Celebrity Service maintains comprehensive files on personalities in the entertainment industry and sells this information to the various major studios, radio, and television networks, news media, representatives and the like who subscribe to the service.

Mrs. GRIFFITH received a call at her home this afternoon at 1:45 p.m. from a GALE or GAIL ROSENBERG. who identified herself as a reporter for "Time" magazine. "Time" is a subscriber to Celebrity Service and the person authorized to receive information at the "Time" Los Angeles Office is MARY LOBERTO (phonetic).

ROSENBERG told Mrs. GRIFFITH she obtained her private home telephone number from Mr. and Mrs/EARL MEMORY of Lake Arrowhead, California (former neighbors of Mrs. GRIFFITH) whose daughter, Mrs. MALCOM KAUFMAN, holds an important position with "Time" magazine in New York City. ROSENBERG appologized for calling Mrs. GRIFFITH on Saturday, but insisted that it was an absolute necessity because she had a "hot tip that can't wait until Monday". Mrs. GRIFFITH said she has been so upset over Senator KENNEDY's death that she cut the ROSENBERG woman off before she could state her purpose. She hung up on ROSENBERG.

Mrs. MEMORY then told Mrs. GRIFFITH that "Time" magazine has information that three well-known motion picture actors, BUDDY EBSEN, DESI ARNAZ, and DALE ROBERTSON are well acquainted with SIRHAN SIRHAN and can furnish a good deal of information about him. Mrs. MEMORY was unable to elaborate about the type of relationship these personalities may have had with the alleged assassin.

PETER SELFE. 2851 Montrose Avenue, Apartment B7, La Crescenta, California, who has furnished reliable information in the past, telephonically contacted writer and furnished the following information:

SIRHAN SIRHAN hung out in Shap's Bar, 2565 Fast Colorado Boulevard, Pasadena, California. Shap's reportedly is a bar where one can place a bet on horse races and due to the fear of having the hand book operation discovered, everyone at Shap's is afraid to talk to law enforcement officers. SELFE stated that SIRHAN usually placed his bets on horse races at this bar.

SELFE continued he met at Shap's through SELFEIs: brother, one GEORGE BEILICKE, who reportedly is an acquaintance of SIRHAN. BEILICKE is described as a German alien, about 40 years old, 5'8", 170 pounds, dark hair, medium complexion, employed as a machinist at Rogers and Olling on Walnut Avenue in Pasadena, and drives a white Chevrolet sedan, license QAU 483.

SELFE stated that BEILICKE loaned \$75.00 to one of SIRHAN's Jordanian friends and that the Jordanian won't or can't repay the loan. BEILICKE approached the Jordanian with the \$75.00 and the Jordanian told him to leave him alone and threatened him with a knife. For this reason, BEILICKE is frightened and reluctant to talk about his relationship with SIRHAN's friends.

BEILICKE told SELFE that SIRHAN has five close friends he drinks with in Shap's Bar. He described them as two Jordanians, one Cuban, and two Americans. SELFE was unable to learn the names of these friends, but is certain BEILICKE knows them all.

SELFE continued that GEORGE is a German National with a "chip on his shoulder," has strong German loyalty, a complex about being a foreigner, and is hard to get into a conversation.

On 6/5/68, Mr. SAMUEL KING, Attorney's Office, Veterans Administration Records Center, Los Angeles, advised he had—caused a search of their records in the name of SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, aka SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, born found no record in that name.

Mr. KING suggested this office cause a check of the VA Central Locator, containing the names of all veterans throughout the United States, in Washington, D.C. He also pointed out if there was any record of outpatient medical treatment, the hospital where he was treated would have to be checked, as their records are separate from the central Los Angeles records in some instances.

At approximately 3:58 AM, I was in a conference room with COP TOM REDDIN, LAPD; DA EVELLE YOUNGER, Los Angeles County; EDWARD DAVIS, Deputy COP, LAPD; Inspector JON POWERS and MERT HOWE when there was a knock at the door. A uniformed officer advised Chief REDDIN that there was a call from the White House, at which time he excused himself.

Upon his return, Chief REDDIN called me out of the conference room and told me that the call was from Attorney General RAMSEY CLARK, who advised him that he was going to instruct the FBI to enter the investigation.

CLARK reportedly/told REDDIN that the reason for asking the FBI to conduct the investigation was not from a standpoint that there was criticism of the LAPD and their handling of this case but from the standpoint that it was felt the Federal Government should take some investigative action to make the people of the United States aware of the Government's interest in this crime.

Chief REDDIN told me that he advised the Attorney General that he would be most happy to cooperate with the FBI, and he advised me that he would welcome any investigative assistance of the Bureau.

During the afternoon of 6/5/68, Supervisor STILLING received a telephone call from the Sacramento Division advising that a set of fingerprints for SIRHAN SIRHAN dated 12/16/65 had been located in the records of CII, Sacramento. These prints were taken by the State Horse Racing Board when SIRHAN applied for a position as an excercise boy.

Supervisor STILLING was told that a copy of these prints would be placed on board PSA airline flight 182 at Sacramento 1:50 p.m. arrival time Los Angeles International in care of pilot captain GORE. A second copy of these prints in a separate envelope addressed to FBI, Washington, was to be on the same flight and the instructions were that PSA flight 182 be met, the two sets of fingerprints picked up; and the copy for Washington be delivered to the pilot of TWA flight 98 leaving Los Angeles 3:00 pm, arriving Washington, D.C. (Dulles Airport) 10:40 pm Eastern time.

SA GILBERT BENJAMIN met the above PSA flight and obtained the set of fingerprints for Los Angeles. Upon opening the envelope it was noted also enclosed was a Xerox copy of a Dealer's Record of Sale of Revolver or Pistol relating to a .22 caliber Lver Johnson Cadet Revolver serial # H53725 sold by the Pasadena Gun Shop, Inc., 300 block West Green Street. Pasadena, California to one ALBERT LESLIE MERTZ 8/10/65 (it is believed this refers to the revolver used in the attempted assassination of Senator KENNEDY).

It is assumed that duplicate copies of the above material were enclosed in the envelope for Washington; which was not opened, but was immediately delivered to TWA pilot captain SANDERS, TWA flight 98 which left Los Angeles as scheduled at 3:00 pm this date. 
