On 8/13/68, source advised the following: C.N. 255; Attorney A. L. WIREN originally contacted Attorney RUSSELL BARSONS and "conned" PARSONS into coming into the case to represent SIRHAN SIRHAN. HARTIGAN reiterated that he could locate no employment record whatsoever at Tartan Farms under the name RAMISTELLA or DONNARUMMA.

HARTIGAN described SCOTT as a white male, 5'8", 120 lbs., with heavy beatle-type eyebrows, hair - dark brown and parted. He advised that SCOTT was always neat in his appearance and was an excellent Exercise Boy and rider.

On 9/5/68, Mr. MANNY TORTURA. Farm Manager, Bonnie Heath (Thoroughbred Horse Farm), viewed photograph of HENRY ALEXANDER RAMISTELLA and checked records of his office and advised he could locate no record of employment for this person. He further advised this photograph was not familiar to him. JK 44-793


