In regard to the inter en requested with DOYLE TRIMAN CALLY is set forth in referenced communication, we following is noted:

On June 17, 1968, the Houston Office opened an impersonation case on CHANEY based upon telephone call to the Houston Office from the Galeston, Texas, Police Department early morning of 6-17-68, in which CHANEY was arrested by Galeston Police Department, 6-17-68, on a charge of drunk and it was alleged CHANEY claimed he was an FBI Agent and working on the KENNEDY assassination.

The following investigation was conducted by SA CARLOS L. KIRBY, JR., at Galeston Texas:

Og June 17, 1968, Sergeant ARTHONY OLARDO, Galveston Poller Dentions, advised that in the early morning of June 17, 1968, DOYLE TRUMAN CHANEY, while driving in Galveston, stopped a G leston

Police Officer and requested that a vehicle he was allegedly was following be stopped He stated CHANEY appeared to be drunk and was arrested and transported to the G lyeston Police Station. SOLANDO advised he inter ewed CHANEY and that CHANEY claimed he was working with the FBI in connect on w th the KENNEDY assassination and had been following a car, li ense number unknown to CHANEY. SOLANDO stated in his opinion, CHANEY was definitely drunk when arrested and furthermore from his interview and observations, he believed CHANEY to be a "nut." He advised the drunk charge against CHANEY was dismissed.

CHANEY was interviewed on June 17, 1968, by SA CARLOL L. KIRBY, JR., and furnished the following information:

He advised that he resides at Route 8, Box 860, Houston, Texas, and is employed as a maintenance employee at Childers Manufacturing Co., Houston. H stated on 6-16-68, at about 11:30 pm, he was at the Texan Drive-In located on Hempstead Highway, Houston, Texas, when he observed a white Ford station wagon, bearing California license number unknown, parked at a telephone booth near the drive-in. H stated there were two males and 1 female occupants in the vehicle. He advised that it was dark and he does not know their race. He stated that he overheard some of their conversat on and one of the male occupants remarked to the driver of the chicle that if you don't dri e me to Vinton, Louisiana, I'll bring up that California thing. He stated the vehicle then departed from the dri e-in and advised that since the vehicle bore California livense, he thought it might have something to do with the KEHNEDY assassination. He advised that he then followed this vehicle in his car, hoping that he would observe a police officer and continued following the car through Houston on Highway 75 to 6 1 eston, Texas, arriving in **Ollect n at about 1:30 a.m. on June 17, 1968.** He

advised that he did not get close enough to the car to obtain the license number, claining that he was afraid. He stated upon arriving in Galveston, he observed and stopped a police officer and told the officer to "stop that car, I have been following He stated the officer then took him to the It Gal eston Police instion and charged his with being drunk. He advised that he was not drunk to his kno ledge, but had been drinking four of fi e beers. He stated that he definitely did not at any time claim that he was an FBI Agent and the only thing he told the officers was that he was trying to contact the FBI. He further advised that he is not an employee of the FBI or any other branch of the U.S. Go ernment and has never been an FBI employee. CHAREY stated he had no further information concerning the occupants o the white station wagon, heard no remarks regarding the RENNEDY assausination and that he only assumed that they may have been associated with it. He stated he told the same story to the Judge at the Corporation Court at Galactop and the drunk charge was dismissed.

AUSA ROMALD J. BLASK, How ton, Texas, declined prosecution concerning the impersonation matter, stating no violation of the impersonation statute.



HIRPARD on the particular date in question., and that Miss SMITH had no recollection whatsoever of waiting on a customer fitting the desciption of the subject, in this case, nor did she had avy recollection of waiting on a customer who exchanged a roll of smaller denomination bills for several \$100 bills.

Mr. WEIR stated that he has discussed this matter with WILLIAM BECKER, manager of this branch and that they have no reason to believe that the subject of this case has been dealing at this bank on any kind of a regular basis.

On 6/17/68, Mr. EIMAND GREEN, Hickory Lane, Binghamton, N.Y., furnished the following information:

He graduated from St. Gregory's College, Shawnee, Oklahoma, a two-year school, during the first week of June, 1968, and returned to his parents' home in Binghamton, N.Y. On a Sunday night in May, 1968, possibly 5/12 or 5/19/68, television comedian DICK GREGORY was on the campus of St. Gregory's College giving a talk at the gymnasium and GREEN heard part of it. After GREGORY's talk, he went to the Commons and spoke to a large group of students numbering about 150, according to GREEN, and GREEN walked in during the middle of this talk by GREGORY.

GREGORY made some comment about Mayor LINDSEY of New York and Sen. KENNEDY of N.Y., would be shot before the election. GREEN did not hear the entire talk, but on the rollowing day discussed it with 2 of his classmates, GREGORY SMITH, 119-18 232nd St. Cambria Heights, N.Y., telephone 528-2924, and CHARLES SHIRO, 100 Ludlow Ave., Spring Lake, N.J., 449-7828.

GREEN stated he personally did not hear GREGORY make the statement, but did hear a student question GREGORY abot what GREGORY had just said, and GREGORY replied that he had received the informatin from a reliable source. GREEN

is certain it had something to do with Sen. KENNEDY and Mayor LINDSEY, and the comment was made by GREGORY that they would be shot before the election. During the discussion the following morning, GREGORY SMITH stated he had heard the entire talk and commented that GREGORY allegedly said either Mayor LINDSEY or Sen. KENNEDY would be shot.

GREEN stated he left the campus in Shawnee, Oklahoma, a few days before the assassination of Sen. KENNEDY and was enroute to his home in Binghamton, N.Y., when he heard the news of the assassination. Therefore, he does not know what reaction took place on the college campus after the assassination. He said he felt that there was somewhere between 100 and 200 students, in the Commons Meeting Hall when GREGORY allegedly made his statement.

Albany indices contain no information regarding this incident and it is being furnished to the Oklahoma City Office for action deemed advisable by OC. No further investigation being conducted by Albany Office.

	The enclosed photographs are of SIRHAN B. SIRHAN and of a mob of students mixed with police at Columbia University, New York City. The letter points out a similarity in looks between the newspaper photograph of SIRHAN and one of the individuals in the photograph of the Columbia University students and police. The student in the mob scene is seen standing near student leader MARK RUDD and is designated on the photo by a check mark.
	The anonymous letter did not contain the date or the name of the newspaper from which the student-police scene was taken. It is indicated that it is a UPI photograph.
	The above data is being set forth for information. No leads are being set forth for the New York Office inasmuch as this is being left to the discretion of Los Angeles, which office may have information relative to recent activities and travel of SIRHAN, thereby positively eliminating the possibility of his presence in the spring riots at Columbia University, New York City. ARCHER. 7306 El Redondo Circle, Buena Park, telephone number 521-3507, telephonically advised the office, 7:55pm, that a few days before Senator Kennedy was killed, his, (ARCHER'S) brother in law, John Mc Carthy, telephone number, 637-1659, made numerous statements to the effect that Kennedy would be killed in Los Angeles, and made references to Jordan and Jodanians

ARCHER stated that when he told Mc Carthy that the FBI should be advised about his statements, Mc Carthy became irate, and stated that he (MC CARTHY) would have to call his employer, because his employer did not want the FBI to know about this. ARCHER advised that he does not know MC CARTHY'S employer nor the actual address of MC CARTHY, but that the above listed telephone number for MC CARTHY is accurate.

The above information is being furnished for appropriate action by the supervisor.
