HUDSON ROLAND MOLLY, RA 198-77-933, Specialist 5, assigned Army Missile Test and Evaluation Agency, Hawk Project, White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico, on 6/7/68 advised SA HERBERT F. GREATHOUSE he attended Pasadena City College near Los Angeles, California, in 1963 and 1964 with SIRHAN SIRHAN. He knew him as an average student on the campus who appeared to have no particular ax to grind with respect to the Israeli-Arab situation and did not associate with Arab students but was friendly with everybody. He had no information as to any campus organizations or particular friends, female or otherwise, that this man had but recalled that he rode back and forth to school in SIRHAN's car with one BRUCE FULTON, now a soldier who is a Specialist 4 at Redstone Arsenal, Redstone, Alabama.

He could furnish no other associates by name and was of no further assistance in this case. Leads to interview BRUCE FULTON are not being set forth but are left to the discretion of Los Angeles.

Re memo to SAC from SA JOHN M. AGNEW dated 6/6/68.

On 6/6/68, PATRICIA ELIZABETH NELSON, JOSEPH THOMAS KLEIN and, on 6/7/68, DENNIS STEVEN WEAVER were interviewed in connection with captioned matter and separate FD-302s on each interview were prepared.

At about 12:10 AM to 12:15 AM on 6/5/68, PATRICIA NELSON claimed that she had seen an individual running out of the Embassy Room, Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California, carrying a package about 3½ feet long and 6 inches wide. From the rear of this package, there protruded a piece of wood which appeared to NELSON to be the stock of either a shotgun or a rifle. She does not know the difference between these two types of guns. She saw this individual before she knew Senator KENNEDY had been shot. The following is a physical description of this individual as furnished by NELSON:

JOSEPH THOMAS KLEIN, who was with PATTI NELSON and saw this same individual, was interviewed; however, he did not see the butt of a gun protruding from the package that this unknown individual was carrying. KLEIN stated that he was this same individual who ran from the Embassy Room the next day on the Frank Reynolds News Cast, ABC, Channel 7, 5:30 to 6:00 PM, 6/5/68.

On 6/7/68, WEAVER was interviewed concerning his comments in this matter.

On 6/7/68, SA LESLIE F. WARREN and SA BOGSTAD contacted Mr. WILLIAM P. MC SHERRY, Television News Director, ABC, 4151 Prospect Avenue, Los Angeles, California, telephone number 663-3311, and made arrangements to view the video tape of the Frank Reynolds News Cast. MC SHERRY stated that he would like to make a video tape of the three witnesses that were to view this tape. MC SHERRY was advised that this was up to the witnesses and the FBI could make no recommendation in this matter. MC SHERRY stated that if there was a news story in this matter that they, ABC, wanted to be in on it from the beginning. MC SHERRY was advised that if a video tape was to be made that the FBI was not to be involved in connection with the filming of it.

NELSON, KLEIN and WEAVER were taken by SA WARREN and SA BOGSTAD to view the above mentioned video tape. They were told that they, ABC, would like to make a video tape of their comments and that such appearance on their part would have to be of their own free will and accord.

The video tape of the Frank Reynolds News Cast was shown by MC SHERRY and staff. Each individual viewed the video tape separately and several times to insure ample opportunity to make an identification. NELSON and KLEIN both positively identified an individual on this film as being the individual they saw coming out of the Embassy Room of the Ambassador Hotel. WEAVER furnished a tentative identification of this individual.

After separate viewings of the above video tape, FD-302s were prepared on these individuals' comments.

After viewing this video tape, MC SHERRY advised NELSON, KLEIN and WEAVER that he would like to make a pilot

video film of their comments concerning the identification of this individual. WEAVER, KLEIN and NELSON were again advised that it was entirely up to them if they wanted to make this television film and that the FBI could not make any recommendations one way or another in this matter. NELSON, KLEIN and WEAVER agreed that they wanted to make this film. Agents were not present when the filming of the pilot film was made by ABC.

MC SHERRY explained that they did not plan to use this film at this time and that the only way that they would use it was if something did come up later concerning this identification which would make a news story.

On 6/7/68, Photo Lab Clerk RICHARD D. FERNANDES took pictures of the video tape which showed this unknown individual running out of the Embassy Room. The pictures obtained by FERNANDES are located in the 1A section of this file.

Enclosed herewith for Los Angeles Division are 16 photographs; eight of which were taken by free lance photographer PETER SPENCER BERKSON (those bearing number COA-75092 on reverse side) and eight of which were taken by Life Magazine photographer BILL EPPRIDGE (those bearing EPPRIDGE's stamp on reverse side).

On 6/8/68, RICHARD POLLARD, Life Photo Editor, Time and Life Building, New York, New York, made available to SA JOHN MILTON JONES the enclosed photographs. He stated that Life Magazine purchased the roll of Berkson film because it contained some overall photographs of the scene immediately following the shooting, which he said appears to be the only ones available to his firm as all other photographs taken by Life photographer of ensuing action of shooting scene are of victims.

POLLARD explained that colored film purchased from BERKSON is being developed in black and white and is currently in early process of this development, which according to him is quite time consuming. He said that in addition his photo laboratory is swamped with film to be processed of the current coverage being afforded the

funeral of ROBERT KENNEDY. POLLARD stated that when the BERKSON film was first received he edited the frames and selected about eight shots, of the corridor scene of the shooting and had these immediately developed. He made these photographs available and they are enclosed.

POLLARD advised that the BERKSON film contained some photographs of what appeared to be BERKSON's relatives in addition to the photographs BERKSON took at the Embassy Room and corridor to kitchen of Ambassador Hotel. He said that he would make available copies of all pertinent photographs taken on the roll by BERKSON at the Ambassador Hotel, but, that such photographs will not be available until early morning hours of 6/10/68.

POLLARD disclosed that Life Photographer BILL EPPRIDGE was assigned to cover the KENNEDY Campaign and was at the scene of the shooting and also obtained photographs prior to and immediately following the shooting. He made available eight photographs taken by EPPRIDGE, for whatever value they may be worth. These photographs are also enclosed.

POLLARD said that he understood that EPPRIDGE was very close to ROBERT KENNEDY at the time of shooting and that soon after Mrs. KENNEDY rushed to her husband's side she immediately asked the press and everyone to move back, but allowed EPPRIDGE to remain because she personally knows EPPRIDGE.

Enclosed photograph number 5, taken by BERKSON shows EPPRIDGE at right where small arrow has been placed on border edge. Photograph number 8, also by BERKSON, shows position of EPPRIDGE. A small x has been placed just above his head on border. He is person with camera to his eye.

POLLARD said EPPRIDGE generally is assigned ~~at~~ ^{of} their NYO and is currently with funeral coverage.

It is not known if EPPRIDGE has been interviewed and consideration is being left to discretion of office of origin.

Enclosed for the file is an investigative insert showing investigation conducted in Los Angeles.

The writer was given the lead to contact CHRISTINE R. MC DONAUGH, 510 N. Cahuenga concerning information received from Mrs. CAROL BRESHEARS, who was in charge of the "KENNEDY girls", who thought MC DONAUGH was the redhead in question who saw SIRHAN ejected from the kitchen area. BRESHEARS earlier received information from a man who identified himself as a reporter from Newsweek magazine who was trying to locate a "KENNEDY girl" who had red hair and observed SIRHAN being ejected from the kitchen on the night KENNEDY was shot.

No lead is being set forth to interview JAMES M. LOWE, 4620 Coliseum, as a previous lead has been set out to have him interviewed.

LEAD: Recontact CAROL BRESHEARS for additional assistance in identifying the red head who was supposedly contacted by a writer from Newsweek magazine.

Also obtain the address of GLORIA LOUJAN and interview her for any additional information with emphasis being placed on the identity of the red head.

The following investigation was conducted by
SAs WILLIAM R. WHITLEY and THOMAS G. MANSFIELD:

CHRISTINE R. MC DONAUGH, 510 North Cahuenga, Los Angeles, advised on 6/9/68 that she had been a "KENNEDY worker" and on the night Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY was shot she and her husband were in attendance at the Ambassador Hotel.

She advised that she and her husband WILLIAM arrived at the hotel at 7:48 PM, which was the time marked on her parking ticket. When she arrived she met with GLORIA LOUJAN in the hallway of the hotel and she agreed to take their purses to room ten of the hotel and wait for other "KENNEDY girls". She remained in room ten for approximately forty-five minutes and then went directly to the Embassy Room of the hotel. She was in the Embassy Room for about an hour when KENNEDY arrived. As the crowd began coming in she became separated from her husband so she and LOUJAN advanced to within six feet of the podium.

After she heard KENNEDY's speech and as he was leaving the podium to her right the crowd began pushing her to her left. Just as she was about four or five feet to the left of the podium, someone ran past her. The image was blurred and it was impossible for her to get any type of description. She then heard someone on the other side of the room scream KENNEDY had been stabbed. When she heard this three other men raced past her to her left pushing people out of the way in the process. She recognized one of the men to be JAMES M. LOWE, another "KENNEDY worker".

She said after this incident she and GLORIA made their way to some chairs to the left of the podium and sat down. They remained at this location until everyone was ordered to clear the room.

She said at no time was she near the kitchen area nor did she recognize anyone near the area of the kitchen.

She said she has not been contacted by anyone from Newsweek magazine.

She also advised that CAROL BRESHEARS has complete charge of the records pertaining to the names of the "KENNEDY workers". Some of the records contain photographs of the workers. She herself worked out of the Wilshire district and she said there could be other girls from other districts that might have ~~not been who could have been the individual who saw SIRHAN ejected from the kitchen area.~~

At approximately 8:20 A.M., 6/7/68, Mr. SCHROEDER called ^{The SAC} and advised a question had been raised as to the search conducted of SIRHAN's room; specifically, a teletype was requested summarizing this. The teletype should answer the following questions:

- (1) Who gave the consent to search the room and was it in writing?
- (2) Did the consent specify the search of the entire house or was the consent merely limited to the room SIRHAN occupied. Also, was he paying for this room?
- (3) Did whoever gave the consent specify that anything could be taken from the room?
- (4) Did the police department give a receipt for those items taken?
- (5) Did an Agent actually participate in the search. If he did there is no problem.

At this point SAC GRAPP advised there is a major problem ~~and that the Agent did not participate in the search~~ *according to info. received confidentially from local authorities and, in fact, tried to stop it.* There is no question the search is illegal and the prosecution cannot use the evidence obtained.

For Mr. SCHROEDER's personal information Mr. GRAPP advised that there is a disagreement between Mayor SAM YORTY and District Attorney YOUNGER. This is merely a smoke screen

to cover up the illegal search. Mr. GRAPP advised he can quote the deputy district attorney as saying it was an illegal search in the teletype, but this should not be disseminated outside the Bureau.

Mr. SCHROEDER stated no inquiries should be made but if the statement has been made it should be put in the teletype. *The teletype should state this info. if the confidential source, the A.D. & should not be disseminated.* This teletype should be sent as soon as possible.

Mr. DE LOACH has instructed we return the evidence to the police department by Monday. The fingerprint examination is still not done. Arrangements should be made to get this on the airplane along with copies of the examination, one for our office and one copy for the police department which will be turned over to them when we return the evidence.

Mr. GRAPP requested someone give him this authorization to turn these copies over to the police department. He was advised that a memorandum will be written at the Bureau concerning this authority. A cover letter will also be with the evidence stating it should be returned to the police department and give them copies of the laboratory report.

Los Angeles will receive photographic copies of this material.

Mr. SCHROEDER advised if we receive any evidence hereafter through our own investigative efforts, it should be

sent back to the laboratory. However, it will later be sent to District Attorney YOUNGER by cover letter over the Director's signature. This cover letter will be prepared in Washington and sent to Los Angeles for us to give to YOUNGER. A copy of the initial reports and subsequent reports should be available to YOUNGER provided they are in proper form. They will also be accompanied by a cover letter over the Director's signature. These reports will be checked over at the Bureau first and any errors corrected. The finished product will then be sent to Los Angeles for dissemination to YOUNGER.

The matter of writing the report was discussed with Mr. DELOACH. He had advised that security data has to be in the initial report and subsequent reports. It should be set forth in such a manner that there is a section in the report containing this information. However, this information should be set forth that when disseminated it will not divulge the existence of our sources.

Mr. GRAPP stated that there are pitfalls in this procedure as when YOUNGER gets this report it will more than likely go to the police department. They will have to have free and full access to it. The possibility exists that Mayor YORTY will also see it. Mayor YORTY has again made statements that this is the work of subversives and communists. Mr. DE LOACH was very adamant that this security data be in the report *according to Schuch*.

It was suggested that if there are any problems concerning this, they be resolved by teletype rather than calling the Bureau.

SHRODER was advised a teletype was being prepared summarizing investigation to this moment into that phase and would be sent to the Bureau today. It was suggested perhaps a decision could be made after investigation to date has been analyzed.

His wife, MUDALLALAH EID MUZHER SIRHAN, born Taybeh, 1904, not U.S. citizen. He listed his children in U.S. in 1960 as AMAD, KARIM, FAHIM, ADEL, GHAFER and ABED AID SALIM SIRHAN. He has also listed daughter NIHEM, born Taybeh 1/23/48. [S-1] [C]

SALIM's son, SIRHAN SALIM SIRHAN, born Jerusalem, Palestine, 6/15/34, claimed citizenship through naturalization of father, gave legal residence in April, 1957 as 1211 Hubbard St., Detroit. He was enlisted in U.S. Army in April, 1957, ASN RA 16 470 219, in Germany. He has sister, ALICE SIRHAN, born Jerusalem 4/15/38. [S-1] [C]

AID's daughter, NIHEM SALEM SIRHAN, born 1/23/48, at Taybeh, resided June, 1962, at Taybeh, where had been since birth. She spelled her father's given name as AYED rather than AID. She claimed citizenship through father's naturalization. [S-1] [C]

MIDDLE EAST SITUATION

A source who has furnished reliable information in the past on June 6, 1968, voluntarily furnished the following information concerning the Middle East Situation based on his observations of when he was in Syria and Lebanon in 1957 and 1958. The source noted that he has had no recent contact with the Middle East but that he wishes to furnish the following background for such value as it may be in regard to the murder of Senator Kennedy in Los Angeles.

The Syrian Communist Party was the center of Communist Party activities in Syria, Lebanon, and Jordan in 1957 and 1958, although each nation had its separate national organizations. At that time, the Communist Parties in Syria and Lebanon were semi-legal and completely illegal in Jordan. The head of the Communist Party in Syria at that time was an individual named Bagdash.

The source recalled that the Communist Parties in the Middle East in 1957 and 1958 were very fanatic and did considerable work among the refugees in Palastine, making them exceedingly corruptible. He noted that the refugees endured very much suffering and that they were easy to buy off with money and ideology.

Facts of complaint

C has known S's wife, **YOLANDA ABBASS**, home ph. 465-4638, for approx. a year. **YOLANDA** divorced **MIKE** in 1961, but has lived with him off and on until 6 months ago. She also operates an employment agency called **Yolandas Domestic Agency**, ph 624-9381. **YOLANDA**, in general conversation 2 or 3 months ago, related that **MIKE ABBASS** was very anti-KENNEDY. **MIKE** and others from Egypt hold secret meetings each week to collect and send money to their native country. At these meetings they also discuss their dislike for the US, its policies, and its leaders. **YOLANDA** described **MIKE** as a psychopath, with a violent temper and a person capable of killing someone. Because of the above, because **MIKE** has been arrested in L.A. for assault and due to the recent killing of **KENNEDY** C felt she should furnish this information to the FBI.

C stated she could furnish no further information, but felt **YOLANDA** should be contacted to determine if this matter might be pertinent.
