Dear Sir:

This will confirm a telephone call from Special Agent Gilbert G. Benjamin of this office with Special Agent Robert M. Barker of your office at 3:25 p.m., June 10, 1968 relating to Arlington Robert Scott.

Information received today from the Central Intelligence Agency reflects that over this past weekend they received a telephone call from Arlington Robert Scott, 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania (Pittsburgh telephone number 683-8063), in which he requested "assistance and equipment" from the Central Intelligence Agency. He stated he needed this help in order to travel to California to see that Senator Robert F. Kennedy's assailant was properly punished. He further stated that since Senator Kennedy was the only friend of the Negro, he wanted to make sure Sirhan Sirhan would receive proper punishment.

No further identifying information regarding Scott is available at this time. The Los Angeles Police Department and Los Angeles Sheriff's Office have been advised of the above information.

On June 10, 1968, at 9:00 AM, the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) reported that one Arlington Robert Scott, 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa., telephonically contacted CIA Headquarters at 4:00 AM on June 8, 1968, and requested assistance and equipment from the CIA in that he needed help to go to California to see Senator Robert F. Kennedy's assailant was properly punished. Scott alleged he could not be certain that the assailant would not get off and since Senator Kennedy was the only friend of the Negro, he wanted to make sure Sirhan Sirhan would receive proper punishment. Scott was advised by the CIA to stay in Pittsburgh and to contact the local office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation if he had any information to offer.

On June 12, 1968, Arlington Robert Scott, 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa., telephone 663-8663, advised that early in the morning on Saturday, June 8, 1968, he telephonically contacted the CIA in Washington, D. C., and spoke to a man whose name he cannot recall. Scott said he called because he was angry over the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy and is concerned the assailant, Sirhan Sirhan, will not receive the punishment he deserves since he is not a citizen of the United States. He feels diplomatic pressure will be applied by Jordan which will result in Sirhan receiving a lighter sentence than he deserves. Scott said Sirhan killed Kennedy and, therefore, he should die also. He said Sirhan will be killed by a "suicide squad" prior to going to trial, but would not elaborate on who will make up the "squad."

Scott was evasive when questioned if he personally plans to attempt any action against Sirhan, but admitted requesting assistance and equipment from the CIA in order that he could travel to California. Scott stated he will not incriminate himself by saying he plans to take some type of action against Sirhan nor would he say he is not going to attempt such an action.

Scott said he is practicing with a high-powered rifle equipped with a telescopic sight, which belongs to his Chinese girl friend, whose name he refused to give. Scott also stated that the feeling he has about Sirhan also applies to James Earl Ray, the accused assassin of Martin Luther King, Jr. Scott expressed hostility toward George Wallace, former governor of Alabama, and Pittsburgh Mayor Joseph Barr, but would not specifically state what he feels should be done about these individuals. However, Scott implied that both Wallace and Barr should be handled in the same fashion as Sirhan and Ray. Scott described himself as a "fanatic" and said he was treated at the State Mental Hospital in Petersburg, Va., from December 2, 1952, through April 13, 1953, for mental instability. He also stated he was treated at the Veterans Administration Hospitals in Roanoke, Va., during the late 1940's and early 1950's and in Pittsburgh, Pa., in 1957 for mental instability, and at St. Francis Hospital, Pittsburgh, Pa., in 1957 for the same reason. Scott said he served in the United States Army in 1945 through 1947 under Army serial number 123070723 and was given a medical discharge for being mentally unstable. Scott further stated he has had several operations in the past including one for ulcers and said he currently has scars on his lungs, which will prevent any future operations. Scott said he has little to live for and would willingly give up his own life in order to help his race.

Reference is made to Bureau teletype captioned "Kensalt" dated June 10, 1968, and Pittsburgh reply dated June 11, 1968. This will confirm telephonic conversation between the Bureau and Pittsburgh this date.

Subject, who gave his address as 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, telephonically contacted SA Dan A. Brant at the Bureau at 4:55 a.m., 6/21/68. Subject, who sounded as if he had been drinking, voiced his disapproval regarding the interview by Pittsburgh Agents of the woman who resides downstairs at his residence. His only complaint was that she has a heart condition and shouldn't be bothered. He indicated he would "personally take care of" any law enforcement officer who bothers her.

Scott would not advise regarding the nature of the interview, however, stated this woman should not be bothered regarding his affairs.

Immediately present facts to U. S. Attorney in order to determine if this constitutes a violation of the Extortion Statute. If Federal prosecution not forthcoming advise other steps being taken by local authorities to have subject committed.

## Synopsis:

Subject telephonically contacted FBI Agent DAN A. BRANT, Washington, D.C., and voiced disapproval regarding interview by FBI Agents of woman residing downstairs at his residence. He indicated he would "personally take care of" any law enforcement officer who bothers her. AUSA, Pittsburgh, declined prosecution because of an ambiguity of SCOTT's statement. ROBERT FOSTER, US Secret Service, Pittsburgh, advised efforts to have SCOTT admitted for psychiatric treatment have proved unsuccessful to date. He has pending file on SCOTT as a potential threat to presidential candidates and will conduct a quarterly investigation regarding SCOTT.

DETAILS:

Investigation in this matter was predicated upon receipt of a telephone call from the subject, ARLINGTON ROBERT SCOTT at 4:55 a.m., on June 21, 1968, by SA DAN A. BRANT of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), in Washington, D.C. Subject, who gave his address as 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa., and sounded as if he had been drinking, voiced his disapproval regarding the interview by Pittsburgh Agents of the FBI of the woman who resides downstairs at his residence. His only complaint was that she has a heart condition and should not be bothered. He indicated he would "personally take care of" any law enforcement officer who bothers her. SCOTT would not advise regarding the nature of the interview, however, he stated this woman should not be bothered regarding his affairs.

On June 25, 1968, SA RONALD WETHERINGTON discussed the facts in this matter with Assistant United States Attorney THOMAS DALY. Mr. DALY stated he feels that because of its ambiguity, the statement made to SA DAN A. BRANT by the subject, ARLINGTON ROBERT SCOTT, taken by itself does not merit prosecutive consideration under the extortion statute. Mr. DALY said he considers this statement by SCOTT as incidental to the investigation of SCOTT as a potential threat to presidential candidates and, therefore, will decline prosecution regarding the extortion matter.

On June 28, 1968, ROBERT W. FOSTER, Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the U.S. Secret Service, Pittsburgh, advised SA WETHERINGTON that on June 13, 1968, following his interview with the subject, ARLINGTON ROBERT SCOTT, he interviewed Dr. ARNOLD FREEDMAN, Chief, Psychology Department, Oakland Veteran's Administration Hospital, Pittsburgh. He said FREEDMAN advised that the subject has very deep-seeded hostility against the white man,

suffers from alcoholism and during his stays at the Veteran's Administration Hospital in Oakland, he was constantly complaining, and he had constant run-ins with the personnel at the hospital stating they were discriminating against him for being a Negro. Dr. FREEDMAN stated subject has paranoid orientation, but he is not psychotic, has "lots of mouth," and in Dr. FREEDMAN's opinion, subject, under the right circumstances, could be extremely dangerous. Dr. FREEDMAN advised he would try and persuade the individual to come back to the hospital for further testing and possible commitment to the Veteran's Administration Hospital.

Mr. FOSTER advised he conferred with Lieutenant CLARK TOMER and Assistant Superintendent JOHN P. KELLY, Pittsburgh Police Department, and it was decided that if during the interview of subject, he made any threats against anyone, he would be committed under the Pennsylvania Mental Health and Retardation Act of 1966. However, FOSTER stated it was determined from an interview with Dr. FREEDMAN that SCOTT's condition is not such that he could be committed to an institution at this time for observation.

Mr. FOSTER stated he will keep his case open on SCOTT and will conduct a quarterly investigation because of his potential danger toward government leaders. He said when presidential candidates such as Governor GEORGE WALLACE come to Pittsburgh, he will closely follow the action of SCOTT.

On June 28, 1968, Lieutenant CLARK TOMER, Pittsburgh Police Department, Pittsburgh, advised that his department has done nothing further toward having SCOTT admitted for psychiatric treatment.
