SA LEROY W. SHEETS was driven to Norton Air Force Base by SA GILBERT G. BENJAMIN and was airborne in Air Force T-39, Aircraft #647 at 5:49 AM, ETA Andrews Air Force Base, 2:30 PM, our time.

The weapon utilized in the crime was determined to be a .22 caliber Iver Johnson revolver, eight shot model.

Serial #53725, which was sold on 8/10/65, according to the records of the California Department of Justice/as checked by the Los Angeles Police Department, to ALBERT LESLIE HERTZ, 777 East Valley, Alhambra. HERTZ advised the Police Department, when contacted, that he gave the gun to his son-in-law in San Francisco, who lost it shortly afterwards. Chief REDDIN, at the time this information was made available, did not have the name of the son-in-law.

It should be noted that arrangements were made with the Pacific Telephone Company to install a private line between this office and the Fifth Floor of the Good Samaritan Hospital, to be utilized by SA BARRON and SA CALLAHAN. The number of the telephone is 483-0357.

At approximately 6:00 AM, Mr. REX SHRODER of the Bureau called and advised that Mr. ROSEN wanted the VIN and the car of the unidentified individual processed and any latents or other evidence sent to the Bureau. It was pointed out to Mr. SHRODER that this might present a problem in view of the fact that the car would be in the custody of the Los Angeles Police Department, but that Chief REDDIN would be contacted and the necessary results secured.

A separate memo concerning call of Mr. SHRODER at 8:10 AM has been prepared concerning taking active part in this investigation which is at variance with previous instructions furnished by Mr. BISHOP and Mr. DE LOACH.

At 8:20 AM, SA HENRY SCHUTZ of the Bureau telephonically advised that Mr. ROSEN desired that all the CBS and NBC television films be secured or reviewed for any possible suspects. It was pointed out that the individual who did the shooting was already in custody. SCHUTZ advised that it was the desire of the Bureau to review and identify all suspicious persons in the films and if necessary, secure a copy of the films. It was pointed out to SCHUTZ that

TV film is video tape and to transcribe it into black and white film suitable for movie projection would cost ten cents a running foot. He advised that if this cost were necessary, to consider that I had authority to extend these instructions unless he telephonically advised me to the contrary.

SA LESLIE F. WARREN was given the assignment of securing additional personnel to handle this phase at the studios.

At 7:50 AM, Supervisor ROBERT E. KERTIN advised that the Police Department now has ascertained that ROBERT JENE GINDROZ, born 1/5/32 in Switzerland, 2921 Briar Kholl, Hollywood, is the owner of the 1958 Chrysler, described as 6'1", 200 pounds, and is employed as an Assistant Chef at the Ambassador Hotel. This information was made available to the Bureau. SA KERTIN advised further that the Unsub had on his person in addition to a car key, some loose change and four \$100 bills. The Bureau requested the serial numbers be secured.

The Bureau also suggested that they had a call from the surgeon stationed at Fort Holabird who suggested that urine and blood samples be taken of the subject to determine if he were on drugs. SA KERTIN was advised of this and told to pass it along in the form of a suggestion from the surgeon and not from the FBI.

At 8:44 AM, pursuant to the instructions of ASAC ROGGE, Sacramento Supervisor BOB RIEDELL was requested to check CII on the fingerprint classification as given by the Los Angeles Police Department. Supervisor RIEDELL advised this would be done.

At 7:48 A.M., 6/5/68, Assistant to the Director CARTHA D. DE LOACH and Assistant Director AL ROSEN called. Mr. DE LOACH stated that Attorney General RAMSEY CLARK has communicated with him on numerous occasions since 4:00 A.M. this morning and insists that the FBI have a representative during every pertinent interview in this matter, including any interrogations of the suspects. The Attorney General has advised that he has been in contact with Chief of Police TOM REDDIN who has indicated they are taping and filming every activity of the suspect; however, the Attorney General feels that the possibility of allegations being made against the Los Angeles Police Department in regard to civil rights violations make it necessary for an FBI representative being available at all times.

DE LOACH also insisted that the Los Angeles Office maintain at least two Agents at police headquarters since the Director had been so advised. DE LOACH was notified there are more than two Agents at headquarters handling various aspects of this case. He was also advised liaison of the closest nature is being maintained at Good Samaritan Hospital with PIERRE SALINGER and TED SORENSON.

DE LOACH stated that if there should be any reluctance on the part of Chief of Police REDDIN to permit the FBI to participate fully in this, he will handle it at Washington, D.C. I told DE LOACH there was no indication at all that there would be any reluctance on the part of REDDIN and that our liaison was very effective and functioning properly. DE LOACH instructed that he be advised of all pertinent developments.

At 8:10 AM, REX SHRODER of the Bureau, advised that Mr. ROSEN had directed that agent personnel sit in in all interviews of the subject of this case. He also advised that the code name of the case was now known as KENSALT and that in connection with information furnished to him that ROBERT JENE GINDROZ of 2921 Briar Knoll, Hollywood, was an Assistant Chef at the Ambassador Hotel. He advised that Mr. ROSEN has instructed that agents sit in on all other interviews.

Mr. SHRODER was specifically asked whether or not this meant that the FBI was to tell LAPD Chief REDDIN that we are actively investigating this matter. SHRODER read a copy of a teletype that was coming out to the field which stated that the FBI was rendering every possible assistance to local authorities and that all leads were to be handled immediately.

It was pointed out to Mr. SHRODER that this did not seem to conform, in view of the previous instructions that I had received that we are not actively investigating this matter. Mr. SHRODER stated that we were to advise the press pursuant to the teletype and that the term "all leads should be immediately covered" meant that we are actively investigating the matter. He was advised that should this question come up with Chief REDDIN, the Chief would be so informed.

SHRODER also indicated that he had previously informed the writer that a report would have to be submitted with 302s and that we are actively investigating the matter. Granja Vista Del Rio Farms is a horse training farm where thoroughbreds are trained for horse racing. said that his office manager, a female, who is presently recovering from a broken back, observed a photograph on television of SIRHAN SIRHAN and identified this individual as a former employee at the farm.

ALTFILLISCH said that SIRHAN was employed at the farm as an exercise boy on 6/2/66. He said complete employment records were not immediately available and he could, therefore, not determine the exact date that SIRHAN terminated his employ nor background information furnished when applying for the job.

ALTFILLISCH described SIRHAN as a very intelligent individual who said he was a political science student. While working at the farm, SIRHAN was injured, resulting in a compensation claim being made. This claim was handled by the Industrial Accident Commission in Los Angeles and SIRHAN received a settlement about three or four months ago. ALTFILLISCH said that this matter was handled by his insurance broker, which is Miller and Ames Insurance Company, Los Angeles, telephone 386-2360. He said that Miller and Ames Company would have considerable background information (ALTFILLISCH also owns the Altfillisch Construction Company; however, the records of farm employees are entirely separate).

ALTFILLISCH said that he was attempting to locate the farm's employment records in order that they would be readily available to the FBI.

Mr. TIM HALLOCK, 3749 Glendon, Culver City, California, telephonically advised at 2:20 P.M., 6/5/68, his mother, Mrs. HALLOCK, is the housekeeper for Mrs. GRACE GARLAND, 22368 Pacific Coast Highway, Malibu, telephone GL 6-2984. Mrs. GARLAND lives next door to the house where the KENNEDY family was staying this week while Senator KENNEDY was campaigning in Los Angeles.

According to TIM HALLOCK, his mother was at the GARLAND home on the evening of 6/3/68. At about 10:30 P.M. the doorbell rang and a man was at the door. Mrs. GARLAND HALLOCK inquired why he was at the home, and he stated he was a telephone repairman. Mrs. Game frightened and did not believe this person was a telephone repairman. She called the LASO, Malibu Station, and reported the incident. She was told by the Sheriff's Office that nothing could be done about the man coming to the door. Mr. HALLOCK did not know whether the man got into the house or not. He was vague in answering questions concerning his mother's activities after the alleged contact and did not know what else she might have done.

Mr. HALLOCK advised that Mrs. GARLAND is a widow and lives at home with her mentally ill daughter. He stated his mother has a day off today and is at an unknown location in San Diego. She can be contacted tomorrow at the GARLAND residence.

Mr. HALLOCK said he is residing temporarily at 3749 Glendon and does not have a phone at this address.

He said he was calling because he felt the FBI might have some interest in the fact that possibly an imposter was attempting to gain admission to the house next, door to where KENNEDY was staying. 156-SEARCHED ___

He stated the LAPD had indicated it was a 13 ridge count and the Identification Division had determined it was a 16 ridge count: The LAPD should be alerted to this fact and insure they search their records with the new 16 ridge count.

KERTIN subsequently advised that the police department had established that there was, in fact, a 16 ridge count and that there were also unusual patters on the left thumb and left middle finger (double loops). Writer received telephone call at 9:20 a.m. this date from REX SCHROEDER at the Bureau who advised that he had just observed Chief TOM REDDIN's press conference on the television and had observed REDDIN mention that during Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) interview of the suspect, the suspect had made reference to, on a number of occasions, the KIRSTIN (phonetic) or possibly spelled KIRSTINE (phonetic) murder case.

SCHROEDER stated that he wanted information developed regarding this murder case and the information telephonically furnished the Bureau immediately.

The writer contacted Supervisor KERTIN at LAPD who advised that the suspect had referred during his interview by LAPD to the KIRSHKE murder case which was a sensational case involving a double murder in the Long Beach area. KIRSHKE was a Los Angeles County District Attorney and was accused of murdering his wife and his wife's paramour in his home one evening. KIRSHKE was convicted in a jury trial and the case is now on appeal.

KERTIN advised that the suspect was merely making small talk regarding this case and made inquiry of his interrogators, one of which was a Los Angeles County District Attorney, whether they thought KIRSHKE would beat the case on appeal.

KERTIN stated that there was no indication that suspect had any connection at all with this case.

Sister JOANNE also stated that some time in the past year or two this woman has applied for a job as a Spanish teacher with instant school, and school records reflect address of 6514 Scotsgrove Drive, Palos Verdes Estates, where she resided with a Mrs. JACKSON, who might be her daughter.

Based on this, the Miami Office had the marriage records searched for LUCY HARRISON and came up with the following information:

There was an application filed 7/27/65, showing an ALFREDO ANZALDUA, born 12/10/40, Hargilla, Texas, and LUCY ANN HARRISON, born 7/27/47, Brownsville, Texas. ANZALDUA's address listed on the application was 761 S.E. 5th Place, Hialeah, Florida and HARRISON's address was listed as 491 East 55th Street, Hialeah, Florida.

HARRISON and ANZALDUA were married 7/31/65, by Rev. ANDREW ROMAN, 1776 N.E. 32nd Street, Miami, Florida. Witnesses were listed as MAGDALENA HARRISON and HENRY F. (last name illegible) JR.

LA 4688-S advised on 6/5/68 that WALTER S. CROWE, a member of the Youth Section, Southern California district Communist Party, had advised that he, CROWE, was a friend of SIRHAN SIRHAN and had attended school with him. According to source. CROWE stated that entire SIRHAN family has had problems in past; father is reportedly presently in Israel, one of SIRHAN's brothers attempted to kill girl friend by blowing up her car when she tried to break up romance, and younger brother has been in trouble with juvenile authorities.

CROWE also stated SIRHAN was extremely anti-Semitic in views but was generally left in his political thinking in that he was in favor of the Vietcong and supported some Communist Party ideals. SIRHAN reportedly is very erratic in his thinking.

CROWE alleged he had talked to SIRHAN approximately two weeks ago and had thoroughly briefed him on Communist Party activities at the University of California at Los Angeles and had told SIRHAN of his, CROWE's, activities and membership in the Communist Party. CROWE attempted to recruit SIRHAN into the Communist Party but SIRHAN allegedly has not engaged in any Communist Party or other subversive activity. CROWE alleged SIRHAN, at last contact, was very dejected and frustrated in that he realized he had made no progress economically or academically, whereas CROWE had recently graduated from the University of California at Los Angeles.

CROWE stated SIRHAN was formerly employed by the Santa Anita Race Track as a jockey or exercise boy but had been injured in a fall from a horse. CROWE expressed apprehension that SIRHAN, during questioning, might reveal his relationship with CROWE and discuss CROWE's Communist Party activities.
