ZATKIN stated on 6-3-68, at about 12:20 P.M. she entered the elevator in the building where she is employed. As she entered she observed a male and a female in the elevator.

She says that they were: #1, Male cauc, 26 yrs, 5-6, 140, dark hair, wearing a tweed jacket, slacks and had on glasses., and that #2 suspect was a: F C 30/32, 5-7, 130, dark hair, Unk. clothing but was also wearing glasses.

Zatkin thought that they were together because they were standing very close together and there were no other occupants in the elevator, however, suspects did not talk to each other and suspect #2 got off the elevator alone. As the elevator continued up, suspect #1, commented to Zatkin's about the weather,; he then stated, "This weather means something. There's going to be a great tragedy to a lot of people either today or tomorrow". PR asked what suspect meant and she just snickered.

PR stated that the  
AFTER THE INTERVIEW, Officer showed PR several photographs.

Offcr. adv. PR that the people in them were not necessarily suspects in this matter. PR was also asked to be sure of any identification she may make.

PR stated that the photo of NABIL KHOURY appeared to be suspect #1; except for the fact that KHOURY looks like a foreigner, and the susp. did not, or did he have an accent. She

also identified the photograph of Beverly Corey, as possibly being suspect #2, except that the susp. had shorter hair, than Corey does in the photograph. Also, the suspect's glasses appeared to be more round and not as pointed as Corey's.

Interview conducted at Miss Zukin's home, at the abv date and time.

Fe Cauc 5'5 125 DOB Sept 19, 1943 (Chicago, Ill) brn hair, blue eyes. Came to the L.A. area in 1952. Graduated from Grant Hi School in Van Nuys. Attended Los Angeles Valley College. Graduated from Berkley in 1965- Political Science.

Informant was a volunteer worker for the Kennedy Campaign. On June 4, 1968 she entered the Ambassador Hotel at approx 6:00PM, and left at approx 7:00AM, June 5, 1968.

Her assignment was as a telephone opr at the Kennedy Staff Room (Anchor Desk), located just west of the stage area of the Embassy Room. She also ran some errands to the 5th floor, and the 1st floor to the Cigarette machine.

At time of, just prior to and during the shooting Miss Zukin was standing at door to the anchor desk area or just outside of it, in the hallway.

After the shooting she went into the kitchen area and first saw a look of horror on the face of Carrol Breshers (Head of "Kennedy Girls"). A short while later she saw Sen Kennedy on the floor. She also saw some of the other victims, but does not recall if it was before or after she saw Kennedy.

Miss Zukin never saw Sirhan Sirhan, but ids picture from seeing it in News Media.

Miss Zukin obs a lady standing, sitting and lingering around the anchor desk area, whom she describes as poss being the "Girl in the Polkadot Dress".

Description: Early 20s, 5;5 120, dark brown or black hair, unk col eyes, good figure. Wearing a sleeveless, scooped neckline, straight skirt, black and white polkadot or print dress. Miss Zukin does not recall this Fe position at the time of the shooting.





Unit G-18 from Central Receiving Hospital was dispatched to 3400 Wilshire Blvd. at 12:18 A.M. on June 5, 1968 to attend victims of a shooting. This Ambulance Unit was composed of Driver Robert Hulsman and Attendant Max Behrman. They arrived at the Ambassador Hotel at 12:23 A.M. and entered the location. After attending the victim and transporting him they arrived at Central Receiving Hospital at 12:30 A.M. Doctors in attendance at Central Receiving Hospital included Dr. Miller, a Negro Physician, and Dr. Bernard Arias a Staff Physician at Central Receiving Hospital. Dr. Miller and Arias were at the scene of the shooting and accompanied Senator Kennedy to Central Receiving Hospital in the ambulance. Nurses in attendance at Central Receiving Hospital included RN's Eby, Nelson, Mejia, Lightzey, Pheln, McCrum, Owens and Bauer. The Ambulance Supervisor at Central Receiving Hospital is Paul Clum. Interviews of the various members of the Staff on June 5, 1968 at approximately 7:30 P.M. indicated that all of the members of the Staff at least made a cursory visual examination of Senator Kennedy if not actually physically contacting him during his stay at Central Receiving Hospital.

Senator Robert F. Kennedy arrived at Good Samaritan Hospital and was admitted under admission number 68 5691 at approximately 1:00am 6-5-68. The ambulance was met by Dr. Robert Mendez and Dr. Roland Navarro who transferred Sen. Kennedy to the intensive care ward. Sen. Kennedy at this time was unconscienous and unresponsive but with strong and regular femoral pulses. He showed evidence of brain injury with bloody spinal fluid draining from the right ear. His injuries were diagnosed as gun shot wound behind right ear in the mastoid sinus area. G.S.W. right shoulder muscel. 2 entry wounds no exit wounds. Due to the seriousness of the injuries Dr. Huebl and Dr. Ironside performed tracheostomy. Mr. Mestman administered a urethreal catheter. Shortly afterward Sen. Kennedy experienced respiratory distress with periods of non-breathing. Breathing was assisted with a mech. respirator. Intervenuous fluids had been started upon Sen. Kennedys arrival at the hosp. Approximately 1:30am Dr. Cunio ordered the patient be cooled on an ice mattress. Xrays were taken of the head, neck, chest, and right shoulder. The results of the Xrays showed the bullet entering the right shoulder had coursed its way to the posterior lower cervical region. Surgery was advised and Mrs. Kennedy was notified. Approximately 2:46am Sen Kennedys medicalhhistory was obtained. Sen. Kennedy was still unconscienous and un-arrousalbe. He was breathing heavily but at a normal rate. Pupils mildly dialated, fixed, and unresponsive to light. Blood pressure was dropping from 180/100 at 1:10am to 95/60 at 2:15am whole blood transfusions had been started.

Prognosis before surgery - extremely poor. Mrs. Kennedy requested to see Dr. William Schumann obstetrician. Anesthesia for surgery was started at 2:30am and surgery at 3:10am 2 more bullet wounds had been found in the upper right tricep. 1 a graze wound and the other an entry with no exit. During surgery Dr. Zaro noted that during surgery Sen. Kennedy's cardiovascular system was satisfactory. Urine output also termed satisfactory by Dr. Griffith. Surgery was terminated 6:20am - anesthesia at 6:40am. At approximately 10:50am Dr. James Poppin the family physician, who had arrived Wash., D.C., noted that if Sen. Kennedy survives he would probably be paralyzed on the left side, blind, and have reduced equilibrium (cerebration). Approximately 4:45pm and 7:00pm blood pressure had dropped to 80/20. At 6:09pm Dr. Poppin indicated patient has steadily lost ground has developed cardiac and kidney changes. Pulse slowing as to volume and rate. No responses. This is terminal - only time is a factor.. Brain wave tracing showed no brain function except heart, pulse irregular. Pupils fixed, 8:00pm Sen. Kennedy seemed to be stabilizing but by 11:20am the heart tones had weakened. June 6, 12:30am blood pressure down. 1:15am no blood pressure. 1:27am no pulse, no breathing, no heart sounds, tubing removed. 1:44am Sen. Kennedy expired. Security was provided both the hospital and the Ambassador Hotel by the Federal Secret Service, LAPD and the Hospital Security (Shield) were providing security for the Good Samaritan Hospital during Senator Kennedy's stay there. Officer MC DEVITT, LAPD, on 6/19/68, advised the LAPD had previously received information from a VIRGINIA TERESI, 714 3/4 North St. Andrews, Los Angeles, California, that on 6/3/68, she had observed three young men in a car parked on Melrose at 3:20 PM, and overheard them say that if they were going to get KENNEDY, they had better hurry. She further stated she had immediately called the FBI about this.

No record of such a call was located in FBI Los Angeles records and Officer MC DEVITT was previously advised re this.

On 6/19/68, MC DEVITT advised that VIRGINIA TERESI, when interviewed under the lie detector, admitted her previous story was completely false.

MISS VIRGINIA TERESI

Miss Virginia Teresi alleges that on June, 1968 at Melrose and St. Andrews Place, she observed Sirhan B. Sirhan and two male companions in a 1959 blue Ford. She further stated that Sirhan was carrying a pistol in his waistband and she observed a rifle barrel partially covered by clothing in the rear seat of their vehicle. She recalls hearing some conversation regarding: "We'll get Kennedy". Mrs. Teresi was interviewed and then given an polygraph examination. She subsequently admitted that her entire story was a hoax and had not occurred.
