Enclosed herewith to the Bureau are five (5) copies of a letterhead memorandum (LHM) concerning the captioned matter and interview with SHARIF B. SIRHAN on 11/7/68. Also enclosed are two copies of FD-376 for transmittal of the LHM to Secret Service, Washington, D. C.

SHARIF B. SIRHAN has denied writing the letter or causing it to be written but indicated he did not repudiate the thoughts that were expressed in the letter.

A copy of the LHM is being made available to Secret Service locally, inasmuch as one of their agents was present during the interview. The interview will also be made available to the Los Angeles Police Department in the next report, submitted in the form of an FD-302.

Los Angeles will attempt to secure typewriting specimens from the typewriter maintained at the residence of Mrs. MARY SIRHAN in Pasadena, California. The Bureau will be kept advised.

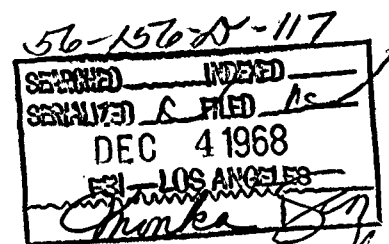

Re Los Angeles airtel to Director dated 12/19/69, Bureau letter to Legat, Ottawa, dated 2/26/69, and Bureau letters to Los Angeles dated 5/6/69 and 6/30/69.

Investigation developed information that PRUSZYNSKI was at the Ambassador Hotel when Senator KENNEDY was assaulted. He was assigned to the Kennedy Campaign as a reporter for Harper and Row Limited, Publishers, London. He made a tape recording of the events immediately subsequent to the assault which was made available and forwarded to the FBI, Laboratory for examination. Due to the poor quality of the original recording, the Laboratory reviewed the tape and made a dubbing from the original recording in an effort to enhance the intelligibility and reduce an interfering hum. The Laboratory suggested that the Los Angeles Office review the tape for any possible leads.

The Laboratory also provided an extra copy of the tape for dissemination to the Los Angeles Police Department.

A review of the recording was made at Los Angeles, however, it does not appear that anything pertinent to this investigation is contained on the recording.
