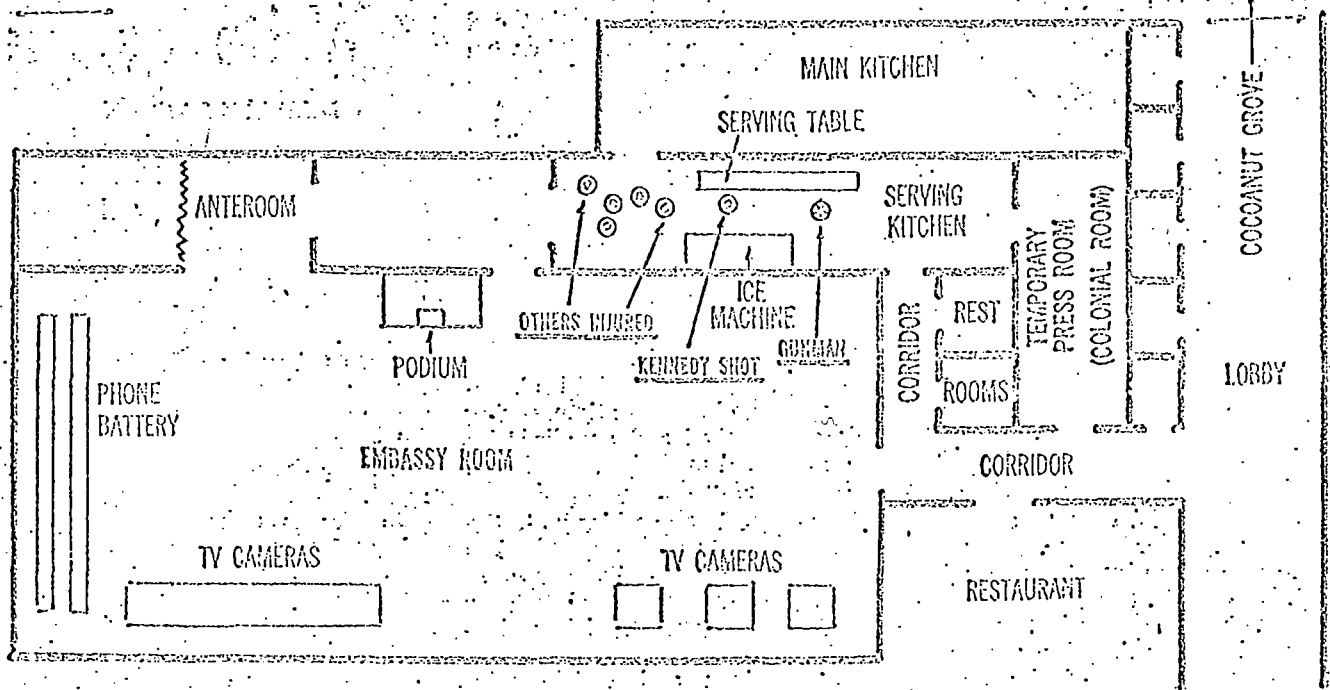


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy
