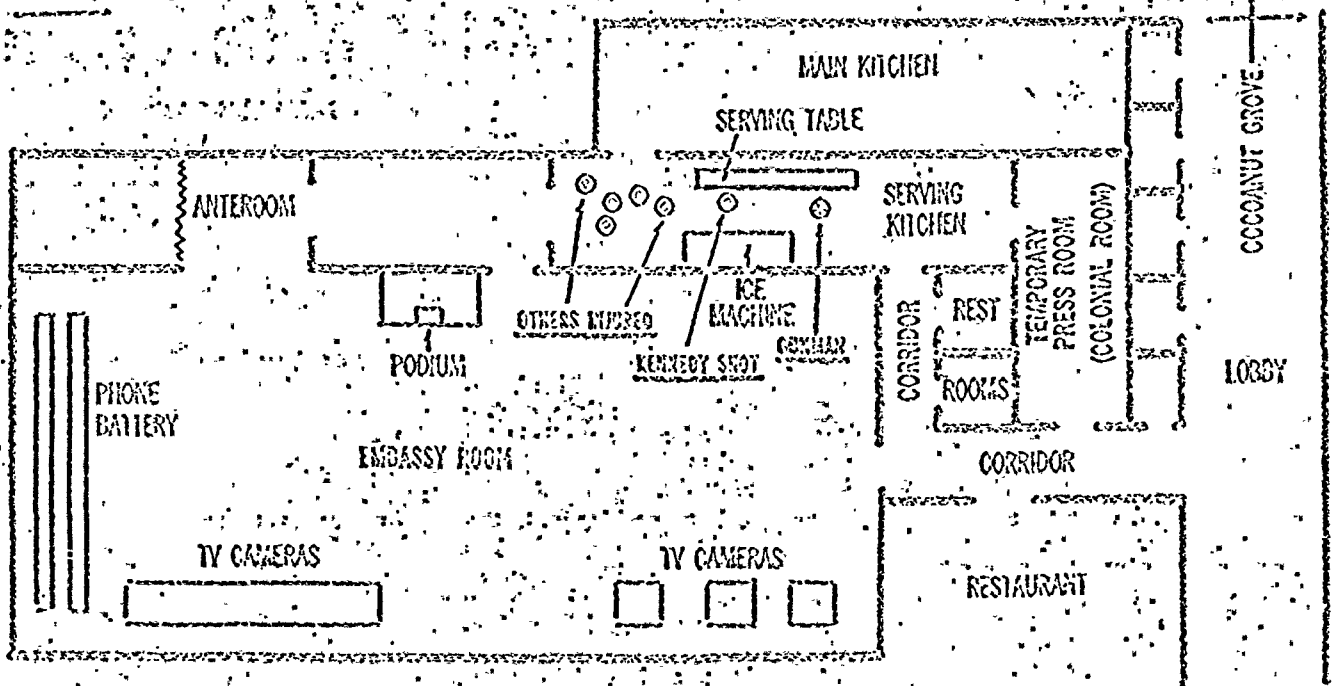


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

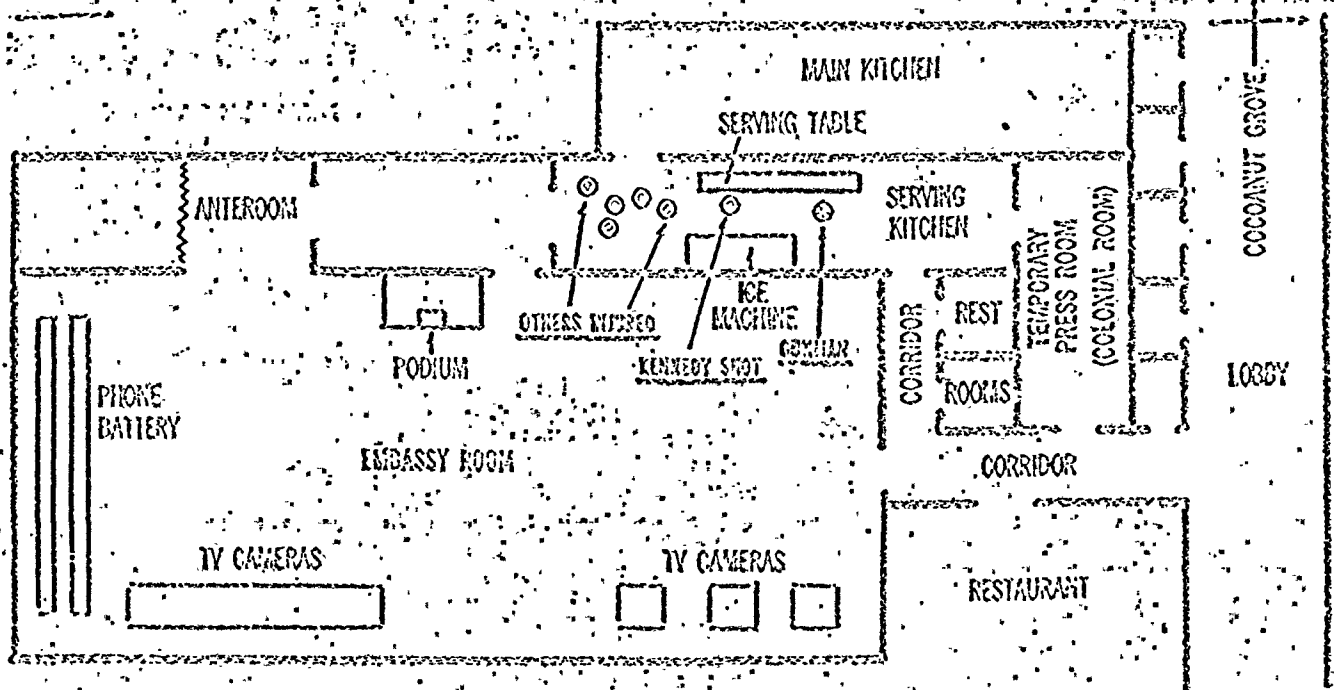


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

Mr. Loudon S. Wainwright, writer for Life Magazine, Time and Life Building, 50th Street and 6th Avenue, New York, New York, stated that during the evening of June 4-5, 1968 he was in the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California covering the Senator Robert Kennedy Presidential campaign.

At the time of the shooting, he was in his room in the hotel writing his story, and heard of the shooting on television. Wainwright went downstairs in the hotel to the area of the shooting. When he arrived, Senator Kennedy had been taken to the hospital.

Wainwright did not see or hear the shooting and did not see Sirhan Sirhan. He knows nothing to the shooting.

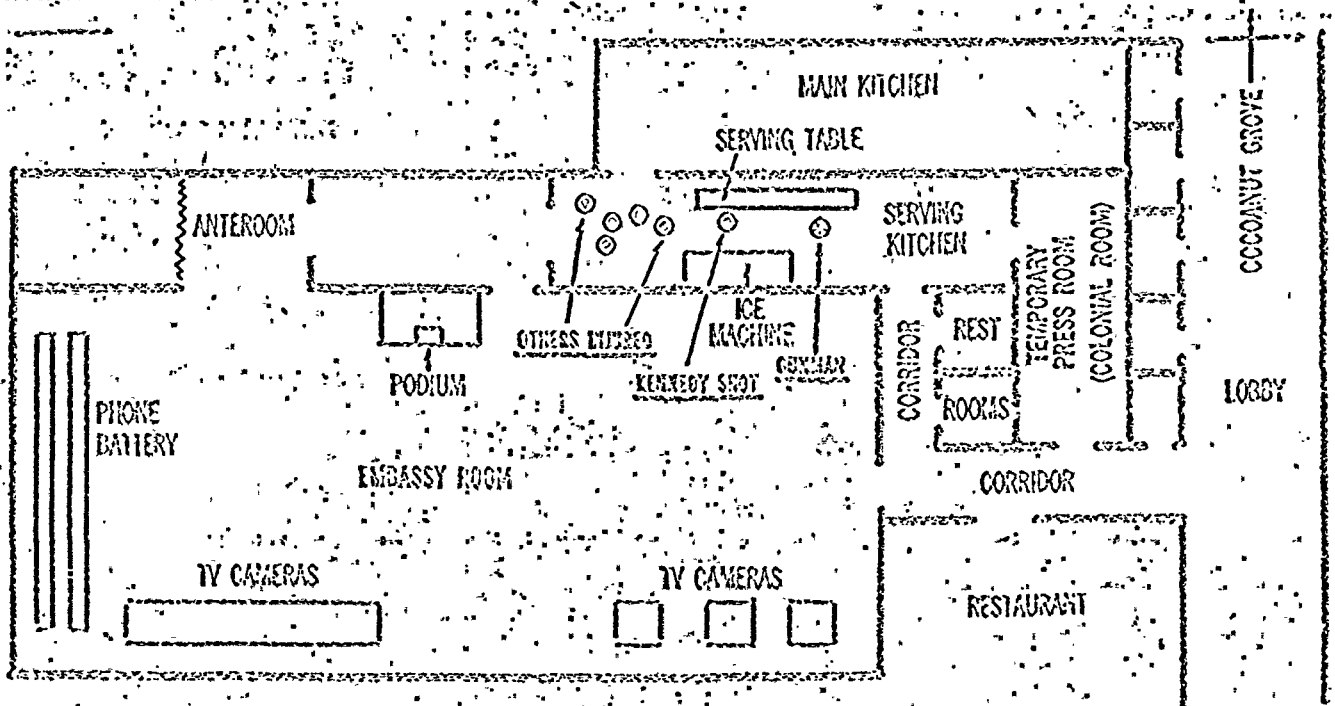


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

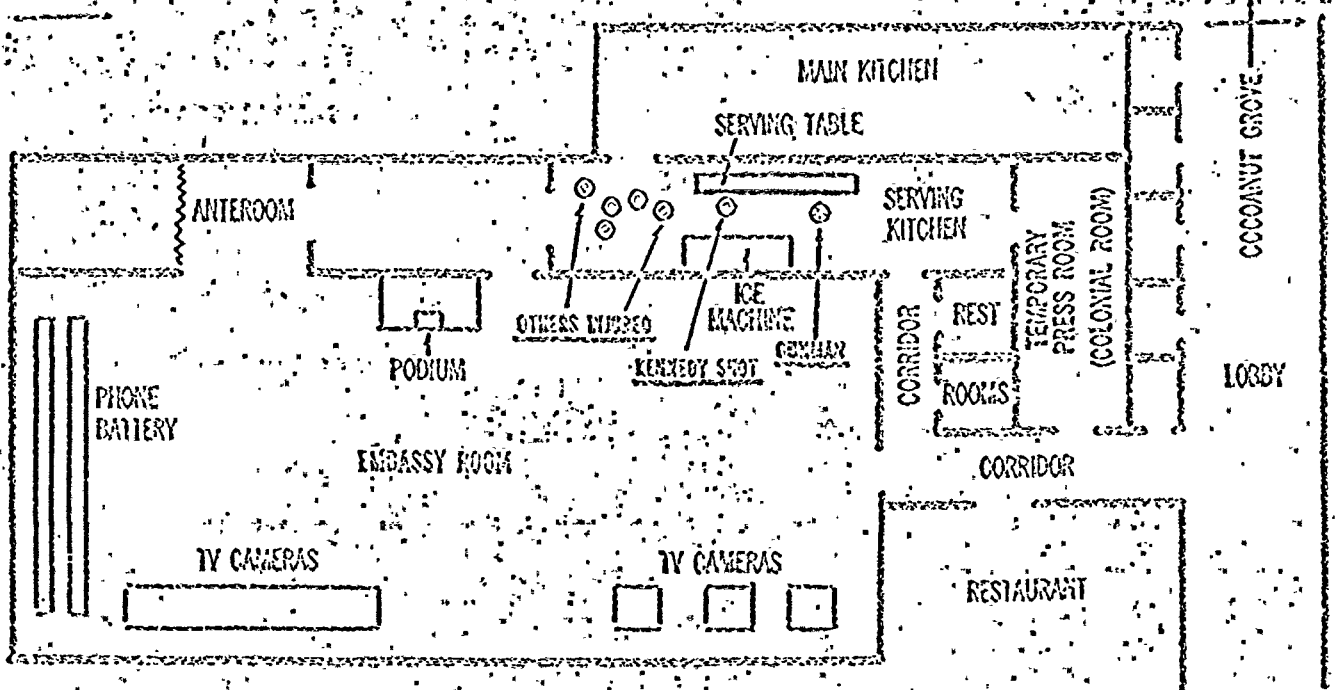


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE--Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy

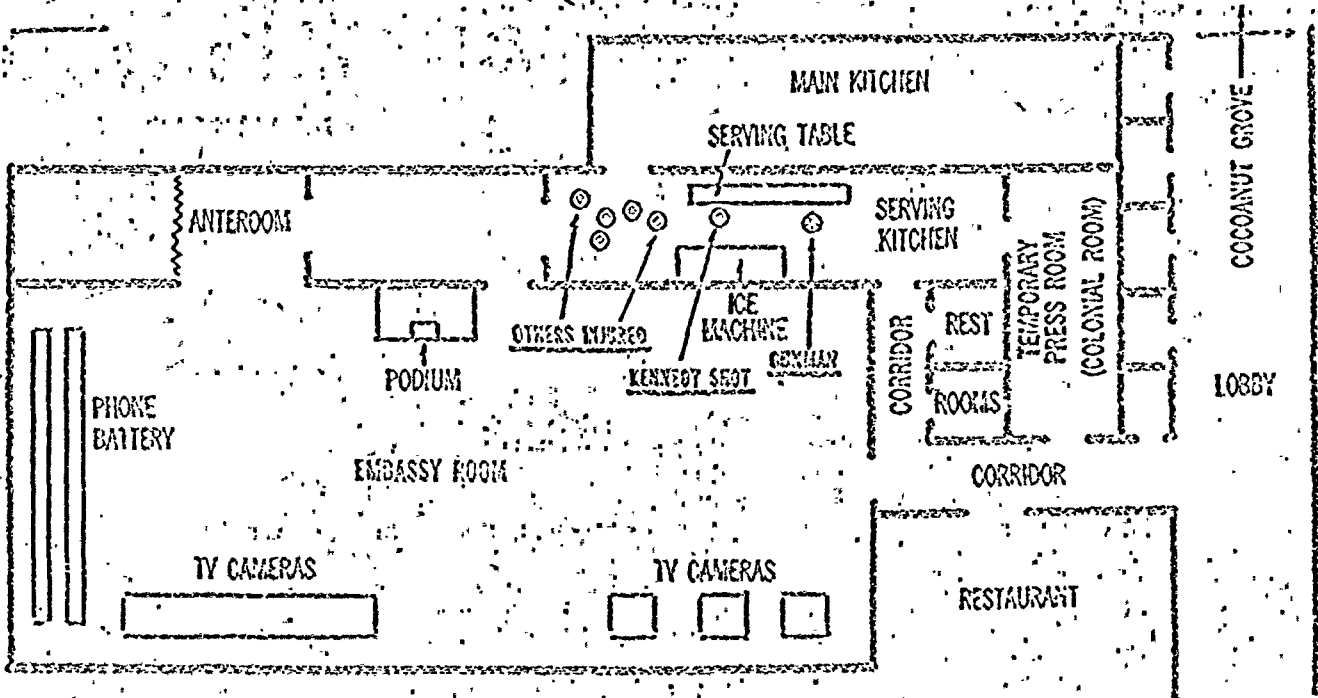


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium of Embassy

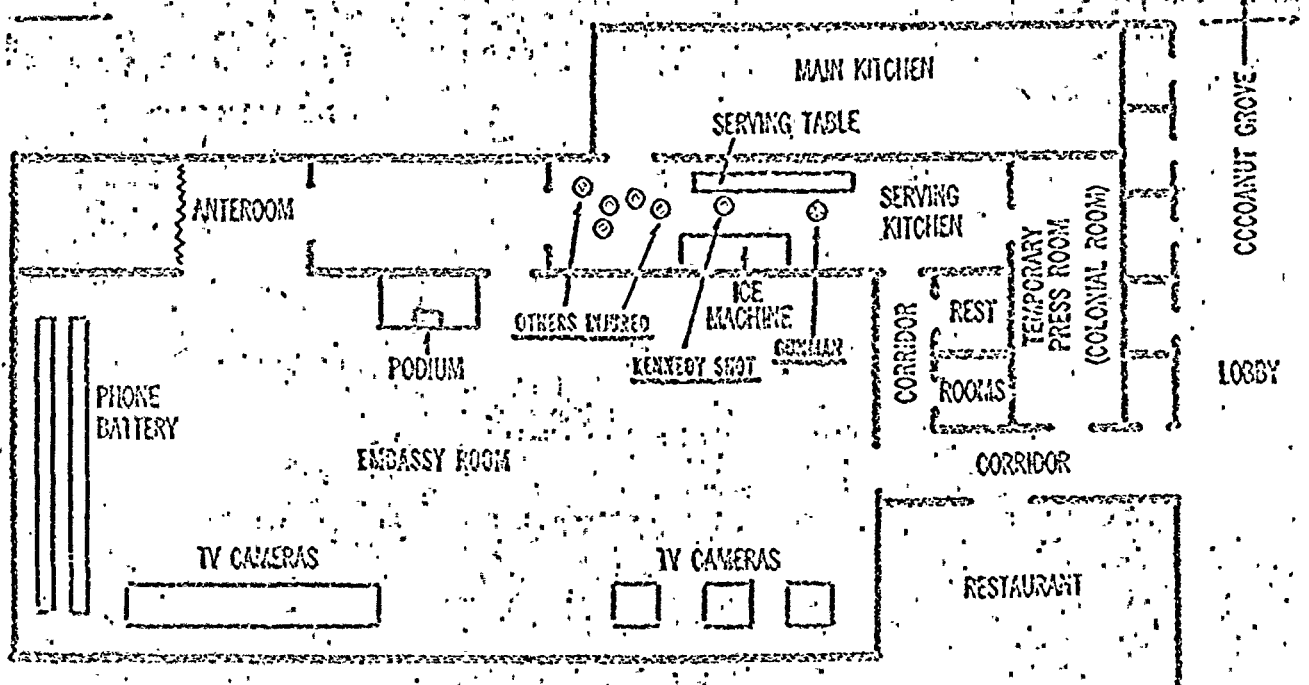


DIAGRAM OF SHOOTING SCENE—Sketch shows the doors leading from behind podium at Embassy
