Re Birmingham teletype to Los Angeles and Albuquerque, dated 6/11/68.

On Page 2 of referenced Birmingham teletype, reference is made to Specialist Five HUDSON MOLLAY and wife ANNETTE, Hawk Project, U. S. Army Missile Command, White Sands, New Mexico.

This individual is identical with HUDSON ROLAND MOLLOY, RA 198-77-933, Specialist Five, assigned Army Missile Test and Evaluation Agency, Hawk Missile Project, ACO, U. S. Army Garrison, White Sands Missile Range, New Mexico.

An interview with this individual has previously been set forth. Recontact with his wife, ANNETTE, reflects no additional information. They were only very casual acquaintances of subject SIRHAN SIRHAN at the time he attended the Pasadena City College, 1963 to 1964; were not associated closely with him; and only knew him as another student on the campus and really know nothing about him, other than that already set forth.

In view of this set of circumstances, no further inquiries are being made along this avenue by the Albuquerque Office.

Confidential informant DN T-1 has furnished reliable information in the past and is a student of the Arab-Israeli relations in the mid-East.

DN T-1 requested on June 14, 1968, that the following information be called to the attention of the United States Attorney, Los Angeles, California, and also the District Attorney at Los Angeles, who have the responsibility of prosecuting Sirhan Bishara Sirhan.

DN T-1 learned from sources in Los Angeles, Sirhan was in school in the Jordanian or Arab section of Palestine and because of this fact was subjected to Arab propaganda which no doubt was the motive which prompted his assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

DN T-1 advised that the prosecutors should contact the Israeli consulate in Los Angeles, and/or the Los Angeles office of the Anti-Defamation League for the purpose of obtaining documentary evidence that the Jordanian Government, the Egyptian Government, and other Arab countries, as a matter of policy, teach the Arab children the importance of vengeance and the necessity for the destruction of the Jews in Israel.

DN T-1 stated that Sirhan was born in Jerusalem in 1944, and that Sirhan is a refugee in the true sense of the word. Sirhan has been the victim of Arab invasion when he lived in Jerusalem and his early memory must have been of bombardment in the area of Jerusalem by the Arabs in 1948. The Israelis pushed the Arabs out of that part of Jerusalem and occupied the Jewish quarters under heavy Arab bombardment.

**ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY

Sirhan is supposed to be a member of the Greek Orthodox Church, but was sent to a Lutheran school. DN T-1 advised that this could have been a Sunday school and it is known that Arab hatred of the Jews was taught in those particular schools during those particular years that Sirhan attended the schools.

DN T-1 advised that when the Israeli troops entered the Gaza Strip in 1956, and when the Israeli Army entered those areas of Jerusalem in 1967, which had previously been under the control of the Jordanian Government, they found textbooks used to teach the Arab children hatred for the Jews.

DN T-1 listed an incident wherein the textbooks used in connection with the teaching of grammar, the first two verbs to be conjugated were hate and kill and the object of these two words was "Jews."

DN T-1 reported that there is documentary evidence that the Egyptians and the Jordanians taught the Arab children that the highest form of virtue and the most courageous act that they could commit was to "kill a Jew."

DN T-1 advised that there is an Arab proverb that is used by all the Arab people, namely, "A friend of a friend is our friend. A friend of our enemy is our enemy." DN T-1 pointed out that this, no doubt, was the cultural background of Sirhan and one of the reasons that caused him to assassinate Senator Kennedy, because Kennedy had made statements in California, during the political campaign, wherein he had supported Jewish cause over the Arab cause.

DN T-1 pointed out that Mohammed Mehdi, now Secretary General of the Action Committee on American-Arab Relations, stationed in New York, was formerly organizer for the Arab student groups in San Francisco, of 1965-1968. DN T-1 stated that Mehdi had the responsibility of making public speeches to American audiences to support the Arab cause, but his first responsibility was to travel throughout the State of California, speaking to Arab students and keeping them loyal to Arab nationalism.

DN T-1 has no information that Mehdi was an influence on Sirhan, but because of his public statements and because of his violent speeches made in California, he could have very easily influenced Sirhan.

DN T-1 advised that Sirhan's background and motive for assassinating Senator Kennedy could not be considered as a defense because he knew what he was doing and was prompted to do so for a political reason.

GERALD BRUNO, 210 Lansdowne Road, advised he was acting as an advance representative for Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY during the primary election campaigns and had acted in the capacity during the California primaries.

On June 4, 1968, he left the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California, about 10:30 p.m. and proceeded by taxi to the Los Angeles Airport. He boarded an 11:30 p.m. flight enroute to Buffalo, New York. During the flight, he was informed that Senator KENNEDY had been shot and he made arrangements to leave the flight at Cleveland, Ohio, and return to Los Angeles. He arrived back in Los Angeles about 10:30 a.m. on June 5, 1968.

He said he knew nothing of the itinerary or plans Senator KENNEDY had on June 4 or 5, 1968, as another advance representative was handling those details in Los Angeles.

At 2:28 PM, 6/20/68, Section Chief GEORGE H. SCATTERDAY, Name Check Section, telephonically requested the following information:

~~Local Washington newspapers disclose that RUSSELL E. PARSONS, age 73, prominent Los Angeles attorney, had been selected to defend SIRHAN SIRHAN.~~

SCATTERDAY stated that the Bureau has a DAPLI investigation entitled RUSSELL EDWARD PARSONS, aka Lester Harris, Los Angeles file 77-208, Bufile 77-9060; however, it is not possible to establish whether the individual who is to defend SIRHAN is identical with the above case.

SCATTERDAY instructed that Los Angeles endeavor to promptly develop background on SIRHAN's defense attorney from review of Los Angeles files and that no outside inquiry should be made.

SCATTERDAY stated that the results thereof should be sent by teletype to the Bureau captioned, "RUSSELL E. PARSONS, MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING, ATTN: NAME CHECK SECTION." It should not be sent in captioned matter.

EDWARD GREEN, President, Sawyer College of Business, 323 West Eighth Street, Los Angeles, California, advised that a search of the files of the Sawyer Schools in Los Angeles and in Pasadena failed to reflect any enrollment or attendance to that school by anyone using the name of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

GREEN stated that he was certain that if this individual had attempted to register or enroll at the Los Angeles school during the last two or three years then he would have recalled the name, as all applications must go across his desk.

It was ascertained through a resident of 465 North El Molino, Pasadena, California, on June 19, 1968, that HAMZEH is employed in the TV department of Robinsons Department Store, 777 East Colorado, Pasadena, California.

HAMZEH was contacted on June 19, 1968, at his place of employment for an interview. HAMZEH who gave his date of birth as August 3, 1942, Tripoli, Lebanon, advised that he was interviewed for one and one half hours approximately one week previous by SA DAVID H. COOK. He stated that he furnished all of the information that he had pertaining to SIRHAN SIRHAN to SA COOK at the time.

The interview was then discontinued.

For information of San Diego, it has been alleged that SIRHAN SIRHAN purchased ammunition which was used to assassinate Senator KENNEDY from the Lock Stock and Barrel Gun Shop, San Gabriel, California on 6/1/68,

At the time of the purchase, SIRHAN was possibly accompanied by two other individuals described only as short, dark, foreign looking and in their early to mid 20's.

The Lock Stock and Barrel Gun Shop is owned by BENJAMIN J. HERRICK and his wife DOXA. On 6/1/68, Mr. HERRICK was at the store and was visited by Mr. and Mrs. RICHARD L. HINELINE, 606 Circle Drive, Solana Beach, California. The HINELINES are the mother and stepfather of Mrs. HERRICK.

Witnesses to the purchase of the ammunition are unable to state what time the purchase was made. Mr. and Mrs. HINELINE are believed to have come to the store around 2:00 p.m.

The San Diego Division is requested to contact the HINELINES, determine the time they were at the store

Mr. JAMES MC MANUS, 410 Conduitt Drive, Mooresville, Indiana, advised that he went to Los Angeles, California, on Wednesday, May 29, 1968, from Oregon where he was working on the KENNEDY primary. MC MANUS said he accompanied the motorcade to downtown Los Angeles where he stopped at the Ambassador Hotel for the assignment in the California primaries. MC MANUS said that he was assigned to make arrangements for a working press room which was the Colonial Room of the Ambassador Hotel and a press distribution center which was the North Room of the Ambassador Hotel. MC MANUS stated that he was assisted by ROY RINGER of Malibu, California, and that in addition to making arrangements for the above-mentioned rooms, he and RINGER took over the registration desk of the hotel from approximately 6:00 PM, May 29, 1968, to 1:00 AM, May 30, 1968.

MC MANUS said that sometime between 9:45 and 10:30 PM, RINGER suggested that they take a break by going for a drink to a free bar which was set up near the Embassy Room of the Ambassador Hotel. MC MANUS said while sitting at a table near the free bar, a young man described as 5'3", 120 pounds, dark complexion, with heavy well-groomed black hair, wearing a sport coat with blue stripes and contrasting trousers and a dark tie open at the neck, approached him and asked for the schedule of Senator KENNEDY for the two following days, May 30 and 31, 1968. MC MANUS said his first thought was "what's a Mexican American reporter doing here in Oregon", but then he recalled he was in California. MC MANUS answered that he did not have the schedule but that the individual could obtain the same by going to 5615 Wilshire Boulevard or calling there. MC MANUS stated that the individual then asked what time the Senator would be in that evening, to which MC MANUS answered 11:00 PM. MC MANUS said he then assumed that the individual worked for a radio station in that radio stations send young people who are inexperienced whereas newspaper media are more apt to send older, more experienced personnel. MC MANUS stated that the individual had a Wednesday schedule in his right coat pocket and that he said, "I have today's schedule".

MC MANUS advised that he went back to the registration desk of the hotel at approximately 11:00 PM, whereupon the press contingent came up the stairs. MC MANUS said that he thought the Senator was back in the hotel at this time because of the return of the press contingent.

MC MANUS said he checked people in until approximately 1:00 AM, May 30, 1968.

MC MANUS recalled that he saw the individual the second time between 11:00 and 12:00 during a short trip to the North Room at which time the individual again asked the question regarding the Senator's schedule, whereupon MC MANUS informed him that he must go to 5615 Wilshire Boulevard to obtain the same.

MC MANUS further stated that sometime after he saw the first individual (probably Wednesday morning or early afternoon) two Latin types described as well dressed, olive skin, thin faced, well-groomed dark hair with long sideburns, and wearing dark business suits, also asked for the schedule. MC MANUS added that these two individuals looked enough alike to be cousins.

MC MANUS advised that he left on Thursday afternoon to go to New York City for campaign arrangements there.

Upon being exhibited a photograph of SIRHAN SIRHAN, MC MANUS said that the face on view looked like the first individual, but that he could not be positive. He, MC MANUS added that the photograph looked a little messed up and that he had the impression that the first individual mentioned above may have had longer sideburns; however, he added the photograph of SIRHAN SIRHAN seemed to him to not be totally unfamiliar. MC MANUS said that the photograph of SIRHAN SIRHAN did not in any way resemble the two Latin types mentioned above.

MC MANUS recalled that his first reaction after seeing news media photographs was that he vaguely remembered seeing someone very similar to SIRHAN SIRHAN.

MC MANUS further stated that he could not be certain if it was the first individual in the Ambassador Hotel the night of May 29, 1968, but someone was wearing a pair of dark brown buckle loafers, with a sheen, made of large grain leather with the buckle across the instep. MC MANUS added that he appreciates good shoes, and that for some reason these stood out in his mind, perhaps because they were uncared for.

MC MANUS finally stated that it was possible that ROY RINGER of Malibu, California, may have seen and could recall the first individual mentioned above. MC MANUS added that he did not know

what RINGER's address was; however, he was sure that he, RINGER, could be contacted through PAT BROWN's Law Office, in Los Angeles, California.

MC MANUS further added that either LISA GWIRTZMAN and/or CONSTANCE CHANCELLOR were present when the two Latin types asked for the Senator's schedule of May 30, 1968. According to MC MANUS, LISA GWIRTZMAN lives in New York City and could be contacted through her husband MILTON GWIRTZMAN of Dutton, Gwirtzman, and Wise (phonetic) Law Firm of New York City; and that CONSTANCE CHANCELLOR could be readily found in the Washington, D. C. telephone book, although her address at that time was unknown to him.

Re memo of SA RICHARD P. DOUCETTE dated 6/8/68, and FD-302 of DAVID MARK ESQUITH.

On 6/13/68, Mrs. JUNE ISACKSON, Headquarters, Kennedy for President, 5615 Wilshire Boulevard, advised that she has known ANN FERGUSON and Mrs. TIFFANY JONAS through her work at campaign headquarters. She did not know their addresses but furnished the following telephone Numbers:

Mrs. ISACKSON could furnish no information concerning BILL COX, VICKY CUCCIA, RICHARD ROSEN, or AL ROTHSTEIN; however, she suggested that Mrs. TIFFANY JONAS may know where they could be contacted.

The man by the name of DAVID (LNU), described by DAVID MARK ESQUITH as being an exercise boy at the race track; according to Mrs. ISACKSON, was undoubtedly DAVID BARRETT. BARRETT was active at the Kennedy Headquarters during May and June, and was presently a student at the Yamano Beauty College, 5653 Wilshire Boulevard.

She advised that the name SIRHAN SIRHAN is vaguely familiar to her and that it may have been the name of a tenth grade student in her algebra class in 1960. She advised that she cannot recall anything specific about this individual except that his first and last name were the same and for this reason believes that he must have been an average student. She pointed out that if there was anything unusual about him she may remember it, but that she probably had him in her class for only one hour per day and could not remember anything specific about him.
