PERSONNEL UTILIZED DURING EARLY STAGES OF KENSALT

During the weekend of 6/8 - 9/68 the Los Angeles Division had a total of 136 Agents working. They worked 1371.8 hours, or 1712 Agent work days.

During the above weekend we used 39 stenographers on Saturday and 36 on Sunday. During this period they put in a total of 641 hours. We used 23 clerks on Saturday and 20 on Sunday. The clerks put in a total of 359½ hours. The combined total of clerical and stenographic personnel used during this weekend period was 118, and they put in a combined total of 1000½ hours of work.

During this period (weekend of 6/8 - 9/68) it was also necessary to call in outside service personnel to repair our xerox and mimeograph machines at night.

We also had three clerical employees (female) who became ill while at work and it was necessary that Agent personnel take them home.

Due to the long and continuous hours performed by one of our Agents, he became ill from exhaustion and it was necessary that he receive medical care and attention on Sunday.

Certain employees in the Photographic Laboratory and Xeroxing Room worked for periods of 30 hours or more, continuous.
