THE SAN FRANCISCO STATE COLLEGE, STATED HE HAD JUST  
RETURNED FROM CUBA AND WAS SHOWING MOVING PICTURES AND  
SLIDES OF THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF CASTRO IN CUBA. AN  
ARGUMENT AROSE BETWEEN DUARTE'S GROUP AND THE PERSONS

DUARTE WAS DESCRIBED AS A VETERAN OF THE U.S. ARMY DURING WORLD WAR TWO AND LATER A MAJOR IN THE CUBAN REBEL ARMY UNDER FIDEL RUZ, HE IS POSSIBLY AN AMERICAN CITIZEN.

WHEN SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY WAS ASSASSINATED IN LOS ANGELES ON JUNE FIVE LAST THE PRESS CARRIED PHOTOGRAPH OF SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

OWEN CLAIMED TO BE WITNESS IN KENNEDY ASSASSINATION, HAVING ALLEGEDLY SEEN SIRHAN WITH TWO OTHER MEN AND A GIRL PRIOR TO THE ASSASSINATION. CLAIMED HE HAD BEEN INTERVIEWED BY THE LOS ANGELES PD.

OWEN HAD TOLD GARDNER HE HAD RECEIVED TELEPHONE CALL FROM MAN CLAIMING TO BE LT. L. L. SANDLIN, DETECTIVE BUREAU, LAPD, WHOM HE HAD NOT PREVIOUSLY MET. SANDLIN WANTED TO TALK TO OWEN. CONCERNING THIS CASE ON JUNE TWENTY EIGHT OR TWENTY NINE AT THE HYATT HOUSE MOTEL, PALO ALTO, CALIFORNIA.
