PREVIOUS PANEL OF TWENTY FIVE PROSPECTIVE JURORS EXHAUSTED AND PROCEEDINGS DURING AFTERNOON SESSION TODAY, *there* was included selection of fifteen additional prospective jurors: TO THIS DATE, NO JUROR HAS BEEN SEATED AS JURY MEMBER. ALL PROSPECTIVE JURORS THUS FAR ELEMINATED HAVEBBEEN FOR CAUSE, PERSONAL SITUATIONS, OR POSSIBLE ECONOMIC HARDSHIP.

ONE ASPECT OF EXAMINATION OF PROSPECTIVE JURORS CHNTERS AROUND THEIR APPARENT FEELINGS CONCERNING CASE AS BROUGHT TO THEIR ATTENTION BY VARIOUS NEWS MEDIA SINCE ASSASSINATION. EACH INDIVIDUAL JUROR IS EXAMINED IN CHAMBERS BY ATTORNEYS, NOT IN OPENICOURT WITH RESPECT PLBLICITY FUBLIC MAY HAVE HAD UPON EACH OF THEM.

PROCEDURE INIDAILY COURT SESSIONS COMMENCES WITH COURT CONVENING AT NINE THIRTY A.M. IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER, APPROXIMATELY FOURTY FIVE MINUTES ARE SPENT IN JUDGES CHAMBERS WITH ATTORNEYS FOR PROSECUTION AND DEFENSE PRESENT. FURTHER PROCEEDINGS THEN CONTINUE IN OPEN COURT UNTIL NOON, WHEN THE LUNCH RECESS IS TAKEN. HERBERT V. WALKER, PRESIDING JUDGE, GRANTED BRIEF PRESS CONFERENCE TO MEMBERS OF NEWS MEDIA WHO HAVE BEEN ATTEMPTING TO INTERVIEW HIM REGARDING CASE. HE HAS




