New York received a copy of referenced memorandum for the file of JARVIS TYNER. Briefly, it is to be noted that TYNER, when appearing at a DCA meeting in Pittsburgh on 7/19/68, apparently made the comment that the DCA is planning to go ahead with its law suit against Mayor SAM YORTY of Los Angeles.

It appears likely that GARVIS made reference to a law suit which had been promised to be filed by the DCA against Mayor YORTY for comments he made in Los Angeles concerning the DCA. Mayor YORTY, after allegedly reviewing a notebook supposedly owned by SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, the alleged assassin of Senator ROBERT KENNEDY, claimed that the notebook linked SIRHAN closely with the DCA. Local members of the Communist Party (CP) youth in Los Angeles immediately denied any relationship of the DCA with SIRHAN.

on 9/5/68, SA R. J. LA JEUNESSE, JR. contacted RONALD J. ELLENSOHN, the Administrative Assistant to Mayor SAM YORTY, on an extremely confidential basis and was advised that no suit has been filed against Mayor YORTY concerning the above comments. ELLENSOHN advised that he would notify the Los Angeles Office of the FBI should any such suit be filed, but he also requested that should any information come to the attention of the FBI either in Los Angeles or any other office concerning the filing of such a suit, his office would be most appreciative of being advised.

INTERVIEW OF OFFICIALSMEMBERS OF KENNEDY PARTY

By teletype dated 6/18/68, the Washington Field advised that the following correspondents were with the official KENNEDY party in the hotel in Los Angeleszat the time of assassination.

These individuals should be expediously interviewed concerning any information they have in their possession pertaining to the assassination.

Specific inquiry should be made as to whether or not SIRHAN may have been seen in the Ambassador Hotel proper to the shooting and whether or not the Senator changed his original plans to go to the Embassy Room instead went to the Colonial Room, which was set up as a press room.

It is suggested that ED GUTHMAN could assist in establishing the location of PAUL FLEMMING and the identity of the correspondent of the Los Angeles Examiner.

PLANNED TRAVEL TO CUBA, AUGUST, 1968

A source advised on August 26, 1968 that he learned from Communist Party (CP) sources in the San Jose area of California on August 25, 1968, that Good was then in Mexico and planned to attempt to travel to Cuba.

A second source on May 1, 1968, reported that Good was a member of the CP Youth Club in San Jose and as recently as April 28, 1968, had attended a combined meeting of the San Jose Adult and Youth CP Clubs in San Jose.

A third source on May 17, 1966 advised that during the Fall semester of 1965 at San Jose State College, San Jose, California, Thomas Good expressed an interest in the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS). He attended several meetings of the SDS and affiliated with the National Office of the SDS.

A characterization of the SDS appears in the Appendix hereto.

A weekly publication of SDS, "New Left Notes", prepared at Chicago, Illinois, in the issue of March 4, 1966, included an article submitted by Thomas Good datelined San Jose, California. The article concerned protest picketing at the United Technology Center (UTC), Sunnyvale, California, on February 22, 1966. It was noted that UTC was engaged in the production of napalm for the Armed Forces.
