Strong stated Abdel-Malek was reading an Arabic language newspaper, apparently purchased by him in Rome prior to the flight, and he commented to Strong about an article in the paper reporting a rumor to the effect that United States Senator Robert F. Kennedy had been shot. Strong stated that he himself was unable to read the article inasmuch as he could not read or translate Arabic.

Strong stated he recalled commenting about the article to an unidentified American male later on May 18, 1968, in a bar in Beirut; but he never read or heard anything further in newspapers or on radios concerning the rumor in the days immediately following May 18, 1968. J
