of both have been previously submitted to the Bureau under the KENSALT case caption. ADEL and MARY SIRHAN have no idea who wrote or caused to send the enclosed items through the United States Mail.

Victim described as an Arab male, born 3/19/44 in Jerusalem, is the accused slayer of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY and is currently confined under maximum security in the Los Angeles County Jail.

The Pasadena Police Department has been advised of receipt of enclosed items. It will be noted that the Pasadena Police Department has afforded protection to the SIRHAN family. Los Angeles Police Department and Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office also advised.

Facts of this matter were presented to U. S. Attorney W. MATTHEW BYRNE, Jr., Los Angeles, by SA JOHN F. MORRISON on 6/18/68. Mr. BYRNE withheld prosecutive opinion. He said that he would immediately discuss this matter with the Department of Justice, Washington, D. C. He said that he would advise the Los Angeles Office of his opinion after his discussion with the Department.

Due to the sensitive nature of this case and its possible relationship with KENSALT, this matter was immediately discussed with U. S. Attorney W. MATTHEW BYRNE, Jr., and the Los Angeles Office will be guided by his opinion, UACB.

Re New York airtel to the Bureau 6/6/68 titled, "JOHN M. LAURENCE, aka John M. Lawrence, RA - MIDDLE EAST", with JFM enclosed; New York teletype to Bureau 6/13/68 titled, "KFNSAH".

On 6/20/68, PATRICIA NAVARRO, Receptionist at the Law Office of RUSSELL E. PARSONS, 205 South Broadway Street, Suite 400, Los Angeles, was interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI, and advised she received two telephone calls from an individual who identified himself as JOHN LAWRENCE calling from telephone number 212-477-1826, New York City. Caller stated he was Executive Secretary of the Clemency Committee for SIRHAN SIRHAN. He stated Los Angeles criminal attorneys are "crooks", and will take SIRHAN "down the river". He said "we are out to get Mr. PARSONS" and "we are going to get you". Caller said PARSONS is being paid \$150,000 to represent SIRHAN and there are 250,000 Arabs who are very militant and are not going to let PARSONS get away with it. Caller repeated himself during the telephone conversation. He was described by Miss NAVARRO as upset and high strung. He sounded like he had a Jewish accent.

LA 9-NEW

RUSSELL E. PARSONS is the attorney that has been selected by SIRHAN SIRHAN to represent him in his forthcoming trial. PARSONS contacted Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) and requested protection. LAPD advised they told PARSONS regarding this request that before any protection would be afforded, the matter would have to be discussed with the Presiding Judge of the Los Angeles County Superior Court System.

Contact by FBI with USA W. MATTHEW BYRNE, JR., Los Angeles, this date, determined that the matter had been discussed with PARSONS and the Presiding Judge who advised a hearing would have to be held to determine whether protection would be afforded PARSONS by LAPD.

BYRNE further advised that due to the sensitive nature of this case, the nature of the allegation and apparent relationship it has to the prosecution of SIRHAN SIRHAN, he would withhold prosecutive opinion regarding possible violation of the Federal Extortion Statute and recommend no investigation be conducted by the FBI at this time. The Los Angeles Office will be guided by his opinion UACB.

On 6/21/68, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office (LASO) furnished the following information in absolute confidence:

SIRHAN SIRHAN received a letter dated 6/7/68 bearing the signature of JOHN M. LAWRENCE, Chairman, Federated Americans Against Israeli Racism, 57 West 10th Street, New York, New York.

In the letter, LAWRENCE offered SIRHAN SIRHAN any assistance he desired and indicated he and his organization would commence a campaign to seek mercy for SIRHAN. The LASO also furnished information concerning a news sheet entitled, "INSIGHT", published by "Federated Americans Against Israeli Racism". This news sheet bears the dateline New York, New York, and sets forth the aim to "restore Palestine to the Arab people". The name JOHN M. LAWRENCE is mentioned in this news sheet.

LA 9-NEW

Re New York airtel to the Bureau 6/6/68 describes JOHN M. LAWRENCE, a law researcher, as the chairman of "a pro-Arab radical left action group," Federated Americans Against Israeli Racism (FAIR).

Re New York teletype to Bureau dated 6/13/68 sets forth information concerning the results of indices search by New York Office. As of August, 1967, JOHN M. LAWRENCE was active in an organization known as FAIR. FAIR is not characterized or on the Attorney General's list. LAWRENCE is described as a white male, 35 - 40 years old, 5'7", 150 pounds, fair complexion with pale blue eyes and brown hair greying and thinning on the top. He and his wife, MARJORIE M. LAWRENCE are listed in the New York telephone book as residing at 57 West Tenth Street, New York, New York, telephone number GR 7-1826.

Los Angeles indices contain no other information identifiable with JOHN M. LAWRENCE.

Copies of this communication are furnished New York for information purposes and in the event further investigation is needed in this matter.

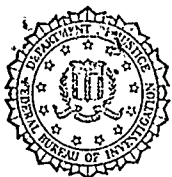

The current Muncie telephone directory reflects telephone number 284-5544, is listed to D. D. SLUSHER, 2201 East 8th; and that number 289-8392, is listed to ED SLUSHER, 229 North Hackley.

The current Muncie city directory lists DELANEY D. SLUSHER as retired and residing 2201 East 8th; and ED SLUSHER as an investigator, County Trustco's Office, and residing 229 North Hackley Street.

On 6/28/68, AUSA CASTERLINE was again contacted and he stated he would still consider prosecution if the identity of the person who made the call could be determined and wanted either or both SLUSHERs interviewed regarding instant call.

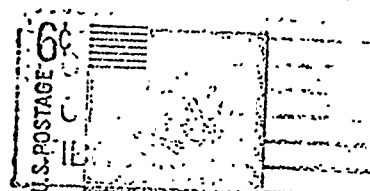
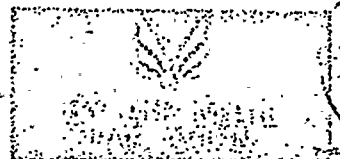

On the same date the facts of this matter were presented to Assistant U. S. Attorney Robert L. Brosio, Chief of the Criminal Division, U. S. Attorney's Office, Los Angeles, for a prosecutive opinion regarding violation of the Federal Extortion Statute. Mr. Brosio said he would discuss this matter with U. S. Attorney W. Matthew Byrne, Jr. He said he would notify the Los Angeles Office of the FBI of his opinion as soon as he had discussed this with Mr. Byrne.

The originals of the letter and envelope, received by Mr. Parsons, were forwarded to the FBI Laboratory in Washington, D. C., for examination.

This will confirm the information furnished to Special Agent Fred Clark, U. S. Secret Service, Los Angeles, and to Special Agent Myers Howard, 115th Military Intelligence Group, U. S. Army, Region II, Pasadena, California, on October 15, 1968. In addition, Sergeant Michael Neilson, Los Angeles Police Department, was also advised.

Dr. M.T. MEHDI, Secretary General, Action Committee on American-Arab Relations, 441 Lexington Ave., NYC, advised that he received a letter postmarked 11/3/68, Flushing, NY. The letter was sent to 149-35 Delaware Ave., Flushing, NY, Dr. MEHDI's home address.

The letter advised Dr. MEHDI to cancel his proposed trip to LA as arrangements for his funeral were being made in that city on 12/5/68. The letter further stated that the results of the trip would be "personally disastrous" to Dr. MEHDI and stated that if he, Dr. MEHDI, did not "cease and desist" from his activities, he would "not only leave America but the world." The letter was signed "Salaam."

MEHDI advised that he is scheduled to go to LA on 12/5/68, and that he would hold a press conference in that city re the publication of his new book "Kennedy and Sirhan - Why."

On 11/13/68, AUSA STUART STILLMAN, EDNY, advised that he would decline prosecution in the matter as it was his opinion that the letter was innocuous, not specific and does not fall within the purview of the federal extortion statute. Victim was advised of AUSA STILLMAN's opinion.
