and letter from Mr. AGUSTINE V. CHAVEZ.

CHAVEZ interviewed Coachella, California, and advised that had no firsthand knowledge of killing of Senator KENNEDY. CHAVEZ advised had predicted that President JOHN F. KENNEDY, MARTIN LUTHER KING, and Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY would be killed before it happened and had told a friend about his predictions. CHAVEZ advised that God had revealed this to him, and this was "God's prediction and not just his." CHAVEZ stated that when he made the prediction, he did not know who would do the killing and has no other information concerning the death of Senator KENNEDY. No further investigation will be conducted on this matter by the Los Angeles office.

Taylor works at this store during sales and frequently about 2 days a week.

The records of the Crawford High School, San Diego, made available by Mrs. HELEN SELNESS on 7/15/68 reflected that LISA LYNN URSO, 6405 Bradford Street, San Diego, who resides with her mother and step-father, ROBERT and BARBARA RAY, graduated from that school in June, 1968.

Miss URSO said that she had been talked to by two detectives of the Los Angeles Police Department shortly after the shooting. Later two detectives of the Los Angeles Police Department re-interviewed her San Diego and took a formal statement. Also Miss URSO has appeared on a San Diego TV station to be interviewed during a news show.

Facts of complaint

C said he had called the LAPD several weeks ago to report the following, however, he guessed they did nothing about it. He said he formerly lived at 425 S. Alexandria, which is near the Ambassador Hotel. He said on the night of the KENNEDY shooting he had been at his apartment. He said hearing some commotion he went outside about 12-25pm that ~~xxx~~ night and observed a blonde headed fellow ~~running~~ between Sixth and Wilshire. He entered a red MG or Triumph and sped away up Alexandria Street. He said this man was young and looked to be about 6'2" tall. He said almost simultaneously another shorter, (5'6-7") dark haired man also came running up Alexandria and entered the apartment building located at 526 S. Alexandria.

C said he realizes the above incidents might be coincidental, however it was a published fact that SIRHANS car was found on Alexandria. Further the time is relative (12-25pm) wherein it would be conceivable that these ~~nighttime~~ men might have been fleeing the shooting scene. In any event, he felt it should be reported.

C was advised his call would be made a matter of record.
