

Stated that KHAN had contacted ELLIE SEBERSEN who had in turn contacted the FBI after she determined that it was an Jordanian who is apparently the subject of this case.

Stated that he was contacted by KHAN, telephonically about 8:00 PM this date who advised that he was going out of town to San <u>Kranssisses</u> Francisco but would be back in a couple of days. KHAN stated he wished to have dinner with HENEBRY when he returns. HENEBRY stated that this disturbs him as he is not well acquainted with KHAN and knows no reason why he should want to go to dinner with him.







At 3:10 p.m., Mr. ED RANDOLPH, 2241 North Beachwood Drive, Hollywood, California, advised that he had been to Hollywood Park Race Track on Saturday, 6/1/68, and had a casual conversation with an individual at the track. He states from the physical description of SIRHAN SIRHAN, which he has heard on the radio, he feels that SIRHAN possibly was the individual he talked to.

RANDOLPH stated the conversation occurred in the restaurant area below the stands and both had coffee. The individual was accompanied by a young girl approximately 10 to 12 years of age and in the brief conversation, he indicated that his sister was at the track with him and was "upstairs". He further indicated that he had had two tickets on a recent daily double and won a total of \$600.

Mr. RANDOLPH stated he would be able to state positively whether this was the individual if he saw a photograph of the suspect.

He stated he wanted to furnish this information as aspossible explanation for the source of the four \$100, bills in SIRHAN's possession when apprehended.

RANDOLPH concluded by stating that he had furnished this information to Chief REDDIN's office and also commented that he was a personal friend of Mayor SAM YORTY.



On 6/5/68 JAMES EDWARD BURN. Associate Pastor, Community Methodist Church, 918 West Avenue J, Lancaster, California, telephone number 942-0419, stated he presently resides at 214 East Nugent, Lancaster, telephone 942-4050.

BURN said he was formerly a Baptist Pastor and served as Associate Pastor under Pastor CHARLES BELL, First Baptist Church of Pasadena, 75 North Morengo Avenue, Pasadena. He resided at 743 East Howard Street, Pasadena, from about 1960 - 1965, during which time he was acquainted with the SIRHAN family.

Burn stated to the best of his recollection, Mrs. AIDA SIRHAN and her children came to the United States from Jerusalem in about 1960. The father, name unknown, remained in Jerusalem as he and AIDA apparently had marital problems. BURN said the only sons he can recall were named SiRhan SAIDALLAK, SHARIEF, and the younge**At** son MENTER. He said he believes there was a daughter who came to the United States with them but he is not certain of her name. It may have been MARY, however, she did not reside with the family in Pasadena.

BURN said he knew the family through his church, as the mother was a member and faithful in church attendance. He also saw them in the neighborhood as the SIRHAN family resided at 1647 North Lake and later at 696 East Howard, which was near his own residence.

Pastor\_BURN stated in reference to the attack on Senator\_ROBERT\_KENNEDY and the suspect\_SIRHAN, he does not ever recall hearing that name mentioned by the family.

He said inchis opinion, the suspect would perhaps be MUNIER SIRHAN. During the time he knew MUNIER, he bad several talks with him regarding belief in God. Museum appeared to be a very intense atheist and could see no logical reason to believe in God. BURN stated MUNIER also attended John Muir High School, Pasadena, during that period and was about a sophomore. He appeared to be very close to one of the high school teachers who furnished him with a great deal of literature to substantiate his beliefs in atheism. BURN said he does not know the name of this teacher but recalls that MUNIER considered him an authority on almost all subjects and perhaps associated with him as a substitute for his father. He said at the time be attempted to communicate with MUNIER, he felt MUNIER was receiving adult orientation, as many of his arguments were those used by adults.

BURN said the boys all seem to have a bitter attitude toward life, with the feeling that the world owed them a living. This was due in part to the resentment they had for their father who did not come with them to the United States.

He advised further that he did not recall any of the boys belonging to any organizations in the community. SIRHAMMENTER may have been a member of some club, but it would have been connected with John Muir High School.

BURN said the mother was employed by the Westminster Presbyterian Church near their residence. She worked in child care with the pre-school children. SHARIEF SIRHAN was employed off and on as a painter and he said he cannot recall where SAIDALLAK was employed.

The SIRHAN family was close friends with the (FNU) MOKHTARIAN family who resided near them on Elizabeth Street in Pasadena. BURN said he believes the two families were related in some manner.



FILIBERTO RIVERO, publisher of the semi-monthly Spanishlanguage newspaper, "La Prensa de Los Angeles," 822 N. Van Ness Avenue, Los Angeles, advised telephonically that he had learned from ALBERTO VELASCO, Cuban barber residing at 1409 North Edgemont St., Los/Angeles, the following:

VELASCO and several other flocal anti-Castro Cubans, attended including JOSE ANTONIO DUARTE, their leader (who resides at Apartment 15, 6643 DeLongpre Ave., Los Angeles), attended a meeting in a private residence somewhere in the Los Reliz district of Los Angeles about five weeks ago. The meeting was sponsored by an unknown erganisation but apparently American pro-communist organization. It was a meeting to which the public was invited and featured an American student who allegedly had recently been to Cuba. The student explained to those present how favorable conditions are in Cuba and exhibited photographs supposedly taken there to illustrate progress there under the Castro regime. DUARTE personally confronted the student, claiming both his remarks and photographs were "phoney" and presented a false picture. This caused a young man present, believed by DUARTE and the others to closely resemble if not actually be SIRHAN, to vehemently defend the student and the Castro regime against DUARTE's statements.

Attached is a copy of an FD 302 setting forth interview of RODERICK LYNN MAC KAY at Santa Monica, California.

On 6/6/68, RODERICK MAC KAY was interviewed by Sergeants W. J. ZANONE and L. F. GOFORTH, Intelligence Division, Los Angeles Police Department, concerning the address of 696 East Howard, Pasadena, California, which appeared on several documents in his possession. These documents related to draft counselors and anti-draft functions which were allegedly attended by MAC KAY. MAC KAY could not furnish the significance of the address of 696 East Howard and was not acquainted with SIRHAN SIRHAN, but felt that the address was furnished to him as a location where draft counseling could be obtained.

The original of these documents were obtained by Sergeant ZANONE and copies have been furnished to the FBI which are attached.

MAC KAY was subsequently interviewed by the writer and SA ORLEY A. LEESON, JR., and results of same are attached.
