At Honolulu, Hawaii

JANE TOKUNAGA, Chief Clerk, Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), was unable to locate any record in her files regarding CLIFFORD FLITTIE or FLITTY, who was on Qantas Airways Flight 530 from Sydney, Australia, to London, England, 6/5/68.

She commented that if this individual were a U.S. citizen, she would have no record of him in her files.

PHILLIP PIPER, Investigator, U.S. Customs, was unable to locate any record of CLIFFORD FLITTIE or FLITTY, who was on Qantas Airways Flight 530 from Sydney, Australia, to London, 6/6/68.

He commented that if there were such an individual on this flight and stopped at Honolulu, there

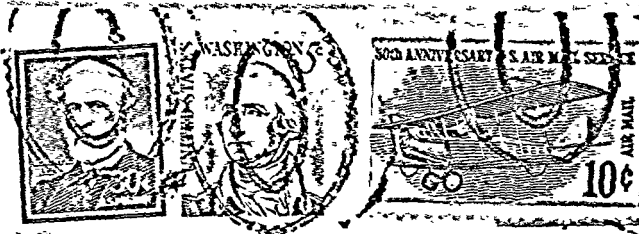

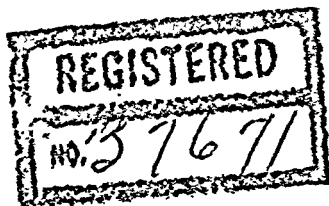

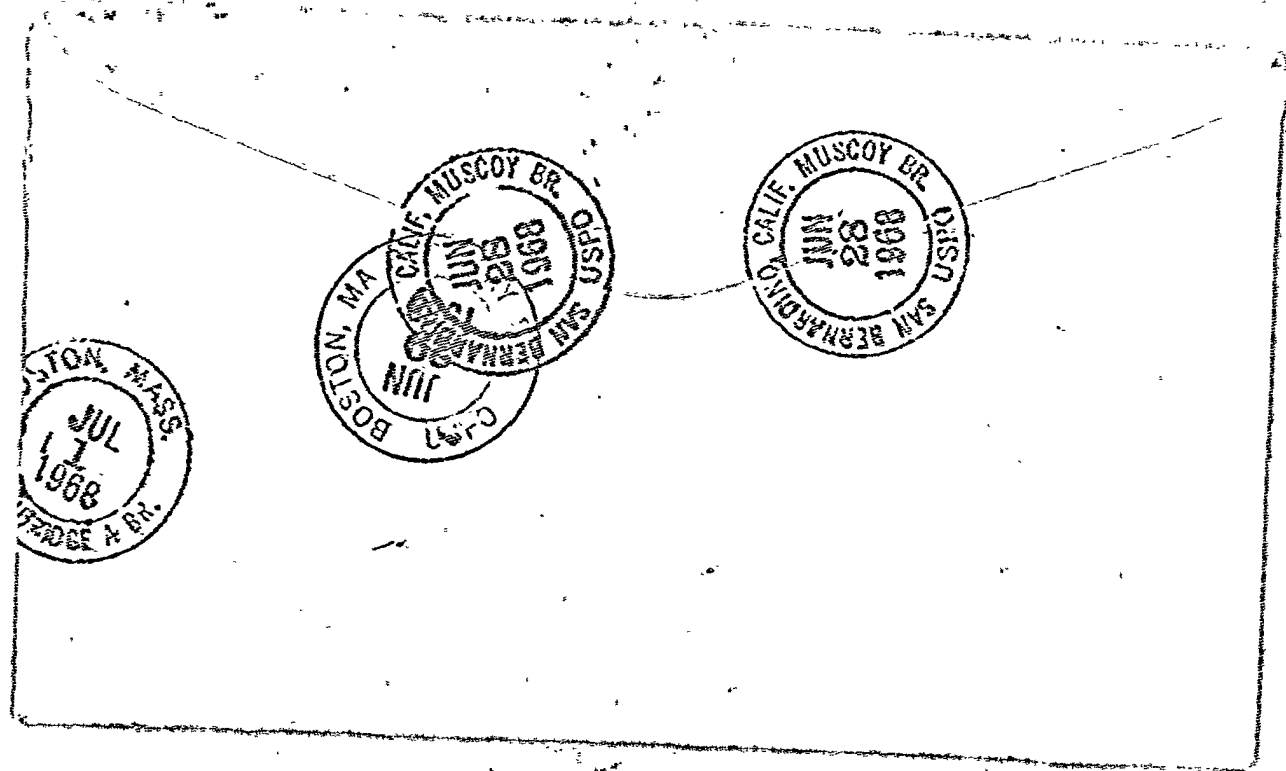

Re complaint form dated 6/24/68(Serial 924).

On 6/26/68, ~~THOMAS MINNOCK~~ advised telephonically that he had contacted the Los Angeles Office of the FBI because he had heard through a friend in Pomona, Calif., that an FBI Agent had been interested possibly in locating photos taken on 5/20/68, the occasion of a reception in Pomona for Senator Robert Kennedy, to determine the possibility that Sirhan Sirhan might have been in the crowds. He related that he would examine the films of movies taken by him on the Mall on that date to determine if any of the footage might be of value in this regard.

On 7/17/68, MINNOCK said that he had gone over all of the film taken by him and had been unable to locate anyone in any of this film who could be identified with Sirhan.

Sergeant MIKE NIELSEN of the LAPD made available the results of a tape recording interview of JOSEPH A. LA HIVE. This interview took place on 6/21/68 and concerns LA HIVE's knowledge of events relating to the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

In the course of this interview LA HIVE mentioned that CAP HARDY or HOWARD HARDY who works for Councilman ED EDDLEMAN and BURT SPICEMAN were also present at the Ambassador Hotel on the night of the assassination.

Re San Francisco airtel to Los Angeles dated 6/20/68, with enclosure of one copy of a reprint entitled, "The Grapes-Communist Wrath in Delano," by GARY ALLEN.

On 7/12/68, ROBERT LEAMAN, Regional Coordinator, John Birch Society, 2627 Mission Road, San Marino, California, advised that one of their members, DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, had telephoned him to advise that he thought the photograph on page 4 of the referenced booklet written by GARY ALLEN looked a lot like SIRHAN SIRHAN.

LEAMAN furnished the address of the author, GARY ALLEN, as 2812 Tigertail Drive Roosmoor, California, telephone number 430-2282.

On 7/12/68, ALLEN advised he wrote the referenced article for the June 1966 issue of American Opinion, an informal monthly review edited by ROBERT WELCH, head of the John Birch Society. He advised that he submitted the article to Belmont, Massachusetts, and thereafter, had nothing to do with it being printed or the final form in which it was presented. He further advised that photographs in the article were inserted by the editor and he was unaware of them until he saw the article in print.

ALLEN stated that he heard the photograph in question on page 4 of his article which was presumed to be SIRHAN SIRHAN.

ALLEN also stated the only person whom he knew who might be aware of the identity of some of those persons attending the State Labor Commission in early 1968 at Delano High School Auditorium would be Sergeant ~~JERRY DODD~~, Kern County Sheriff's Office, Bakersfield, California.

The San Francisco Office is requested to recontact Mr. DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, to ascertain if he knows the identity of one DICK (LNU), who is or was a student at San Jose State College, San Jose, California.

The Sacramento Office is requested to contact Sergeant JERRY DODD, Kern County Sheriff's Office, at Bakersfield, California, who has conducted extensive investigation concerning the Delano Grape Strike, to ascertain if he can establish the identity of one DICK (LNU), who may have been the photographer taking the photograph on page 4 of the article "The Grapes - Communist Wrath in Delano". It is also requested that the date of the State Labor Commission meeting held in Delano be established if possible.

If San Francisco or Sacramento is able to establish the identity of DICK (LNU), interview him concerning the circumstances surrounding the meeting in which he took the questioned photograph and ascertain if he can identify the person on the far left, adjacent to the edge of the photograph as being identical with SIRHAN SIRHAN.

On Tuesday, 12 June, 1968, at 8 p.m. a meeting of the Los Feliz club of the Peace and Freedom Party was held at the home of Bob and Raquel Leammiller, 3800 Amesbury Road, Los Angeles.

Frank Gibson arrived at the meeting at about 8.40 p.m.

The meeting then in progress. Milton Zaslow speaking.

There was a phone call.

Bob Leammiller said a photo of the house had been taken.

He referred to a Anaheim Newspaper.

The paper (not sure if newspaper on phone, line being held) was interested in (or about rumor of) possibility that Sirhan Sirhan, to be tried for the assassination of Senator Robert Kennedy, had attended a meeting of the Peace and Freedom Party, at which films of Cuba had been shown. (at 3800 Amesbury).

Ron Schneiders, chairman of the Los Feliz club, said he would answer (or speak) and left the meeting room to go to the phone in other section of the house.

There were some comments among the group on the matter.

In effect.

Four persons who were at the movie showing, in this group of four one man resembled somewhat the accused.

Someone. (in effect) One could not tell by anything shown (any pictures of accused).

Someone. He was in group of four sitting over there (indicating left forward section of the meeting room.

The meeting proceeded.

Zola Talbot, who was with Sadie Doroshkin, slept through most of it.

Zola dozes at many meetings she attends. (both the P & F Party and her CP club meetings).

Milton Zaslow left the meeting early. A collection (usual procedure)

The meeting concluded about 10.30 p.m.

On 7/16/68 Captain HUGH BROWN, Los Angeles Police Department, advised that members of his department do not anticipate further contact with JOHN FAHEY since they consider him to be unreliable.

FAHEY first came to their attention when he was introduced by one FERNANDO FAURA, a reporter for the Citizens News in Hollywood; for a San Fernando Valley Newspaper; and a reporter doing free-lance work for Life and Time, Inc. BROWN explained that FAURA has continuously attempted to introduce other individuals to the police department whom he alleges have knowledge of the KENNEDY assassination. Those individuals interviewed by the police department have proven to have no knowledge of the KENNEDY shooting.

Captain BROWN further explained there is no intention on the part of his department to subject FAHEY to a polygraph examination.

KENNEDY) on television recently and realized that the two men he saw in the United States Senate Gallery were SIRHAN and his brother. He was fairly positive of this.

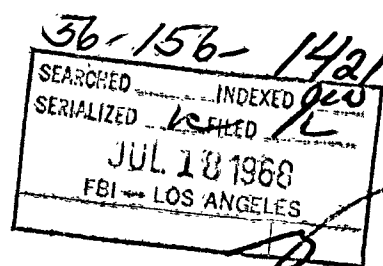
A confidential source, who is in a position to furnish reliable information, recently advised that Karl F. Jorss, Jr., President A. F. Jorss, Incorporated, Iron Works, 300 South 10th Street, Arlington, Virginia, home address 5401 Audubon Road, Bethesda, Maryland, made the following statement:

"A well-known attorney of the Department of Justice related at a cocktail party last week that Bobby Kennedy's assassin was inspired by a high Government official."

On June 25, 1968, Mr. Karl F. Jorss, Jr., advised he attended a dinner party Friday, June 7, 1968, at the residence of Mr. Armiger L. Jagoe, 3700 Kanawha Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. He identified Mr. Jagoe as President, Corporation Insurance Management, 4000 Brandywine Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

After the dinner, there was general discussion of the assassination of Senator Robert Kennedy which had just taken place.

Mr. Elwood Davis, Attorney with office at 800 17th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., was present at the dinner but left immediately after eating. During the after-dinner discussion, another guest, identity not recalled, quoted Mr. Davis as having commented during dinner that he, Davis, thought the assassination of Senator Robert Kennedy "was inspired by a high government official." This guest did not explain the context in which Mr. Davis made this statement or endeavor to interpret his meaning.



F. ELWOOD DAVIS

Mr. Jorss had been at another table during dinner and did not personally hear Mr. Davis' comment.

On July 9, 1968, F. Elwood Davis residing 1301 California Avenue, N.W., an attorney with offices at 800 17th Street, N.W., and past President of the Washington Board of Trade, Washington, D.C., furnished the following information:

Mr. Davis attended the above mentioned dinner party and left immediately after eating. He does not recall entering or overhearing any conversation during the dinner party relating to the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. Mr. Davis added he had never considered, stated or heard that Senator Kennedy's assassin was inspired by a high Government official.
