On 8/1/68 IC MILLARD T. ANDERSON caused the records of the LAPD to be checked but no record identifiable was located.

On 8/2/68 DAVID ESQUITH was recontacted by the writer at which time he advised that he had no additional information concerning AL ROTHSTEIN, that Ethey met only on the night of the assassination and to his knowledge ROTHSTEIN has been a volunteer for KENNEDY for only a few days. ESQUITH further stated that ROTHSTEIN was not in the immediate area of the shooting and could probably furnish no information which had not already been obtained.

In view of the fact that investigation set out above has been unsuccessful in locating ROTHSTEIN, it is suggested that efforts to interview him be discontinued.

FRANK GOODPASTURE, JR., Goodpasture Motor Company, Bristol, Virginia, advised he has known JOHN A. JENSEN, also known as "Buddy", General Motor Service and Truck Company, 386 State Street Extension, Fairfield, Connecticut, since 1959, and he always has found him to be a person of high morals, character and reputation.

He said he attended the dinner at the Americana Hotel, Miami Beach, Florida, during the conference of the National Automobile Dealers Association, truck meeting, and that JOHN A. JENSEN was present, and he heard JENSEN was making remarks concerning segregation; however, since the remarks were not made to him, he could not recall any definite statements he may have made.

He said he gathered from the remarks that JENSEN had some feelings regarding segregation as there apparently had been some trouble in Fairfield, Connecticut. He stated he did not feel JENSEN meant anything by his remarks and he put no significance in them as he had been drinking.

He recalled that ARTHUR TRWIN, Irwin GMC Inc., GMC dealer, Lima, Ohio, was present, as well as BILL WIESON, General Truck Sales, Murfreesboro Road, Nashville, Tennessee, and ROBERT C. GALIAHAN, Goode Motor Company, Bristol, Tennessee.

He said after the meeting, WILSON and IRWIN made a trip to Jamaica, and they discussed the remarks of JENSEN, but they put no significance to them. He said that if JENSEN is contacted, he is sure he could explain his remarks.

WILLIAM J. WILEON, General Truck Sales, 535 Murfreesboro Road, Nashville, Tennessee advised as follows:

During May of 1968 he attended a conference of the National Automobile Dealers Association in Miami Beach, Florida, which was attended by a number of truck dealers throughout the United States. On one evening during this series of meetings he was with a group of individuals including "BIDDY" JENSEN of Fairfield, Connecticut and ARTHUR IRWIN of Lima, Ohio. Everyone in this group of some twenty to twenty-five men had been drinking heavily and conversations could only be described as extremely "alcoholic."

On one occasion, "BIDDY" JENSEN made some remark to the effect that ROBERT KENNEDY would never live to become President, if he were nominated and elected, that someone would probably shoot him. JENSEN did not say that he had attended any meeting where this was discussed, nor was any conversation recalled with reference to MARTIN LUTHER KING.

He does not recall any other remarks of JENSEN and does not recall discussing JENSEN'S remarks on a subsequent trip to Jamaica, which he made accompanied by other men at the conference.

He paid absolutely no attention to JENSEN'S remark regarding KENNEDY, since he was drinking heavily, as were most of the men at the conference.

He described JENSEN as an "ultra conservative", a loyal American, and one who would have no part in the death of KENNEDY or KING.

On 8/7/68, SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, Jr., in connection with his liaison responsibilities pertaining to captioned investigation, was advised by Lieutenant CHARLES HIGBIE, LAPD, S. U. S., as follows:

An individual by the name of JIM FLUG, reportedly a former member of the ROBERT F. KENNEDY official family, was in charge of threatening mail by KENNEDY. Following the assassination of KENNEDY, FLUG, whose offices were then in Washington, D. C., was contacted by Agents of the United States Secret Service and the FBI. On that occasion, a Secret Service Agent by the name of RADFORD JONES and an unidentified Agent of the FBI were given all information then in FLUG's possession concerning threatening mail received by KENNEDY.

Lieutenant HIGBIE requested, if possible, all information made available to the United States Secret Service and FBI pertaining to threatening mail received by KENNEDY be made available his department.

SUGGEST LEAD: Set forth appropriate lead to have FLUG contacted relative to the foregoing request.

On 8/23/68, Mr. DAVE GRAY, Inspection Department, Bank of America, Los Angeles Main Office, advised that he had circularized all of the branches of the Bank of America in the Los Angeles area in connection with ascertaining whether any of them maintained an account in the name of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN. This circularization resulted in the negative; however, there was a report made by the Arroyo-Colorado Branch in Pasadena, California, to the effect that they have an account in the name of MUNIR B. S. SIRHAN which was opened on 3/20/68, with an initial deposit of \$75. There has been very little activity on this account and the current balance as of this date is \$5. GRAY said the branch does not know if the person who has this account is in any way related to SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

TURNER suggests to OWEN that SIRHAN B. SIRHAN could conceivably have considered using OWEN's truck as a "getaway" vehicle following the shooting. CHRISTIAN has furnished a mailing address of Postal Drawer 2850, San Francisco, California.

HIGBIE further stated that CHRISTIAN has sought permission for him and TURNER to be "deputized" to assist the LAPD in the investigation of the shooting of Senator KENNEDY.

The LAPD is conducting investigation to discredit CHRISTIAN and TURNER, since it is obvious they have no factual information in their possession to suggest a conspiracy.

The Los Angeles Division will continue to follow this aspect of the investigation and keep the Bureau appropriately advised.

Based on limited data available, no information can be located in Los Angeles indices identifiable with JOHN G. CHRISTIAN.

Foregoing is for information and a copy is being sent to San Francisco since it appears CHRISTIAN and/or TURNER are currently within that division's territory. In addition, both TURNER and CHRISTIAN are in contact with GEORGE DAVIS, Attorney for OWEN, as previously reported by Los Angeles.

Information Concerning United States Senators Robert Kennedy and Eugene McCarthy

On August 23, 1968, Joseph Willard "Pappy" Luke, owner of Pappy's Stew House, General Delivery, Highway 90, Raywood, Texas, advised he had been unable to recall anything additional concerning the description or comments of the man who came into his restaurant on May 23, 1968 and made various claims regarding his intention to kill a senator in California. Luke advised the photograph of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan which he viewed around the first of August. 1968 was in his opinion identical to that man who came into his restaurant on May 23, 1968. Luke advised he has never owned a television set nor has he viewed anyone else's television set within the last six months. Luke stated he could not read and has not looked at a newspaper for several years. He advised he was certain he had not seen a photograph of Sirhan until a photograph was shown him by the FBI. Luke stated he was hard of hearing but he was certain the man had said what Luke reported on June 5, 1968.

A photograph of Sirhan Bishara Sirhan was shown the following residents of Raywood, Texas on August 23, 1968. None of the persons had ever observed anyone similar to Sirhan in Raywood.

Enclosed for the Bureau are six copies of a IHM reflecting investigation conducted in Raywood, Texas on 8/23/68. Enclosed for Los Angeles are two copies of IHM.

On 6/24/68, Postmaster FRED CONNELL, N.S. Post Office, Raywood, Texas advised J.W. "PAPPY" LIKE is not, in his opinion, senile in any way and does not let his imagination run away from him. LUKE is hard of hearing, does misunderstand people, and could hear part of a story and fill in the remainder in such a way as to change the story. CONNELL advised LUKE speaks loudly and likes to gripe about all sorts of things. LUKE may have appeared sympathetic to someone who opened up and disclosed to LUKE that persons true beliefs. CONNELL restated the fact that LUKE is hard of hearing and may have simply misconstrued what someone said. CONNELL did not observe the man described by LUKE or any vehicle similar to that driven by the man. CONNELL had no idea who the man may have been that LUKE described. CONNELL viewed a photograph of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN and advised he had never seen anyone similar to this person in Raywood.

meeting. They were JOE HARRIS from the San Francisco area who is down in Los Angeles for three days and is staying with the FREEDs. Also is JIM DAVIO, who is from the San Francisco area but is going to be in Los Angeles for the summer. He is attending Cal State College in L.A. He is renting a room from SUE ROMO who lives on Quintero Street in Echo Park, so that is where he can be reached at and where he will be staying this summer. He is transfering into the student club for the summer so he will be attending party meetings while he is in Los Angeles.

The only business at the meeting was a breif report by the FREEDs on the recent party convention in New York, but I won't go into it now because a detailed report of the convention is going to be given this Sunday at Larchmont Hall from 10:00 to 3:00 PM, this will be a city-wide party meeting, all party people are invited to it. So I will get a much better detailed report here and make a report of it at a later date.

Also in Montreal, Canada, this October there is going to be a conference of all of the Communist Parties in America where they will be discussing the Vietnamese war and U. S. Imperalism. This conference will be held. October 11, 12 and 13. The party is having a full mobilization on this, trying to get as many working class and black youth to go as possible.

on a regular basis or nearly as regular as possible a newspaper to be called the "Red Beard". This newspaper will be a party newspaper put out by the Youth Section of the Southern California District Communist Party.

It is going to have articles, photographs, art work and this sort of stuff. The Cultural Club is going to be doing alot of the organizing of it and also there will be individuals from each club. The basic staff for this now is

LESLEY DAVIS, WALTER CROWE, and one person by the name of HENRY, last name unknown, who is a black person and in the Chala Mumba Club. The first issue of this is slated to come out on August First, and about 9,000 copies are going to be printed.

Another piece of information I have is that the Los Angeles Police, their Homicide Division has made a number of visits to WALTER CROWE in connection with his knowledge of SIRHAN SIRHAN in the KENNEDY assassination. In the course of interagation by the homicide people of WALTER CROWE, it was mentioned they had read and had knowledge of the FBI reports when the FBI interviewed CROWE. Also they induced CROWE to go down to the City Police Headquarters where he was given a lie dector test and also interagated. They wanted a second session with him where the police actually went to CROWE's job and got him to leave work early, etc. and gave him a second lie dector test, both times they found the results negative, not so much on the case because CROWE has something to hide, but actually because of CROWE's use of extreme nervousness. The police began

openly intimidating CROWE, calling him a lier, ect., until finally CROWE just completely blew up and a with them and got quite angry. He had went to see BEN MARGOLIS, the party lawyer, earlier, but since MARGOLIS is out of town, he went last Saturday to see JOHN MC TERNAN who is MARGOLIS's partner. It was then whereupon CROWE gave all the information he had to MC TERNAN as to what events had happened with the FBI and also with the L.A. Police Department. MC TERNAN advised him not to speak or have anything else to do with the police and that if they wish to speak or contact him, they first have to make an appointment with his attorney, MC TERNAN, and that is actually the state of the affairs now. CROWE refuses to have anything more to do with the authorities partly because of the treatment he has received from them.

The following investigation was conducted by SA THOMAS J. LARDNER:

On August 16, 1968, Patrolman HERBERT MYCROFT, Identification Division, Providence, Rhode Island Police Department, advised from records that HENRY R. RAMISTELLA, of 878 180th Street, Bronx, New York, was arrested by this Police Department, on July 24, 1957, and charged with violation of the banking laws.

On July 26, 1957, the charge was reduced to false pretenses and RAMISTELLA was placed on probation.

Patrolman MYCROFT advised that it appeared from the records that RAMISTELLA was arrested along with JACKSON DURANT, RICHARD S. MC NABB, of 32 Saint Alfonsus Street, Roxbury, Massachusetts, and RONALD X. CHIAVERINI, of 37 Ring Street, Providence, Rhode Island, on a charge of being suspicious persons, and the latter three being released and RAMISTELLA being held for violation of the banking laws.

A stand-up photograph was taken of the four individuals which Patrolman MYCROFT made available.

He also made available a mug shot of RAMISTELLA.
