Subj. arrived at Ambassador 6-4-68 830PM with Her Husband Mr. Profuno (Already interviewed). She went directly to the Embassy Rm. and stayed near the TV watching the returns. At 11PM she left with her husband and went home. She again returned to the Embassy Rm. at approx. 1145PM alone since Her husband had to go to work. When She arrived at the main door she couldn't get in so she walked around through the kitchen area and stood near the swinging doors which lead into the kitchen. Upon walking through the kitchen She noticed three bus boys, two smaller children (approx. 10yrs. of age) and two women wearing Kennedy Hats.

Upon completion of the Senator's Speech She remained at the same location and as the Senator passed He shook hands with Her. The Senator then entered the kitchen area and in a few seconds She heard a single bang, then two bangs and finally five more. She recalls a slight delay between the three sets of bangs which at first she thought to be fire crackers. A few seconds later a body of people came running out of the kitchen and She then walked into the kitchen. She obs. Kennedy on the floor and some other people bleeding. She didn't recall seeing Sirhan just a large mass of people. Due to the crowd She climbed on top of a serving table with two other women and remained there for a short period of time. She didn't see any girl in a polka dot dress or Sirhan. She didn't take any photos or knows anyone who did. She has not been interviewed by the press or FBI.

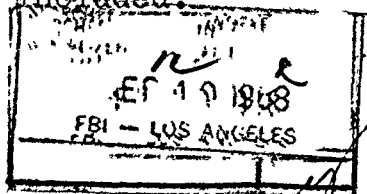

Linda went to the hotel with another girl by the name of Chris Sherrill (interview slip already made on this girl). Her husband went later by himself. Upon arriving at the hotel Linda went directly to the Embassy Room but could not get in. She then went down to the Ambassador Ballroom. She went back up to the Embassy Room and was able to get in. She was talking with a CBS TV man who told her to come back about 8:45PM and they would take some pictures of her. She left the Embassy Room at 8PM and met her husband Robert downstairs in the lobby. They both then went back up to the Embassy Room. They spent about 2 hours next to the double doors because they were informed that that was where Kennedy would enter. Robert left the hotel at 11:45PM since he had exams the next day and he heard the news about Kennedy on the radio. Linda stayed for Kennedy's speech and left immediately after it. She states she was in the lobby downstairs when she heard people screaming and found out that Kennedy had been shot. Neither recalls seeing Sirhan or any woman wearing a polka-dot dress. They did not have a camera and don't know anyone that did.

Charlotte went to the hotel with her roommate, Lynda Gamburd, (interview made), and a friend, Lebbie Bronstein (no interview, 1706 Brockton; WLA #3 PH#477-8433). She arrived at the hotel at approximately 8:15PM and went directly to the Embassy Room. She did not have a pass but was able to walk past the guard. Once inside she did not leave the room. She spent the 3 hours before Kennedy spoke sitting on the right edge of the stage. After Kennedy spoke she linked arms with other Kennedy girls on the right side of the stage in order to form a pathway for him. Kennedy then went down the left side of the stage. A short time later she heard a lot of noise but she thought it was trays and dishes being dropped. Someone then came running out stating that Kennedy had been shot. Charlotte does not recall seeing Sirhan or any woman wearing a polka-dot dress. Her friend mentioned above, Leslie Bronstein, brought a camera but supposedly did not take any pictures.
