DETAILS OF CASE:

On 6-9-66 Agents received information that the above subject was dealing in can quantities of Marijuana in the Pasadena area.

Pasadena Police Department advised that they had two informants who could introduce an Agent to the suspect for the purchase of Marijuana, and further that on 6-9-66 the two informants had given the suspect \$10. to show good faith.

On 6-10-66 under the surveillance of Agent Thompson and Sgt. Kilgore and Detective Dominic of Pasadena Police Department, Agent Miller and two informants met suspect Munir Bishara Salameh SIRHAN, (introduced as Joe MURR) in an alley north of Colorado to complete a purchase of 2 "cans" of Marijuana.

After introduction of Agent Miller, the following conversation ensued:

INFORMANT: "I couldn't raise enough for the five cans, all I could get was \$5. more. Bill wants a can too."

AGENT: "Yeah, but can't you do better on the price?"

SIRHAN: "Fifteen is the best I can do a can."

AGENT: "How about on quantity, can you do better?"

SIRHAN: "Fifteen's all I can do."

AGENT: "How about on a ki?"

SIRHAN: "Seed weight or leaf weight?"

AGENT: "Leaf weight."

SIRHAN: "I'll see what I can do. (To informant) Give me the 20 for the two cans."

Agent Miller handed SIRHAN \$20. pre-recorded State funds and at this time Joe directed Agent and informants to wait at the corner of Lake and Walnut.

Agent and informants proceeded to this location and Agent Miller contacted covering Officers and advised them of what had transpired to this time.

Agent Miller then returned to the informant's vehicle and at this time observed SIRHAN and another individual subsequently identified as Carlos Arturo GONZALES DEL VALLE walking north on Lake. The two suspects came up to the vehicle and at this time Agent and one of the informants were directed to get out of the vehicle by SIRHAN who said, "Let's take a ride around the block."

SIRHAN, GONZALEZ DEL VALLE, and one of the informants then left the area. A short time later SIRHAN and the informant returned and at this time Agent and informant entered the vehicle where the following conversation ensued:

SIRHAN: "You still want the kit?"

AGENT: "Sure, when can you get it?"

SIRHAN: "When do you want it?"

AGENT: "Whenever you can get it; how about price?"

SIRHAN: "Name a figure."

AGENT: "Is it good weed, name a price."

SIRHAN: "It's good weed, what can you pay for it?"

AGENT: "How about a bill."

SIRHAN: "Oh man, you're kidding."

At this time the informant's vehicle was pulled over by covering Officers and the informant driving advised Agent Miller that the suspect SIRHAN had the two cans in his pocket. Agent Miller relayed this information to Agent Thompson who recovered three bags from the subject which contained a green leafy substance resembling Marijuana.

At this time suspect was placed under arrest for violation of 11531 and 11530 H&S Code, possession and sale of Marijuana; suspect was immediately advised of his constitutional rights, to wit: the right to remain silent, the right to services of an attorney, and that anything he said could be used against him in subsequent legal proceedings.

Suspect was then transported to Pasadena Police Department and was subsequently booked. During the booking, \$5. State funds were recovered.

STATEMENT OF DEFENDANT:
