STUDENTS FOR A DEMOCRATIC SOCIETY

The Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), as it is known today, came into being at a founding convention held at Port Huron, Michigan, in June, 1962. The SDS is an association of young people on the left and has a current program of protesting the draft, promoting a campaign for youth to develop a conscientious objector status, denouncing United States intervention in the war in Vietnam and to "radically transform" the university community, and provide for its complete control by students. GUS HALL, General Secretary, Communist Party, USA, when interviewed by a representative of United Press International in San Francisco, California, on May 14, 1965, described the SDS as a part of the "responsible left" which the Party has "going for us." At the June, 1965, SDS National Convention, an anti-communist proviso was removed from the SDS constitution. In the October 7, 1966, issue of "New Left Notes," the official publication of SDS, an SDS spokesman stated that there are some communists in SDS and they are welcome. The national headquarters of this organization as of July 24, 1968, was located in Room 206, 1608 West Madison Street, Chicago, Illinois.

On July 31, 1968, at the house of NEMMY SPARKS, there was held a meeting of the Education Commission of the Southern California District Communist Party. NEMMY SPARKS' house is located at 145 South Burlington in Los Angeles, Apartment 4.

Members of the Commission in attendance were:

NEMMY SPARKS

ELIZABETH, last name unknown, she is a woman about 50 years old, blond hair, from Echo Park

BILL DI VALE

TOM FOLEY

MARILYN GLICK, from the Workers and Peasant Club. Marilyn was a new addition to the Ed Commission and also will be the Ed Commissions secretary.

The meeting centered around three topics, the first was a report by BILL DI VALE on the Party's National School, the one he attended from March to May of 68, and mainly was a detailed report of the people in attendance, the curriculum studied, the kind of teaches and the manner in which the whole thing was carried out and also finally comments on the value of the school, etc.

The second topic of the discussion was a report by TOM FOLEY on what some of the educational activities are in terms of the district as a whole. He said that there were some study groups formed in Es Condido, the Es Condido area, which he said are mainly party people and they they have already started a human rights forum so FOLEY has been keeping in touch with them and anyways says that things are going well there. Also he said he has been down to San Diego and worked with some adults there who are also supporting the S.D.S. and they also have a study group going, a Marxist study group. In East Los Angeles, FOLEY said there are two things going in the Mexican-American Community, one is mainly for adults and it was started by a couple of party people and the Mexicans that attend this class or study groups you might say. He said they are just becoming interested in radicalism but they are still for the most part, you know, not Marxist or not radicals, but they are just becoming interested in it and he is teaching two classes for this group, one is in Marxism and the other is a class in Latin American History mainly in Mexico and what not.

The third point that TOM made was that he was going to begin an American institute for Marxist studies, this is HERB APTHEKER's group, that he had written to him and recently when he was in New York he had a meeting with APTHEKER and APTHEKER sort of outlined some general plans he could follow by which they could get the organization started. FOLEY said he has already contacted about 50 or 75 professors and intellectuals in the southland area and he said he got good response from everyone of them with the exception of one, and that was TIM HARDING at Cal State and that was mainly because he has been interested in the Socialist Workers Party but FOLEY has been contacting people at Long Beach, UCLA, at SC, San Fernando Valley State College, at San Diego, San Diego State, Loyola University, all around the area and also he was asking names of anyone that people knew. He is planning to call sort of a introductory meeting in about the middle of September and from there he expects to get 50 or 75 people and from then plan another meeting in October where perhaps APTHEKER could even come to. So we thought of this, that this would be sort of a, become a left intellectual center on the left where there would be monthly discussions and forums and presentations of papers etc., and that this would be good in

terms of, you know, we would begin to be able excersise some influence on the intellectual left community.

There is a side issue here I want to mention. TOM GOOD, a friend of WALTER CROWE, who lives up in the San Jose area and has been active in the S.D.S. and been friendly with the party kidsup there. ~~He is a member of the Party in San Jose,~~ ^{He joined recently and} this is just a incidental piece of information.

The third part of the meeting was centered around the discussion of full time district school. IN probably the last week of August theparty is going to to put on a district school for some of the party people, it is going to compose of a weekend, five nights and then the following two days and the next week end. There is about 20 - 25 people that have been proposed, I don't have all of the names but some of them are people like:

JUDY SCHUB

JUDY ARRJI

WALTER CROWE

A number of Negro adults, some people from the Mexican American Community and as a whole I don't have all of the names down but it would be about 20-25 people and all party people.

A meeting will be held shortly by which some of the curriculum will be planned and times, etc., and some of the topics of the discussion. There will be a number of people doing some of the teaching like:

NEMMY SPARKS

TOM FOLEY

BILL DI VALE

Together this school is going to quite an endeavor by the Party. There will be a number of people involved in the teaching of it, it will cover quite a long period of time and will be an attempt on the Party to get 20 or 25 people through this and you know perhaps increase there marxist understanding. So this is the immediate project for the head commission. Also at the end of August there is planned, I think August 23rd, at Basey's Hall, there is planned to be a general forum put on by the Anti Commission which will be a discussion at Czechoslovakia and some of the policies of Czechoslovakia.

So this about covers what went on at the Ed Commission meeting.

On 6/4/68 the above-captioned person was a registered guest at the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, California.

At 12:15 A.M. on 6/5/68, SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, at the conclusion of a victory rally by the late Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. (D-New York), in the kitchen area leading off the Embassy Ballroom shot and killed Senator KENNEDY, utilizing a .22 caliber revolver.

The Los Angeles Police Department requested the assistance of the Bureau in the location and interview of guests of the hotel in an effort to determine whether or not any of the guests might be in possession of any information concerning a possible conspiracy, might know SIRHAN, or might have seen him about the hotel on the night of 6/4/68.

All information, negative or positive, should be incorporated into an FD-302, as all information is being disseminated to the District Attorney, Los Angeles County, in report form, such reports being prepared by Los Angeles.

It is requested that Secret Service be contacted and a determination made as to whether the photograph contained in the 1/22/68 letter to President Johnson from Djuro Stokic is identical with the photograph that apparently was enclosed in the 6/11/68 anonymous communication. It is noted that Secret Service did not furnish a photograph in its referral to the Bureau.

Copies of the above-referred-to material are likewise enclosed for the information of the Los Angeles Office.

An examination is being conducted by the FBI Laboratory of the handwriting in both communications and you will be advised of the results.

ZIYAD IBRAHAIM HUSANI, 725 Lawrenceville Road,
Lawrence Township, New Jersey, furnished the following
information:

He is a graduate student in the Politics Department, Princeton University, Princeton, New Jersey, and is a native of Beirut, Lebanon, having been in the United States for two years. He is president of the organization of Arab Students in the United States and Canada, advising that the organization was established in 1952 to further Arab-American friendship and to assist Arab students in adjusting to academic life away from home. There are more than 100 chapters in colleges throughout the United States and Canada and the group has a fairly large membership.

After the attack on Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY, the National Headquarters Executive Committee of the organization of Arab Students heard that press reports had indicated the assailant of KENNEDY was a member of the organization. As a result of this, the organization issued a press release dated June 5, 1968, which stated that the suspected assailant of Senator ROBERT KENNEDY (SIRHAN SIRHAN) was not and had not been a member of the organization of Arab Students. The Executive Committee noted in the press release that the group had sent a telegram to Mrs. ROBERT KENNEDY expressing shock and dismay on the attempt on the Senator's life, and a hope that he would soon recover. Following Senator KENNEDY's death the Executive Committee of the group sent a second telegram to Mrs. KENNEDY expressing condolences on behalf of the organization of Arab Students.

HUSANI emphatically stated that SIRHAN SIRHAN has had no association with his organization and has never been a member of the organization and the disclaimer was issued for the reason stated above.

ON 8/1/68 THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACTED MRS. ELMA GILES AT HER RESIDENCE. MRS. GILES IS THE MANAGER OF THE APARTMENTS LOCATED AT 1080 AND 1090 N. LAKE AVENUE, AND HAS BEEN MANAGER OF THE APARTMENTS FOR THE LAST TWELVE YEARS. MRS. GILES WAS QUESTIONED AS TO HER FINDING A PISTOL IN AN APARTMENT WHICH HAD BEEN OCCUPIED BY THE VICTIM AND SHE RELATED THE FOLLOWING.

ON JUNE 1, 1966 SHE WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF MRS. SCHACHTEBECK WERE CLEANING AN APARTMENT WHICH HAD JUST BEEN VACATED BY SAIDALLAH SIRHAN, AND DURING THE CLEANING OF THAT APARTMENT A PISTOL WAS FOUND UNDER A CUSHION TO AN OVER-STUFFED CHAIR. MRS. GILES HAD NEVER SEEN SAIDALLAH SIRHAN WITH ANY WEAPONS OF ANY KIND, HOWEVER, SHE HAD CLEANED THE SAME APARTMENT JUST PRIOR TO SAIDALLAH MOVING INTO THE APARTMENT AND NOTICED THAT THE PISTOL WAS NOT IN THE APARTMENT AT THE TIME HE MOVED IN. SHE FELT THAT THE ONLY WAY THE PISTOL COULD HAVE COME TO BE IN THE APARTMENT WAS FOR EITHER SAIDALLAH OR ONE OF HIS FRIENDS TO HAVE BROUGHT THE PISTOL THERE. WHEN ASKED WHAT APARTMENT THIS WAS THAT THE PISTOL WAS FOUND IN MRS. GILES STATES THAT IT WAS IN APARTMENT #5, AT 1080 N. LAKE AVENUE. MRS. GILES IN REFERRING TO THE APARTMENT RECORDS STATED, THAT SAIDALLAH SIRHAN HAD FIRST LIVED IN APARTMENT #2 AT 1090 N. LAKE AVENUE, HOWEVER, DUE TO THE APARTMENT BEING NEXT TO THE STREET SAIDALLAH MOVED TO AN APARTMENT AT 1080 N. LAKE AVENUE. HIS REASON FOR THE MOVE WAS THAT HE COULD NOT SLEEP WITH THE NOISE OF THE TRAFFIC ON LAKE AVENUE, AND HE THUS MOVED TO APARTMENT #5 AT 1080 BECAUSE THE APARTMENT IS LOCATED TO THE REAR OF THE APARTMENT BUILDING AND IS AWAY FROM THE TRAFFIC NOISE. WHEN ASKED WHAT TYPE OF A TENANT SAIDALLAH SIRHAN WAS, MRS. GILES STATED THAT HE WAS VERY QUIET AND HAD NOT RECEIVED ANY COMPLAINTS FROM OTHER TENANTS IN THE APARTMENT BUILDINGS. SHE HAD NEVER MET ANY OF THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE SIRHAN FAMILY AND TO THE BEST OF HER KNOWLEDGE SAIDALLAH SIRHAN WAS A "LONER" AND DOES NOT REMEMBER SEEING ANY OF HIS FRIENDS. MRS. GILES COULD NOT GIVE ANY FURTHER INFORMATION AT THIS TIME THAT WOULD ASSIST IN THIS INVESTIGATION.

ON 8/1/68 THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACTED MRS. FAYE SCHACHTEBECK AT HER RESIDENCE. SHE WAS QUESTIONED AS TO ANY INFORMATION SHE HAD WITH REFERENCE TO THE WEAPON FOUND IN APARTMENT #5 IN JUNE 1966. MRS. SCHACHTEBECK STATED THAT SHE WENT WITH MRS. GILES TO CHECK AND CLEAN THE APARTMENT WHICH HAD BEEN OCCUPIED BY SAIDALLAH SIRHAN.

WHILE THEY WERE IN THE PROCESS OF CLEANING THE APARTMENT SHE NOTICED THAT ONE OF THE DUST COVERS ON THE ARM OF AN OVER-STUFFED CHAIR APPEARED TO BE LUMPED UP. SHE STARTED TO STRAIGHTEN OUT THE DUST COVER AND AT THAT TIME FOUND A PISTOL UNDER THE COVER. SHE IMMEDIATELY GAVE IT TO MRS. GILES WHO WAS PRESENT IN THE ROOM AND MRS. GILES TOOK IT TO HER OWN APARTMENT. MRS. SCHACHTEBECK REMEMBERS HAVING CONVERSATION WITH MRS. GILES ABOUT MRS. GILES CONTACTING RELATIVES OF SAIDALLAH WITH REFERENCE TO THE PISTOL, AND THAT THE DAY AFTER THE PISTOL HAD BEEN TURNED INTO THE PASADENA POLICE DEPARTMENT SAIDALLAH CAME BACK TO THE APARTMENT HOUSE AND CONTACTED MRS. GILES. DURING THAT CONTACT MRS. GILES ADVISED SAIDALLAH THAT SHE HAD TURNED THE PISTOL INTO THE PASADENA POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THAT HE COULD GO AND PICK IT UP THERE. MRS. SCHACHTEBECK STATED THAT SHE HAD TALKED WITH MRS. GILES WITHIN THE PAST FEW DAYS WITH REFERENCE TO SAIDALLAH SIRHAN AND THE PISTOL, AND THAT MRS. GILES NOW REMEMBERS MORE INFORMATION WITH REFERENCE TO IT. SHE SUGGESTED THAT THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACT MRS. GILES FOR THAT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION. THE UNDERSIGNED ASKED MRS. SCHACHTEBECK IF SHE HAD ANY COMPLAINTS IN REFERENCE TO SAIDALLAH SIRHAN AT THE TIME HE WAS LIVING AT 1080 OR 1090 N. LAKE AVENUE, AND SHE REPLIED THAT SHE DID NOT HAVE ANY PROBLEMS WITH HIM AT ALL AND THAT HE SEEMED TO BE A VERY QUITE PERSON. SHE COULD NOT REMEMBER ANY FRIENDS OF SAIDALLAH VISITING HIM AND COULD NOT REMEMBER ANY COMPANY HE MIGHT HAVE HAD WHILE A TENANT IN THE APARTMENTS.

ON 8/7/68 THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACTED MRS. GILES FOR ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT SHE REMEMBERED AT THIS TIME. MRS. GILES STATED THAT SHE HAD CONVERSATION WITH MRS. SCHACHTEBECK WITH REFERENCE TO THE FINDING OF THE WEAPON, AND THAT THIS CONVERSATION REFRESHED HER MEMORY IN REGARDS TO IT. MRS. GILES NOW REMEMBERS THAT THE GUN WAS FOUND UNDER A DUST COVER WHICH WAS ON ONE OF THE ARMS OF AN OVER-STUFFED CHAIR. AFTER THE GUN WAS FOUND SHE TOOK IT TO HER APARTMENT HOUSE AND ON THE NEXT DAY CALLED THE SIRHAN FAMILY AND ADVISED THEM THAT THE WEAPON HAD BEEN FOUND. SHE DOES NOT REMEMBER WHICH MEMBER OF THE SIRHAN FAMILY SHE SPOKE WITH. MRS. GILES FELT THAT THIS CONVERSATION WITH AN UNKNOWN MEMBER OF THE SIRHAN FAMILY TOOK PLACE ON JUNE 1, 1966. ON JUNE 2, 1966 SHE TURNED THE PISTOL INTO THE PASADENA POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THEN ON THE FOLLOWING DAY SAIDALLAH CAME TO HER APARTMENT ASKING FOR THE FOUND PISTOL. SHE ADVISED HIM THAT THE PISTOL HAD BEEN TURNED INTO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THAT HE COULD PICK IT UP THERE. SAIDALLAH TOLD HER THAT THE PISTOL WAS NOT HIS AND FOR THAT REASON THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WOULD NOT GIVE IT TO HIM. HE STATED THAT THE PISTOL BELONGED TO A FRIEND OF HIS AND HE WAS JUST CLEANING IT FOR THE FRIEND. MRS. THE INCIDENT WAS AN OCCASION WHEN SAIDALLAH SHOWED RITCHEY A RIFLE THAT SAIDALLAH SAID BELONGED TO HIM, AND HOW SAIDALLAH MADE THE STATEMENT THAT HE LIKED TO GO TO A GUN RANGE IN FISH CANYON FOR TARGET PRACTICE. THE STATEMENT ALSO HAS INFORMATION WITH REFERENCE TO AN OCCASION WHEN RITCHEY ARRIVED HOME AT THE APARTMENT AND FOUND SAIDALLAH SIRHAN ASLEEP WITH THE PISTOL ON HIS CHEST. ON 8/19/68 THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACTED SAIDALLAH SIRHAN AT HIS APARTMENT. THE UNDERSIGNED REVIEWED THE STATEMENTS MADE BY SAIDALLAH, WITH SAIDALLAH, AND ATTEMPTED TO OBTAIN FURTHER INFORMATION FROM MR. SIRHAN. THE ONLY INFORMATION THAT MR. SIRHAN OFFERED THAT HE HAD NOT OFFERED PREVIOUSLY, WAS THAT HE HAD ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS WITHIN THE PAST WEEK OR TWO OBSERVED WHAT HE THOUGHT TO BE A SUSPICIOUS CAR DRIVING UP AND DOWN LAKE AVENUE IN FRONT OF HIS APARTMENT. MR. SIRHAN DESCRIBED THE CAR AS A 1954 CHEVROLET, PURPLE OR GREEN IN COLOR WITH CALIFORNIA LICENSE #LUV 966 OR LUV 699, HOWEVER, HE LATER CHANGED THE LICENSE NUMBER TO BE NUD 966. A CHECK WAS MADE WITH DMV ON LICENSE # NUD 966 AND FOUND IT TO BE REGISTERED TO A 1960 PLYMOUTH STATIONWAGON. MR. SIRHAN WAS ADVISED OF THIS INFORMATION AND HE THEN ADVISED THE UNDERSIGNED THAT THE CORRECT LICENSE NUMBER ON THE VEHICLE HE HAD OBSERVED WAS NUD 996. A CHECK WAS MADE WITH DMV ON THAT LICENSE NUMBER AND THE UNDERSIGNED WAS ADVISED THAT NUD 996 IS REGISTERED TO A 1964 CHEVROLET FOUR DOOR, REGISTERED OWNER, GLAYDES JOSEPHS, 1577 N. GARFIELD AVENUE, PASADENA. MR. SIRHAN WAS ASKED TO DESCRIBE THE OCCUPANT OR OCCUPANTS OF THE VEHICLE HE THOUGHT WAS ACTING SUSPICIOUSLY IN THE AREA OF HIS RESIDENCE, AND HE STATED THAT HE DID NOT OBSERVE THE PERSON OR PERSONS IN THE VEHICLE AND HE COULD NOT DESCRIBE THEM. HE COULD ONLY STATE THAT HE HAD OBSERVED THE VEHICLE DRIVING NORTH AND SOUTH ON LAKE AVENUE DURING THE PAST WEEK OR TWO. HE STATED THAT IT WAS DURING BOTH DAYLIGHT AND DARK HOURS.

THE UNDERSIGNED CONTACTED GLAYDES AND MORRIS JOSEPHS, 1577 N. GARFIELD AVENUE, PASADENA, AND LEARNED THAT THEY HAVE RESIDED AT THAT SAME ADDRESS FOR THE PAST TWENTY-EIGHT YEARS. THEY HAVE OWNED THE 1954 CHEVROLET WITH LICENSE NUMBER NUD 996 FOR THE PAST TEN YEARS, AND THAT FOR THE PAST FOUR YEARS MR. JOSEPHS HAS BEEN THE ONLY DRIVER OF THAT VEHICLE. MRS. JOSEPHS NO LONGER DRIVES THAT CAR BECAUSE THE INDICATOR ON THE DRIVE SHAFT THAT SHOWS WHAT GEAR THE AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION IS IN IS BROKEN, AND SHE IS NOT CAPABLE OF DRIVING THE VEHICLE PROPERLY. MR. JOSEPHS STATED THAT HE IS ABLE TO DRIVE THE CAR. THEY DO NOT HAVE ANY SONS OR DAUGHTERS OR RELATIVES THAT DRIVE THE CAR AND IT IS NEVER LOANED TO ANY OF THEIR FRIENDS. AS FOR THE VEHICLE BEING OBSERVED IN THE AREA OF THE RESIDENCE OF SAIDALLAH SIRHAN, MR. JOSEPHS STATED THAT HE AND HIS WIFE DO THEIR MARKETING AT THE MARKET BASKET STORE LOCATED AT CLAREMONT AND LAKE, OR AT THE RALPHS MARKET LOCATED AT MOUNTAIN AND LAKE. THEY ALSO PATRONIZE MANY OF THE OTHER STORES ALONG LAKE AVENUE AND ALSO STORES ON LAKE AVENUE IN ALTADENA. BOTH MR. AND MRS. JOSEPHS STATED THAT THEY DRIVE LAKE AVENUE ON MANY OCCASIONS BECAUSE IT IS A WIDE STREET AND THEY FEEL MORE COMFORTABLE DRIVING IT. THEY STATED THAT THEY HAVE A SAVINGS ACCOUNT AT THE ALTADENA FEDERAL SAVINGS WHICH IS ON LAKE AVENUE, AND ALSO THE DENTIST THAT MRS. JOSEPHS GOES TO IS LOCATED ON LAKE AVENUE NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF ELIZABETH. IT SHOULD BE NOTED, THAT ELIZABETH STREET IS SOUTH ^{OF} SAIDALLAH SIRHAN'S APARTMENT. MR. AND MRS. JOSEPHS ALSO STATED THAT SINCE THERE ARE MANY SMALL "DRIVE-IN" TYPE RESTAURANTS LIKE MACDONALD'S HAMBURGERS LOCATED ON LAKE AVENUE THAT THEY FREQUENT THESE ESTABLISHMENTS QUITE OFTEN AND THIS WOULD BE ANOTHER REASON FOR THEIR BEING ON LAKE AVENUE. THEY DID NOT FEEL THAT THEY ACTED SUSPICIOUSLY IN ANY MANNER AT ANY TIME, AND BOTH STATED THAT THEY WOULD CONTINUE TO USE LAKE AVENUE IN THE FUTURE. THE UNDERSIGNED EXAMINED THE 1954 CHEVROLET OWNED BY MR. AND MRS. JOSEPHS AND FOUND IT TO BE LIGHT BLUE IN COLOR. ON 8/19/68 THE UNDERSIGNED RECONTACTED LINDA MASSRI, 911 ALTA VISTA DRIVE, ALTADENA. THE UNDERSIGNED REVIEWED THE PREVIOUS STATEMENTS MADE BY MRS. MASSRI WITH HER IN CONNECTION WITH THE RIFLE SHE SAW IN POSSESSION OF SAIDALLAH SIRHAN. MISS MASSRI ADDED THAT PRIOR TO HER SEEING THE RIFLE SHE HAD A CONVERSATION WITH SHARIEF SIRHAN WITH REFERENCE TO IT. SHARIEF HAD TOLD HER ABOUT THE RIFLE AND HAD MADE THE STATEMENT THAT, HE, SHARIEF WANTED TO GET THE RIFLE AWAY FROM SAIDALLAH. HE DID NOT WANT IT FOR HIS OWN USE, BUT HE WAS JUST AFRAID FOR SAIDALLAH DUE TO HIS HAVING THE RIFLE. SHARIEF TRIED TO GET MISS MASSRI TO CALL SAIDALLAH ON THE TELEPHONE, AND DURING THIS TELEPHONE CONVERSATION TELL SAIDALLAH THAT SHE WAS A "SECRETARY FROM THE FBI" AND THAT HE BETTER GET RID OF THE RIFLE, OR THEY WOULD TAKE IT AWAY FROM HIM. MISS MASSRI REFUSED TO DO THIS BECAUSE SHE KNEW THAT SAIDALLAH WOULD RECOGNIZE HER VOICE ON THE TELEPHONE. INSTEAD, SHE TOLD SHARIEF THAT HE SHOULD JUST TAKE THE RIFLE AND DO SOMETHING WITH IT TO GET RID OF IT. MISS MASSRI ALSO REMEMBERED HAVING A CONVERSATION WITH SAIDALLAH DURING WHICH SAIDALLAH TOLD HER THAT HE HAD GONE TO THE RIFLE RANGE IN FISH CANYON TO SHOT THE RIFLE AND PRACTICE WITH IT. SAIDALLAH HAD TOLD HER THAT HE HAD THE RIFLE FOR PROTECTION. MISS MASSRI TOLD THE UNDERSIGNED THAT SHE WOULD CONTACT SAIDALLAH AND ATTEMPT TO LEARN WHAT HE DID WITH THE RIFLE, AND IF POSSIBLE WHERE IT IS AT THIS TIME.
