

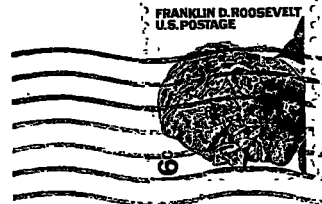

On 6/21/68, Dr. NATALIE GUNKEL, 905 Southeast 15th Street, Fort Lauderdale, Fla., advised SAs ROGER B. COLTON and EUGENE L. PAYNE that she taught German at Muir High School, Pasadena, California, from 9/60 - 6/61.

She stated she does not recall SIRHAN SIRHAN as being a former student, and was unable to identify his photograph. She advised she had seen pictures of SIRHAN in newspapers and magazines, but did not associated him as having been a former student of hers.

She continued that even if she could recall SIRHAN, she would have no information regarding any background nationalistic tendencies he might have possessed.

She reiterated she could not recall SIRHAN, and could furnish no information whatsoever concerning him.

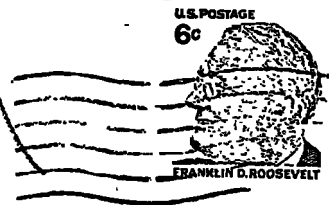

The letter reads as follows:

"A Man by the Name of Frank Quartucci of Pasadena California Gave the four hundred dollars to Sirhan Sirhan, to kill Senator Robert Kennedy in California, I can not give you My Name because My family Would be in danger."

Enclosed also are two copies of the letter dated 6/24/68 from Secret Service wherein the anonymous letter was forwarded to the Bureau.

The original of the anonymous letter is being searched in the Anonymous Letter File by the FBI Laboratory and you will be advised of the results.

Bureau indices contain no information identifiable with Frank Quartucci.

Conduct appropriate investigation, advise Bureau promptly of results and include investigation conducted in your next investigative report.

1. JERUSALEM POST REPORTS JUNE 14 BISHARA SIRHAN "IS THINKING OF GOING TO U.S." FOR SON'S TRIAL. STORY SAYS SIRHAN YESTERDAY APPLIED TO RAMALLAH MILGOV FOR PERMIT TO VISIT AMMAN (AND HAS SINCE, WE UNDERSTAND, RECEIVED IT). IT ADDS HE WANTED TO MAKE VISIT "TO DRAW SOME MONEY FROM PRIVATE BANK ACCOUNT" WHICH HE WOULD NEED IF HE DECIDED TO GO TO U.S. RELIABLE AMERICAN NEWS-MAN TELLS ME HE HAS "CLEAR IMPRESSION" SIRHAN THINKING ABOUT U.S. TRIP AND UNDERSTANDS HE HAS MADE SOME INQUIRIES IN RAMALLAH TRAVEL AGENCIES.

2. EXCEPT FOR BRIEF VISIT TO SIRHAN TO CARRY OUT INSTRUCTIONS IN STATE 178228 CONGEN HAS STAYED STRICTLY AWAY FROM SIRHAN TO AVOID STIMULATING SPECULATION AND HAD ALREADY DECIDED TO PROCEED AS OUTLINED IN STATE 182633. HOWEVER, WE ASSUME THAT THE DEPT WILL UNDOUBTEDLY DECIDE IN FAVOR OF ISSUING VISITOR'S VISA IF SIRHAN APPLIES. ANY REFUSAL TO DO SO WOULD CREATE IRRESPONSIBLE SPECULATION IN THIS AREA AND PROBABLY ~~AL~~ OVER THE WORLD. IF OUR ASSUMPTION IS CORRECT IT WOULD SEEM SENSIBLE FOR THE DEPT TO AUTHORIZE US IN ADVANCE TO ISSUE A VISA IN THE USUAL WAY AND IN THE NORMAL TIME. ANY EXTENDED DELAY IN ISSUING

A. VISA WOULD CAUSE SPECULATION SINCE U.S., HEBREW AND INTERNATIONAL PRESS IS CLOSELY WATCHING SIRHAN'S MOVEMENTS. ACCORDINGLY I SUGGEST DEPT AUTHORIZE IN ADVANCE ISSUANCE OF VISA IF AND WHEN SIRHAN APPROACHES CONGEN OR EMBASSY AMMAN.

3. WE HAVE NO HARD EVIDENCE WHATSOEVER THAT SIRHAN INDEED INTENDS U.S. VISIT. HE HAD NO VALID VISA IN JORDANIAN PASSPORT WHICH HE SHOWED CONGENOFF. HE COULD NOT ENTER ON HIS ALIEN REGISTRATION CARD SINCE HE HAS BEEN OUT OF U.S. MORE THAN ONE YEAR. BOTH HE AND ISRAELI AUTHORITIES, ACCORDING TO PRESS, HAVE DENIED HE HAS APPROACHED GOI FOR TRAVEL DOCUMENTS.

4. WE WILL FOLLOW SITUATION CLOSELY AND REPORT HARD INFORMATION BUT BELIEVE WE SHOULD BE MORE THAN USUALLY WARY OF PRESS STORIES WHICH TEND TO KEEP ALIVE THE LOCAL ANGLE TO KENNEDY ASSASSINATION.

1. WE APPRECIATE SENSITIVE POLITICAL IMPLICATIONS INVOLVED IN PROSPECT JORDANIAN LAWYERS BECOMING INVOLVED IN SIRHAN CASE.

2. ALTHOUGH THEY ARE PALESTINAIAN, AT LEAST TWO OF THE LAWYERS, FUAD ATALLAH AND AHMAD AL-KHALIL, MENTIONED IN LOCAL PRESS ARE GENERALLY WELL-BALANCED AND MODERATE INDIVIDUALS. THEY ARE ALSO ABLE LAWYERS. WE BELIEVE RESPONSIBLE GOJ OFFICIALS WILL NOT NEED TO HAVE PICTURE DRAWN FOR THEM WITH REGARD TO POSSIBLY UNFORTUNATE POLITICAL RAMIFICATIONS INVOLVED.

3. ON BALANCE WE SEE NO ALTERNATIVE TO LETTING NATURE TAKE ITS COURSE. WE CANNOT CONTROL DECISIONS OF CALIFORNIA SUPERIOR COURT OR TRIAL JUDGE, IN ANY CASE. EVEN IF PRESENT JORDANIAN LAWYERS WERE DISSUADED IT IS QUOTE POSSIBLE OTHER ELEMENTS IN JORDAN OR ELSEWHERE MAY SEEK TO INFLAME ISSUE BY ENLISTING THEMSELVES IN SIRHAN'S DEFENSE.

JANE VENDOLA, daughter of Major LOUIS A. VENDOLA, 355 Auwinala Road, Hailua, furnished the following information:

On June 4, 1968, she and CANDY MACKAY traveled from Atlanta, Georgia, to Los Angeles, California, aboard Delta Airlines Flight 855. Their seats were in the third or fourth row in front of the lavatory and were on the left side of the plane for a person facing the cockpit.

Miss VENDOLA stated she made no statement which could have been interpreted to mean she was going to Los Angeles to be there "when the bullets fly around KENNEDY." Miss MACKAY made no such statement in her presence, and she heard no one else make any such statement.

She and Miss MACKAY had one hour at the Los Angeles Airport to make connection for their flight to Hawaii.

MACKAY's parents live near Calcutta, India, and CANDY continued to the Far East to join her parents. MACKAY's father's first name is unknown to VENDOLA. The only address she has for MACKAY is 249 Summers Avenue, Orangeburg, South Carolina. She stated mail sent to that address will be forwarded to MACKAY in India.

Both girls were students at the University of South Carolina.

VENDOLA is 18 years old, 5 feet 4 inches tall, weighs 115 pounds, has blond hair, and wore orange culottes.

On June 16, 1968, HARRY BAUM, 238 South Alexandria, Apartment 7, Los Angeles, (383-2684), advised that he attended a political rally at the Ambassador Hotel on Sunday night, June 2, 1968. BAUM explained that he was "in the main ball-room" which was filled to a capacity crowd and noted that he was standing directly in front of the stage. He related that he moved back in order to allow Senator KENNEDY and singer, ANDY WILLIAMS to get on the stage.

BAUM explained that while he was standing in the crowd waiting the arrival of the Senator he observed a white female in a polka dot dress standing approximately ten feet from him. He stated that during the time the Senator spoke this woman sat beside him on the stage. BAUM noted that inasmuch as efforts have been made to locate a white female who wore a polka dot dress on the night of the assassination, he felt he should come forward with this information and furnished the following physical description:

Height	5'10-11"
Build	Slender
Hair	Could only describe as light in color
Clothing	Wore white dress with black polka dots; described dress as not tight and not loose; 3/4" length sleeves; length slightly below knees, not stylish or low cut.

BAUM was unable to furnish specific details concerning the type of polka dots on the above dress and pointed out that inasmuch as he did not take particular note of the woman at the time, he is unable to determine whether or not she was accompanied by any other persons. He noted that when the rally concluded, he did not see this woman again.
