Facts of complaint

C. advised he is resident manager at above address. A tenant there, GILBERT MARTINEZ, works at the Ambassador Hotel, and was there the night of the KENNEDY shooting. He went home in tears, and has been upset ever since.

MARTINEZ has told C. that he was interviewed by the FBI, and he appears to be very upset about that, too. Recently, a salesman went to MARTINEZ's door, and MARTINEZ told C. he is certain it was not a salesman, but rather was an FBI agent in disguise.

Because of this experience with the salesman, MARTINEZ is planning to leave to return to Mexico. He told C. that he would pay 2 weeks rent, and from that C. assumes that he will be here for another 2 weeks.

MARTINEZ showed C. a shotgun he has bought to take to Mexico with him. He also told C. that he plans to drive his 1964 Chevrolet around Mexico City, as a taxi, for the summer Olympics. He is not certain whether he will decide to return to the USA.

C. advised that MARTINEZ resides in apartment 208, at 3030 San Marino, with his wife and children. He was born in 1938.

IRP report of investigation dated 8/23/56, at Amman, concerning ADEL BISHARA SALAMEH GHATTAS SIRHAN, brother of subject.

The Bureau is advised that identical copies of these investigative reports are being furnished to the Bureau through liaison channels by the Office of Security (SY), Department of State, on 6/6/68.

These documents were made available to SA KENNETH J. HASER on 6/6/68, by SA SIDNEY T. TELFORD of SY who obtained them from the Visa Office, Department of State.

Los Angeles will note that the investigative report concerning subject's mother points out that her case includes her sons SARHAN SIRHAN, subject, and his brother MUNIR SIRHAN. Los Angeles will also note that these investigative reports contain background information concerning members of this family. An apparent discrepancy is noted in that the mother's file states she has four children, all accompanying her whereas the file of BISHARA SIRHAN states that he had six children, none of whom would accompany him. It is believed that this is explained by the difference in dates of these respective reports.

On 6/6/68 Mr. AKELEY P. QUIRK telephonically contacted the Los Angeles Office and advised as follows:

He was referred to the writer by FLOYD NORRIS, Attorney, with offices at 714 South Hill Street, a personal acquaintance of SA WHITE's.

He, QUIRK, is an attorney and is associated with the Moriqui Exploration Company at 612 South Flower, Los Angeles, telephone 624-9685.

A friend of his, Dr. JOHN H. DAVIS, M.D., with offices at 10600 Wilshire Boulevard, West Los Angeles, telephone GR 8-0103, residence phone GR 2-6080, has told him of an individual that might be of interest to the FBI in view of the recent assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

^{Dr.}
Mr. DAVIS did some hospital work in Algeria a year or two ago through the U.S. State Department. While in Algeria, he became acquainted with a young Arab who later came to the United States for a visit and then returned to Europe. He, QUIRK, does not know this individual's name but he is about 25 years old and he attended some Arab League meetings while in the United States. This individual is technically not an Arab but a member of the Khabil tribe in Algeria. He, QUIRK, understands that this individual may now be employed at the U.S. Embassy in Paris, France. He speaks Arabic, French and English fluently. Mr. QUIRK stated that Dr. DAVIS could furnish more detailed information concerning this person.

Efforts to contact Dr. DAVIS on 6/7/68 were unproductive. On 6/7/68 Dr. DAVIS advised that the individual in question is known to him as "JEFF" DAKAR and is about 24 years of age and a member of the Khabil tribe in Algeria.

entered the United States in January, 1968 in New York and left in about May, 1968 to return to Europe. He was in the United States on a student visa. He believes this visa was obtained in Paris. DAKAR attempted to obtain permission to stay here as a student but was unsuccessful.

DAKAR visited in Dr. DAVIS' home while in Los Angeles and visited the campuses of UCLA and USC while here and also attended meetings of the Arab League. DAKAR was quite disturbed to find a strong anti-American feeling in the Arab League. Dr. DAVIS said DAKAR is very much pro-American.

DAKAR left Los Angeles in the spring of 1968 on a bus tour of the South and departed New York for Europe in May, 1968. He understands that DAKAR is now in Paris working for the American Embassy or a Bechtol (phonetic) Engineering Company.

Dr. DAVIS stated that he has photographs of DAKAR should they be needed.



On 6/10/68, SIMON SHAROU, date of birth 10/10/33 in Jerusalem, who resides at 452 North Euclid Avenue, Pasadena, and owns a barber shop at 48 North Lake Avenue, Pasadena, advised that ABDEL MAJED DOBOSS attended USC School of Journalism in the early to middle 1960s. SHAROU, who is Arameic, came to the United States in May 1959 and is now a U. S. citizen.

SHAROU said he is quite certain DOBOSS is now married and returned to Jordan about one year ago.

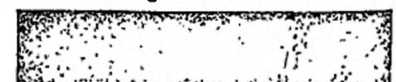

Rebutel dated 6/9/68, which, among other things, requested Los Angeles to locate and interview one MAJED GUSSOUS who, according to Bureau files, was President of the Young Arab Student Organization in Pasadena, in 1963.

Established source checks, INS, credit, criminal, Pasadena directories, and check of records of Registrar at Pasadena City College failed to develop any identifying information concerning this person.

On 6/10/68, SIMON SHAROU, 462 North Euclid Avenue, Pasadena, and owner of a barber shop at 48 North Lake Avenue, Pasadena, advised that the individual in question was probably named KUSSOUS or something similar, but not GUSSOUS. SHAROU said KUSSOUS attended Pasadena College (Nazarene) in the early 1960s and is believed to have returned to Jordan about two years ago. SHAROU is also from Jordan and knows KUSSOUS there.

At Pasadena College, the records of the Registrar reflected that this person's proper name is MAJED KHALIL GUSSOUS. His date of birth is shown as 8/27/34 to Madaba, Jordan. He attended Pasadena College from 1956 to 1960, graduating in 1960, and, according to information in the file, later attended Los Angeles College of Chiropractics at Glendale, California from 1962 to January 1963. While at Pasadena College, he resided at 1271 Morada Place, according to these records.

There is no information in the file concerning GUSSOUS' whereabouts or activities subsequent to 1963. A check of INS I-53 card on GUSSOUS is presently being made and information received therefrom will be included in this memo at the conclusion.

YASHUK was employed from March 1965 through December 1967, at Jack Davies Richfield Service Station, 2529 East Foothill Boulevard, Pasadena. SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN was employed at this station with YASHUK from March 1965 through November or December 1965.

YASHUK stated that a security guard with the Hough Security Patrol would guard the station nightly while the day's cash was placed in the safe, then the guard would leave the station.

YASHUK recalled that one particular guard was a very profane individual, and on one occasion SIRHAN asked this guard to tone down his profanity. The guard offered to fight SIRHAN, but SIRHAN would not fight this guard. YASHUK did not know the name of this guard.

Re FD-71 of SA GERALD F. MOORE dated 6/9/68, and complaints of one DOROTHY PINCZYKOWSKI.

DOROTHY PINCZYKOWSKI, 7235 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, California, advised she desired to call to the attention of the FBI certain observations of hers which she believed might be pertinent to the FBI's investigation of the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

She said from approximately October 1967 until December 1967, she had been employed in a secretarial capacity by the Lou Lesser Enterprises, which had office space at 901 Avenue of the Stars in Century City. She said this company has much money behind it, was involved in land development, and that one of the principle financial backers of the company was one HENRY SALVATORI, who is extremely wealthy.

She stated that while employed by this company she gained the impression that SALVATORI was very much in favor of the candidacy of RONALD REAGAN for president of the U.S., and she also believed he had contributed financially to REAGAN's campaign, although she stated she could not substantiate this information.

She said in doing her work for the firm she had been able to "read between the lines of various communications and believed this company was not completely honest, as she felt they do have secure of certain lands, zoning privileges and the like, may have offered bribes, at times even Cadillacs, in order to secure these gains. She said again she had no proof of this and that it was merely her own impression.

Miss PINCZYKOWSKI advised she is single, is 27 years of age, and that she considers herself to be quite intelligent. She said she had attended San Francisco City College in 1964, but did not graduate, as she quit when she failed a course, stating that the reason for her failure was that the professor did not understand her. She further stated the apartment in which she was now living was rather expensive, at about \$175 per month, and that she did not believe she would be able to maintain this apartment beyond her three month lease, but stated she had taken the apartment in the hopes of meeting some eligible males.

She stated she had been fired from her position with the Lou Lesser Enterprises in December 1967, no reason being given, but that it was her belief she had been fired because she understood the situation far better than the other girls, and that the company's officials feared what she might do.

Miss PINCZYKOWSKI discussed at some length the high taxes that the citizens of the State of California have had to pay during the administration of RONALD REAGAN, and that she feels that if REAGAN were elected president that the taxes would be even higher. She also stated she felt, in her own mind, that if REAGAN were elected that much of his policy making would be dictated by financiers such as HENRY SALVATORI of Los Angeles.

Miss PINCZYKOWSKI was questioned as to any information of any kind known to her which might link the Lou Lesser Enterprises, HENRY SALVATORI, or any other company officials, with the KENNEDY assassination, at which time she stated she had no information to furnish relative to this, other than her belief that any individuals contributing money to other political candidates may have had some interest in seeing KENNEDY assassinated.

A review of Los Angeles Office Indices reflects numerous references to HENRY SALVATORI, none of which are of derogatory nature. Reference 134-237, serials 35 and 37 contain information to the effect that in 1961 SALVATORI and his wife

donated to the University of Southern California the sum of \$325,000 for the establishment of "a research institution on Communist strategy and propaganda." The reference points out that SALVATORI was a trustee of the University and was founder and chairman of the building of the Western Geophysical Company, a subsidiary of Litton Industries, Inc.

Inasmuch as there is no positive factual information furnished by PINCZYKOWSKI relative to the KENNEDY assassination, it is believed no further inquiry in this regard need be pursued.

Her Son, BUD, who manages ranch advised SIRHAN unknown to him and according to his records has never worked or applied for work. Mrs. JOHNSTON'S husband advised her that SIRHAN may have worked as horse exercise boy for trainer who has stable space near theirs at Hwd Race Track. Mrs. JOHNSTON advised that her picture appeared on front page of Monday, 6/3/68, issue of Racing Form regarding a horse of hers, O'LUCKY YOU racing at Golden Gates Field, Albany, California.

According to Ray Williams, TRPB, Hwd Park Race Track, trainer mentioned above who SIRHAN worked for was GORDON BOWSHER, 13505 Oaks, Chino, Calif.

JERRY LEWIS LAMBERT, Jockey, Hwd. Park Race Track advised on 6/8/68 that photograph of SIRHAN B. SIRHAN unfamiliar to him.

On 6/10/68 JOHN H. STRATHMANN, 2800 Monterey Rd. San Marino, Calif., frequently a frequent associate of SIRHAN since attending Pasadena City College together in 1964. Both are linguist, and SIRHAN frequent guest of STRATHMANN and wife. Last saw SIRHAN about 6 months ago

SIRHAN very passive politically, except on one occasion he expressed an admiration for Adolph Hitler in his ability to get to the top so rapidly. SIRHAN criticized the U.S. because of existing poverty and difficulty to advance rapidly to wealth and success. SIRHAN seemed obsessed with idea that he wanted instant wealth and success. SIRHAN also very emotional in his attitude toward loyalty toward Arabs in Arab-Israeli conflict and criticism of US

SIRHAN and STRATHMANN studied Arabic and Russian languages together. SIRHAN was always alone when visiting STRATHMANN'S except on one occasion when he brought an Arabian, MUSTAFA (LNU) with him. MUSTAFA was from Lebanon and a Science or engineering student at PCC.

~~STRATHMANN~~ SIRHAN appeared to change considerably after his fall from a horse in 1966. He appeared to have difficulty seeing out of one eye, and seemed to be very impatient, nervous, and emotional. After the fall SIRHAN became interested in the study of Mystical bodies which he was studying with an individual named PAUL, who STRATHMAN never met. GRIER also stated that GEORGE PLIMPTON (phonetic) and BILL BARRY were wrestling with SIRHAN prior to the time GRIER disarmed him.

On 6/8/68, JESUS N. SALAZAR, SR., 4264 Alla Road, Los Angeles, California, advised the writers that HECTOR and JESUS SALAZAR, JR. are his twin sons, age 22 years, both of whom reside with him at the above address. SALAZAR stated that to the best of his knowledge, neither of his sons have any information concerning the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY, and neither was present at the Ambassador Hotel, in Los Angeles, on the night of 6/4 - 6/5/68.

JESUS JOSE SALAZAR, JR. advised that he and his brother, HECTOR, had been discussing the assassination of Senator KENNEDY, and he, JESUS, had mentioned to his brother that he had been at the Ambassador Hotel on one occasion, this being in February 1968, when his employer, Volkswagen Pacific, had held a company party there for all their employees. He advised that his brother had apparently misunderstood him and believed that he, JESUS, had been present at the Ambassador Hotel the night of KENNEDY's assassination. He added that he vaguely recalled his brother having mentioned something last night in regard to calling the FBI, but he had not taken his brother's remark seriously and was unaware that he had called the FBI.

JESUS stated that he had been at home in bed at the time of the assassination and definitely was not at the Ambassador Hotel on that night. He was unable to furnish any information whatsoever regarding the assassination. JESUS advised that he is presently employed by Rockwell, Incorporated, 6029 Slauson Avenue, Culver City, California.

HECTOR MANUEL SALAZAR advised that he and his twin brother, JESUS, had been drinking on the night of 6/7 - 6/8/68, and had been discussing the assassination.

He stated that his brother had made a remark about having been present at the Ambassador Hotel at the time of the assassination and having witnessed a man and a woman leaving the hotel immediately after the shooting stating, "We shot the Senator." HECTOR stated that he had attempted to have his brother call the FBI, and when he had refused to do so, he, HECTOR, had decided to make the call himself. HECTOR advised that he is presently unemployed.

It was apparent to the writers through interviews with both JESUS JOSE SALAZAR, JR. and HECTOR MANUEL SALAZAR, as well as with their father, that both JESUS and HECTOR had done a considerable amount of drinking the night of 6/7 - 6/8/68, and that both had been drunk at the time that they called the FBI Office in Los Angeles. Neither was able to recall exactly what remarks had been made concerning the assassination, and neither was able to furnish any information of value.

On 6/11/68, GRIER was interviewed by SAs JAMES CAGNASSOLA, JR. and WILLIAM P. CRAWFORD and the interview has been recorded on an FD-302.

During this contact with GRIER he indicated that on this date he received a telephone call from ETHEL KENNEDY who advised him that RAFER JOHNSON is presently in Washington, D.C. and will go to New York City. GRIER could not supply JOHNSON's current address and stated that the only method which he had of obtaining this information was through the KENNEDY family. GRIER was thanked for his cooperation and told that it was not our desire that he contact the KENNEDY family in this regard.

On 6/10/68, IRMA JOHNSON, sister of RAFER JOHNSON, was telephonically contacted and stated that she is not certain as to when her brother will return to Los Angeles. She requested to be recontacted on 6/11/68. On 6/11/68, IRMA JOHNSON was again telephonically contacted and stated that she has learned that RAFER JOHNSON will probably return to Los Angeles during the evening hours of 6/11/68 or morning hours of 6/12/68.
