UNSUB, aka Robert Gene Gindroz ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA 6/5/68

Writer received a telephone call at approximately 4:00 A.M., 6/5/68 from an individual who identified himself as RONALD R. HUNTLEY, 2902 East Burnside, Portland, Oregon, no telephone number.

HUNTLEY advised that he was Senator KENNEDY's personal bodyguard during the Senator's campaign for the Oregon primary and that a week ago from this past Tuesday he was with the Senator at the Benson Hotel, Portland, at which time the Senator was congratulating Senator MC CARTHY on his primary victory.

HUNTLEY stated that as the Senator was attempting to leave the hotel he, HUNTLEY, was clearing a path through the crowd and had occasion to push two males out of the way of Senator KENNEDY. As he pushed one of the men out of the way he felt a weapon under the man's suit coat and immediately shoved the man up against a wall. THE MEN CAUSED NO FURTHER PROBLEM AND KENNEDY WAS NOT ADVISED OF THE INCIDENT.

HUNTLEY stated that he was presently observing television and observed a photograph of the man the Los Angeles Police Department had arrested as a suspect in the attempted assassination of KENNEDY. HUNTLEY advised that he is certain this individual is identical to one of the two men he shoved out of the way of KENNEDY's path at the Benson Hotel.

HUNTLEY stated that the other individual was approximately 24 years old, possibly of Latin American extraction, 5' 4", 195 pounds, dark brown hair, very stocky

HUNTLEY advised that he would be available for interview by FBI Agents at 374 East Edison, Hillsboro, Oregon, telephone 688-4704, and would wait at this address until contacted by Agents.

This information was telephonically furnished to the Bureau by Supervisor WILLIAM JOHN NOLAN. The Bureau instructed that this information should be telephonically furnished the Portland Office with instructions that HUNTLEY should be immediately interviewed and that the results thereof should be telephonically furnished the Bureau and Los Angeles.

Writer immediately contacted Portland and spoke to Night Security Clerk LUND who advised he would immediately contact his SAC regarding the matter.

Writer, while listening to news broadcast over KHJ 24 hour news station, obtained first info that an attempt had been made on the life of KENNEDY. No further details were available as there was considerable confusion at the scene. This was at 12:16 AM, 6/5/68.

Writer at this time, attempted to contact LAPD but could get no answer. Details were obtained as far as possible from radio and television. Continued attempts to contact LAPD were negative.

Writer, at approximately 12:30 PM, writer received call from Supervisor NOLAN who stated he had heard about situation on TV and that he was ready to come to office should SAC so desire.

Writer contacted SAC who stated SUP. NOLAN should be brought into office and that he should arrange for necessary number of personel to handle situation. SAC stated Bureau should be advised.

Writer contacted NOLAN who stated that Supervisor BARRON, & SA's SHEETS&R. ROSS and should be contacted to come into office.

Writer then contacted Bureau, SA ROBERT PETERSON and advised of info known to date.

Writer then was switched over to SA LEON SMITH, Division 5 and he was also apprised of info to date.

SERIALIZED_/Z_FILED 1968 JUN5 FBI - LOS ANGELES The only info known at this time was that obtained from new media to the effect that KENNEDY had been shot twice, once behind the left ear and once in the shoulder. A number of other persons were also hit by gunfire, however their identity unknown at this time. Info was also obtained, at approximatley 12;30 AM, over television, that LAPD had suspect in custody, name and description unknown.

Writer determined that KENNEDY was being taken to the Central "eceiving Hospital accross from the office. SA THOMAS JUDD was sent over to obtain up to date info re KENNEDY's condition.

At approximately 12:45 AM, KENNEDY was transferred to the Good Samaritan Hospital and SA'S JUDD and KENNETH MARISHAN were dispatched there to keep writer advised of KENNEDY's condittion.


At approximately 12:50, after continued attempts to contact LAPD were negative, writer contacted Supervisor KERTIN regarding his contacting an offical at LAPD in effort to obtain info on suspect they allegedly had in cystody.

SAPPETERSON at Bureau palkept advised by writer of facts as they became available.

DATE:

At 1:30 A.M. Assistant to the Director C. D. DE LOACH was advised that the KENNEDY party, in the persons of TED SORENSEN and PIERRE SALLNGER, had requested that he contact Chief U. S. Marshal MC SHANE and have him go to the KENNEDY home to stay with the family. Mr. DE LOACH said he would take care of this. Mr. DE LOACH advised that under no circumstances should we give the impression that we are investigating this matter; that we are rendering every possible assistance that we can.

At 3:40 A.M. Assistant Director TOM BISHOP contacted the writer and advised that in the event of any press inquiry, we are to give the statement that the FBI is rendering every possible assistance to the local authorities.

At 3:35 A.M. the writer contacted Colonel W. H. STUART, 382-4808, at Norton Air Force Base to arrange for a military flight to take the fingerprints of the subject of this dase back to Washington, D. C., along with an Agent. call was based upon a call at 3:30 A.M. from HENRY SCHUTZ, Division 6 at the Bureau, on the instructions of Mr. DE LOACH that the fingerprints of the unidentified killer were to be flown back immediately via military, inasmuch as commercial flights would not leave at the very earliest until 8:30 A.M. The Colonel advised that it would take him some time to attempt to find a craft ready for flight, and that he would contact the writer.

The prints were turned over to SA JOSEPH ARWINE by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) in view of the fact that the perpetrator of the shooting had no identification and had no record in the LAPD and Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office.

It was ascertained that the Speed Photo machine in

the Identification Division was inoperative. Upon clearance

by SCHUTZ with Mr. DE LOACH, it was arranged that the photographs of the prints would be transmitted to the Bureau via UPI, and the originals would be flown back by military aircraft, accompanied by an Agent, or commercial airline, whichever flight was the earliest.

The following arrangements have now been made:

A private line, telephone 483-0357, has been installed between this office and the fifth floor of the Good Samaritan Hospital and placed into operation at approximately 3:30 A.M.

Supervisor JOHN BARRON and SA FRANK CALLAHAN are handling liaison with the KENNEDY party at the Good Samaritan Hospital.

Supervisor ROBERT KERTIN upon his arrival at the office immediately went to handle liaison with Chief of Police REDDIN, replacing SA JOSEPH ARWINE, visitor from Tampa, and SA LEROY W. SHEETS.

SA ARWINE has handled the UPI transmittal of the prints and advised at 4:06 A.M. that the prints and photograph of the unidentified individual were now transmitted.

The Bureau has been advised of the identities of five persons known to be wounded and their condition, as known as of 3:00 A.M.

Supervisor BARRON by telephone furnished the following as concerns the President of the United States:

The President at 3:30 A.M. to Staff Assistant TED SORENSEN expressed his sympathy and deep regret and thereafter stated immediately he was invoking security precautions for all candidates of all political parties because Secret Service was not large enough in staff to handle, and the President stated he would even consider using military. Comment was made by SORENSEN to the effect no mention of FBI made in conversation concerning security.

This information was received by Mr. SORENSEN at about 3:40 A.M., and Supervisor BARRON relayed the data to the office at about 4:00 A.M. The Bureau (HENRY SCHUTZ, Division 6) was advised.

As of 3:30 A.M. Senator KENNEDY was in the operating room with a bullet in the mastoid area at the rear, causing pressure on the brain. Physicians were uncertain as to whether pressure was caused by the bullet or a blood clot. If it were a blood clot, it was operable, and if caused by a bullet, it would be most serious.

At 4:10 A.M. Colonel WILL STUART advised that he had a T 39 flight laid on for 5:30 A.M. departure time at Norton Air Force Base. The pilot would be Captain BUCHNER, and pursuant to Bureau instructions, an Agent was assigned to carry the prints. SA LEROY W. SHEETS has departed for Washington, D.C.

At 4:18 A.M. Supervisor BARRON called and advised that the progress report on the Senator is as follows: He is in surgery. They have removed bone splinters from the head. All organs are performing strongly. Condition good.

At 4:18 A.M. SA ROBERT KERTIN advised that the LAPD had discovered a car key in the unidentified person's pocket and had tied it up to a car which they believe belongs to ROBERT GENE GENDROZ. SA HENRY SCHUTZ, Division 6 at the Bureau, was advised of the above at 4:30 A.M. He requested that we attempt to develop more background information on GENDROZ. He will call back.
