PAUL WERTLAKE, M.D., Pathologist, Good Samaritan Hospital, Los Angeles, California, advised that after the surgery had been performed on Senator ROBERT KENNEDY, he personally, at approximately 6:30 AM on June 5, 1968, removed certain specimens from the Surgery Room to the Pathology Room. Dr. WERTLAKE identified these specimens as bullet fragments, bone particles and bits of tissue from the skull of the victim. Some of the bone particles have bullet fragments adhering to them. The largest bone particle is a bone flap with a burr hole on one side. This was removed to furnish the surgeons an entry into the interior of the head and to relieve intolerable pressure inside the skull. The specimens were all turned over to the coroner. Dr. WERTLAKE advised that a photographer of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) took photographs of these specimens.
