When Denator Hennedy finished his greech, I left the Embassy Room through the front door, and I was headed toward the Colonial Room where a press conference was to be held. I was standing in the hall in front of the Embassy Room, near the swinging doors which lead To the kitchen, when I heard 2 or 3 gogs in quich succession, at the time I thought these noises were balloons popping, I then heard a commotion in the butchen and Uno Elmonson came out and said something about "shooting." No one else came through the swinging doors while I was there. I went into the hitchen right after 5 monson came out of it, and I saw a struggle going on, 2023 release the sice machine
