On 8/7/68, in connection with his liaison responsibilities regarding captioned investigation. SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, Jr. determined from S. U. S. Unit of the LAPD that one TIFFANY JONAS (telephone 475-5206) has been contacted by the Police Department. JONAS was a volunteer staff worker with the ROBERT F. KENNEDY campaign for President in Los Angeles. connection therewith, one RALPH WASHINGTON, whom she described to the Police Department as an unemployed volunteer worker for KENNEDY, has, on several occasions, attempted to solicit money from her presumably to pay his rent. In connection therewith, she later learned that ROSELLE BUNDY, another KENNEDY campaign worker, paid \$150.00 to WASHINGTON.

JONAS advised she had an address of 7107 Brynhurst for WASHINGTON. In addition, she obtained a telephone number, 483-8348, reportedly that of a sister, and telephone 751-7502, that of a friend who had reportedly characterized WASHINGTON as a "kook."

SUGGESTED LEAD

It is recommended this memorandum be forwarded to SA RICHARD P. DOUCETTE in connection with his previous interview of JONAS and in the event this information is of substantive value with respect to WASHINGTON.





In connection with the review by the Bureau of Los Angeles reports dated 6/9/68, 6/15/68, and 7/1/68. The following reflects the status of investigation by the Los Angeles Office:

LOUK, STOCK AND BARREL GUN SHOP

- 1. The femily of SIRHAN is being interviewed re his ownership of a pair of white duck pants.
- 2. In connection with LARRY ARROT and DONNNA HERRICE the Los Angeles Police Department afforded a polygraph examination to them on 8/5/68 and 8/6/68 respectively. Copies of the complete results of these examinations will be included in a forth coming Los Angeles report.

During the course of investigation tracings at points where crucial questions were asked suggested that ARNOT was being untruthful concerning seeing anyone with SIRHAN at the gun shop on 6/1/68. It was the conclusion of the examiner that ARNOT aid not, in fact, remember SIRHAN or the transaction of 6/1/68.

ARNOT stated he confused the sale of the ammunition to three other individuals and could not truthfully recall SIRHAN being in the store on 6/1/68. He knows he made the sale due to the receipt, but cannot recall SIRHAN or the sale.

He stated he was mislead by DONNA HERRICK, who told him that SIRHAN and two other men had been in the store on 6/1/68.

During the course of the polygraph examination of DONNA HERRICK tracings at points where crucial questions were asked indicate strongly that Mrs. HERRICK was being untruthful.

Upon conclusion of examination Mrs. HERRICK was advised that she was either mistaken or deliberately untruthful, but she could not honestly say that she remembered seeing SIRHAN or talking to him in person. Mrs. HERRICK admitted she was confused, but she did believe SIRHAN had been at her store. She was advised that the results of the polygraph did not show this.

3. In accordance with Bureau instructions, investigation of this phase is being pursued so that this area may be completely resolved.

AREA OF SHOOTING

- 4. Investigation is being coordinated between information by BIDSTRUP and a Los Angeles Fireman to resolve whether or not the unknown male was SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.
- 5. It is the belief of the Los Angeles Office that the Los Angeles Fireman is identical to HAROLD L. BURBA. Results of interview with BURBA in Los Angeles are in report dated 6/15/68, page 79. Further coordination will be made to determine if this is the true identity.

6. Investigation is being conducted into WILLIAM F. GARDNER to determine the source of the pamphlet, which bore the caption, "Kill Kennedy".

AMBASSADOR HOTEL

- 7. WILLIAM F. GARDNER, Chief Security Agent, Ambassador Hotel advised that many of the employees used on the night of 6/4/68 were hired on a temporary basis for these nomination events. The matter of the employees will be pursued by this office.
- 8. Los Angeles report dated 6/9/68 reflects that the automobile belonging to SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN was located on June 5, 1968, in the 3200 block of New Hampshire Avenue, which is close to the Ambassador Hotel. This information appears on page 266 of the designated report.
- 9. The Jordanian couple referred to by GERALD PARMENTER is identical to MAWAD MOHARMED SARHA and his wife, SIGRID SABRA of Alhambra, California. Results of interviews with these individuals appear in Los Angeles report dated 7/1/68, pages 671 and 673.
- 10. Information was developed by the Los Angeles Office that newspaper men ran through the hotel grounds at approximately 12:15 a.m. in the morning of 6/5/68. Additional research will be conducted to resolve this point.
- 11. It is believed by the Los Angeles Office that the individual referred to by JOHN SHAMEL is identical to MICHAEL WAYNE, who ran through the hotel lobby and was arrested by a security guard. Results of interview with WAYNE appear in Los Angeles report dated 8/7/68 on page 550.

- 12-13. Additional investigation is being conducted at the hotel re these items as apparently several individuals resorted to subterfuge to attempt to enter the various rooms where KENNEDY was to appear.
 - 14. Referenced Bureau letter dated 8/1/68 under Item No. 2 requested Los Angeles to display appropriate photograph to FALLAH BEN-JAPR.

SUBJECT: Report on Rumor-About Robert Kennedy Being Shot-

- 1. This office has been informed of a rumor similar to that reported in our out teletype number 06680 of 8 June 1968.
- 2. On 23 July 1968 our representative in Mogadiscio. Somalia, was contacted (but not deliberately sought out) by a Mr. J. Christian Kinney. a United States citizen, who volunteered information about a rumor of Robert Kennedy having been shot. Mr. Kinney reported that on 18 May 1968 he stopped in Beirut, Lebanon, while enroute to Mogadiscio, with his wife and child. On the evening of May 18th he entered the Phoenicia Bar, Phoenicia Hotel, Beirut, about one-half hour before This was either 2130 or 2230 hours according closing time. to Mr. Kinney. At the bar Mr. Kinney struck up a casualconversation with a Mr. Joseph Strong, a United States citi-During the conversation Mr. Strong inquired if Mr. Kinney had heard that Robert Kennedy had been shot. Mr. Kinney replied that he had not, and Mr. Strong said that he had heard this just before coming to the bar from a man he did not identify. Mr. Kinney and Mr. Strong reportedly felt that if this were true it would appear in the newspapers the next day, which, of course, it did not.
- 3. On 19 May Mr. Kinney left Belrut for Jidda, Saudi Arabia, where his company has business. He questioned some of his colleagues in Jidda whether they had heard a story about Robert Kennedy having been shot. The colleagues disclaimed having heard this so Mr. Kinney attributed the story to being a "typical Middle East coffee house rumor", and forgot about it. Mr. Kinney also met Mr. Strong in Jidda during the week of 19 May, and no mention was made by either party about the rumor that Robert Kennedy had been shot.

4. According to our representative in Mogadiscio Mr.

J. Christian Kinney is employed as a consultant by the Middle West Service Company, 69 West Washington Street, Chicago, Illinois. He presently is assigned to Mogadiscio as the chief consultant to the Mogadiscio Water Agency on a United States

Agency for International Development (USAID) project. Mr. Kinney is described as being a bright, pleasant, young man in his early thirties who appears to know his business, and is well thought of by USAID officials in Mogadiseio. His wife is reported to be Ecuadorian, and they have one child.

- 5. The files of this office contain no identifiable information on J. Christian Kinney. Our representative in-Mogadiscio reports that Mr. Kinney presently is undergoing a security check for the purpose of permitting him to have access to "need-to-know" classified information in connection with the USAID Mogadiscio water project. It is possible, therefore, that USAID Washington may have information on Mr. Kinney.
- Kinney described Mr. Joseph Strong as being the Middle East Sales Manager for Raytheen. According to Mr. Kinney, Mr. Strong is based in New York and travels to his sales territory several times a year. It is possible that Mr. Strong may be identical with Joseph Addington Strong who was born on 5 October 1911 at Chattanooga, Tennessee. According to information dated mid-1967 Joseph Addington Strong resided at 743 Wellesley Street, Weston, Massachusetts. He was employed by the Raytheon Company, Wayland, Massachusetts, as International Sales and Projects Manager, Surface Radar and Navigation Operation. He has been employed by Raytheon since 1950.
- Joseph Addington Strong in 1964. The checks included the Office of Naval Intelligence (ONI); Department of State, Passport Section; House Committee on Un-American Activities; and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The checks developed no unfavorable information. In 1962 ONI completed a favorable background investigation on Strong. The investigation was predicated on his civilian duties in a contract capacity.

On 7/24/68, ROSCO_GOOD, 1364 Elizabeth Street, Pasadena, appeared at the office of the F.B.I. re concern for his son THOMAS GOOD, a recent graduate of San Jose State College, residence 22 S. 11th. Street : San Jose, California.

GOOD advised that his son had been interviewed by F.B.I. Agents in the past re his activities in participating in demostrations on the campus of San Jose State College.

GOOD stated that his son is a friend of a WALTER CROW, a recent graduate of U.C.L. A., residence Topoka St. Pasadena. Good said both were classmates in high school, John Muir High Shhool, Pasadena and both were members of the DuBois ^Clubs at their respective colleges. He said also that SIRHAN SIRHAN was also a classmate of his son and Crow in high school and believes they all were influenced in their political beliefs by a teachers in politics who is still teaching there, (name unrecalled).

GOOD advised that CROW and SIRHAN went out together for dinner approximately two weeks prior to the assasination of ROBERT KENNEDY. He said that he did not know anything more about this meeting and did not recall just how he came about this information, possible from his son Thomas.

GOOD stated that he is very concerned about his son due to his association with SIRHAN and Crow in high school. He further said that Crow has written several letters to his son, which letters he has seen and said that the tone of the letters reflects views opposite to our democratic way of life.

GOOD said that after the KENNEDY assasination his son had said that if anyone had found out his association with SIRHAN, high school friends, someonut would probably take a shot at him.

GOOD advised that a person who is well acquainted with the SIRHAN family and arone time was going to take the Sirhan family in her house when the father of Sirhan Sirhan ran off is RUBY HAYWORD, Topica Street, Pasadena, California. (Approximately two houses from Crow's residence).



In reference to Bureau letter dated 7/26/68, reflecting the review of Los Angeles reports of 6/9/68, 6/15/68, and 7/1/68, the following is set forth concerning the coverage of investigation outlined in referenced Bureau letter.

- 1. Mrs. THEODORA VAN AMERSSOORT and Mrs. BETTY WANSINK have been interviewed. A lead is outstanding for the interview of DAVID HENDRICKSON and his place of residence has been established.
- 2. MISTIG, referred to in the interview of MAUF MOHAMMAD BEDRAN, is identical to GAYMOURD MISTRI who has been interviewed and the results were set forth in Los Angeles report dated 6/9/68 on Page 869.
- 3. EDWARD VAN ANTWERP was located and interviewed by the San Francisco Office and results of this interview appear in Los Angeles report dated 7/1/68 on Pages 708 and 709.
- 4. V. FRANK (LNU), referred to by RAYMOND SICHTER, is identical to FRANK DONNARUMMA who was the head trainer at the Granja Vista Del Rio Ranch, Corona, California, and whose wife was a waitress in a cafe. Extensive investigation has been conducted to locate DONNARUMMA and investigation is continuing on this phase.
- 5. No interview will be conducted with REX ELLSWORTH as an employment check made at the ranch operated by ELLSWORTH through Mrs. RUBY GRAY reflects that SIRHAN WASRCHED never employed at the ELLSWORTH ranch. Results of this investigation appear in Los Angeles report dated 6/15/68, INDEXED on Page 566.

- 6. Information concerning investigation on this point was set for th in referenced Los Angeles letter to the Bureau.
- 7. RAY LOZA was interviewed and results of interview appeared in report dated 7/1/68, on Page 680.
- 8. Mrs. MARGARET POMEROY, a former landlady of ABDUL MAJED DA BASS, was interviewed and advised that DA BASS returned to Jordan and may possibly return to the United States in the fall of 1968. UACB, no effort will be made to have DA BASS interviewed in Jordan.
- 9. MARCIA GIROUARD has been interviewed and the results have been set forth in Los Angeles report dated 8/7/68.
- 10. CHERYL PIERCE has been interviewed and the results of this interview are set forth in Los Angeles report dated 8/7/68.
- ll. Investigation is being conducted at Pasadena, California, to verify SIRHAN's employment at Peak's Hamburger House.
- 12. The PAUL referred to in Item 12 is believed to be identical to an associate of SIRHAN by the name of PAUL KHOURY. The results of interview with KHOURY appear in Los Angeles report dated 8/7/68. KHOURY is being reinterviewed to specifically determine if he studied mysticism with SIRHAN.
- 13. Checks are being conducted in the Los Angeles area through banking channels to determine if SIRHAN had a bank account. Investigation conducted by this office and the Los Angeles Police Department to date fails to reflect the existence of such an account.
 - 14. FRANCISCO TAPIA is currently confined to St. Luke's Hospital for surgery, but arrangements are being made for interview of him. Other members of the TAPIA family all have been interviewed and results will be set forth in forthcoming Los Angeles report.

- 15. HENRY RAMISTELLA is identical to FRANK DONNARUMMA (Item 4) and extensive investigation has been conducted throughout the country to locate this individual. Los Angeles airtel to the Bureau dated 8/5/68, reflects additional leads to locate RAMISTELIA.
- 16. DESI ARNAZ was interviewed by the San Diego Office and results of this interview will be in a forthcoming Los Angeles report.
- 17. OMAR RAMZI has moved from the address where he conducted the meeting of the Arab Student Association and extensive investigation has been conducted by the Los Angeles Office to locate RAMZI. Investigation is continuing in this regard.
- 18. All of the teachers listed under Item 18 have been interviewed by the Los Angeles Office.

In connection with referenced Bureau letter dated 7/1/68, the following information is set forth concerning the investigative points enumerated in that letter.

- 1. Leads are currently outstanding to locate and interview Mr. and Mrs. BENJAMIN EVRA in Lynwood, California.
- 2. Mr. FALLAH BEN-JABR will be reinterviewed and the appropriate photographs will be displayed to him.

The other photograph is an enlargement of the left portion of the above described photograph wherein there appears an individual who could be considered possibly resembling SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

On 8/7/68, Detective Sergeant SANDLIN, LAPD, S. U. S., advised SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, Jr. that these photographs were exhibited to MUNIR SIRHAN and MARY SIRHAN, brother and mother respectively of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN. Both advised these photographs are not pictures of their brother and/or son. In addition, SANDLIN advised that detective personnel of the LAPD, who have had some personal contact with SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, concur that the photograph is not that of SIRHAN.





KENNEDY. The contact was relative to the IAPD's desire for an interview of Mrs. ETHEL KENNEDY regarding the shooting of her late husband. at the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles on 6/5/68. SMITH, according to HOUGHTEN, advised that Mrs. KENNEDY would not submit to an interview by Agents of the FBI or by the LAPD and it was SMITH's opinion that she could contribute very little if anything of significance concerning the shooting. He agreed, however, to contact her in behalf of the LAPD providing that agency would submit a list of questions they desired her to answer. Upon receipt of such a letter SMITH advised he would discuss with ETHEL KENNEDY the questions and there after furnish the results to the LAPD.

The foregoing is furnished for information and Los Angeles is taking no action at this time regarding this phase of the investigation with respect to an interview with ETHEL KENNEDY.



Mr. Thomas Lynch and other personnel who work in the Supreme Court of Justice of Los Angeles, I take this moment to extend my greetings to all of you and kindly request you to assist me in something very important which must be said:

Mr. Lynch I want to kill Sirhan Bishara Sirhan. I want to fight hand to hand with this Jordanian devil

Mr. Lynch I wish that you would afford me the opportunity to give what he deserves to this cowardly assassin. I would like to confront him on the battlefield, fist to fist with this dirty assassin in order to hit him strongly with my fist and after killing him to take him apart piece by piece with my teeth and if it is possible to eat him also, because this dirty. Jordanian does not deserve a different death since Sirhan Bishara Sirhan took the life of an idealistic man and humanitarian as Robert F. Kennedy. Robert F. Kennedy was the hope of a tranquil and happy world and the hope of all the poor people because Robert wanted peace. May peace rest with the soul of Robert.

My hope was Robert, but he doesn't exist any more. And neither do I have any hope and therefore I do not want to live. Robert undertook to help me; I will send an application to the Department of State of the United States. A deep love united me with Robert and I looked toward him as my own father because upon him depended my future, but Robert is dead. They have also

killed my hopes and my dreams in this perverted life and myself now I want to avenge his death because I want to take an eye for an eye with this Jordanian devil. I want to destroy him with my fists and my teeth. I want to finish him. I want to destroy him piece by piece. Mr. Lynch would you kindly help me, but if you don't it will kill me and if you do not have the authority to authorize a bloody battle with this Jordanian dog and me, you ask the authorities of the government of the United States to see if they can authorize such a thing. I hope that you will do me the favor of helping me because this Jordanian has to die a death piece by piece.

Robert was very noble person and I have to avenge his death against this rotten Jordanian. Dear sir I hope you will extend me the favor of fighting in this way. Do everything you can. I will await your prompt reply without more.

In the opinion of Lieutenant PENA, who is in charge of the Case Preparation Team, the work of that unit would probably be completed within the next six weeks.

Mr. FITS commented that he has been instructed by District Attorney EVELLE J. YOUNGER to prepare separate files on all witnesses interviewed by all law enforcement agencies during the course of this investigation. He stated that Mr. YOUNGER desired this information, because it is his expressed intention to have the final say-so on who will be subpoensed in connection with the trial.

It is the intention of FITS in prosecuting the case to concentrate on what took place in the pantry area of the Ambassador Hotel, the scene of the shootings. In addition, it is his further intention to concentrate on the range of this investigation, a reference to SIRHAN's activities at the Sun Valley Gun Club, 401 Fish Canyon Road, Duarte, California. FITS speculated that he plans only to use the testimony of handwriting experts and SIRHAN's obtaining of ammunition.

With respect to SIRHAN's possession of the murder weapon, it is the intention of FITS to call as prosecution witnesses MUNIR SIRHAN, GEORGE EPHARD and WILLIAM EDWARD PRICE. There was some discussion during the conference of the fact that MUNIR could be prosecuted for being an alien in the United States with a gun. Chief HOUGHTON advised FITS that it was the intension of his department to present to the District Attorney for a prosecutive opinion the fact that MUNIR had a gun in his possession.

With respect to the "medical aspect" of this investigation, it is the intention of Deputy District Attorney JOHN MINER to journey to the States of Michigan and Wisconsin accompanied by Lieutenant ENRIQUE HERNANDEZ of the LAPD (a polygraph operator) and Dr. POLLOCK (a prosecution psychiatrist). The trip will be made for the purpose of interviewing TERRY WEECH, currently residing in Michigan, and HENRY PETERS, currently residing in the Jamesville, Wisconsin area. It is anticipated this trip will be undertaken on or about 8/20/68, when Mr. MINER has other commitments in the Cleveland, Ohio area.



There was some discussion pertaining to television film obtained from ABC, CBS and NBC during the course of this investigation. As a result of the conference, it was determined that if a copy of the CBS film obtained by the LAPD would be reproduced, that the copy could be edited, if necessary. This course of action was decided upon because CBS, in previously making available their television film requested that it not be cut or edited.

A request was also made by Chief HOUGHTON for the FBI, if possible, to identify a representative of the British Broadcasting Company (BBC) who was reportedly present at the Ambassador Hotel the night of the shooting of Senator KENNEDY. This, information apparently was furnished by RICHARD DREW of Pasadena who advised the LAPD that the BBC representative was present. Detective Sergeant COLLINS, who was also present at the conference, advised he would obtain the name of the BBC representative.

Some discussion was also had pertaining to the allegation that SIRHAN had purchased a drink at the RAFFERTY campaign headquarters sometime during the evening of 6/4/68 for which he allegedly paid a \$20.00 tip to a female serving drinks. Investigation has failed to establish the identity of any such individual. This discussion was resolved when it was mentioned that the RAFFERTY Campaign Headquarters did not have female employees serving drinks on that particular evening.

Mr. FITS explained that under the Law of Discovery in California, the defense attorney would have access to information furnished by the witnesses which the prosecution intends to utilize. In connection therewith, FITS explained that Deputy District Attorney YOUNGER has consulted with United States Attorney W. MATTHEW BYRNE, Jr. relative to furnishing copies of all FBI reports to the defense attorneys. No firm decision has been made with respect to that phase of the prosecution's intentions.

On 6/12/68, Dr. T.J. (JEFF) TOWA, B.S., D.D.S., was interviewed at Bell, California, by SA's JAMES M. KELLOGG and WAYNE L. BOURQUE, (Los Angeles report 7/1/68, Page@724).

TOMA, in this interview, advised that he had never met SIRHAN, but had learned recently that allegedly more than five years ago SIRHAN attended the same church which TOMA attended. TOMA identified this church as the Syrian Orthodox Church located at 3rd and Alvarado Streets, Los Angeles, and its pastor as Father PAUL ROMLEY.

By letter dated 8/1/68, the Bureau instructed Los Angeles to contact the pastor and appropriate members of Syrian Orthodox Church, 3rd and Alvarado Streets, Los Angeles, reportedly attended by SIRHAN.
