

Re San Francisco Airtel to Los Angeles dated 6/20/68.

On 6/20/68 DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, appeared in the San Francisco Office and furnished a copy of "The Grapes - Communist Wrath in Delano" by GARY ALLEN. He stated that he believed SIRHAN SIRHAN appeared in the photograph on Page 4 of the booklet. He advised the author, GARY ALLEN, resides somewhere in Los Angeles and could possibly reveal the source of the photo.

On 7/12/68 Mr. ROBERT LEAMAN, Regional Coordinator, John Birch Society, 2627 Mission, San Marino, California, advised that one of their members, DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, had telephoned him to advise that he thought the photograph on Page 4 of the booklet "The Grapes" looked a lot like SIRHAN SIRHAN. LEAMAN furnished the name and address of GARY ALLEN, 2812 Tigertail Drive, Rossmoor, California telephone number 430-2282, as the author of the booklet.

On 7/12/68 GARY ALLEN advised he wrote the article "The Grapes-Communist Wrath in Delano" for the June, 1966 issue of American Opinion, an informal monthly review edited by ROBERT WELCH, head of the John Birch Society. He advised that he submitted the article to Belmont, Massachusetts, and, thereafter, had nothing to do with it being printed or presented. He advised the photographs in the article were inserted by the editor and he was unaware of the photographs chosen until they appeared in the article.

ALLEN stated the only person who might be aware of the identity of those persons attending the meeting of the State Labor Commission, held at the Delano High School would be (Sergeant) JERRY DODD, Kern County Sheriff's Office, Bakersfield, California.

Serial 1499 reflects that Sergeant GERALD DODD, Kern County Sheriff's Office, Bakersfield, advised on 7/24/68 that the pertinent photograph was not familiar to him. He said the individual who took the photograph may be DICK SYDER, Administrative Assistant to California Assemblyman, KENT STACEY.

On 7/26/68 RICHARD H. SNYDER was contacted at Assemblyman STACEY's Office, Room 609, 1415 18th Street, Bakersfield. He advised he took the photographs on pages four and nine of "The Grapes", but had no idea of the identity of pertinent individual to the left of photograph on page four of this booklet. SNYDER said he too photograph during Christmas season, 1965, when a rally was held for WALTER REUTHER by farm workers union in Delano. At this time SNYDER said he was employed by local daily newspaper, "The Bakersfield Californian", and later sold photographs regarding this rally to "American Opinion". SNYDER said he would attempt to locate and study copies of other photographs taken at the same time to determine if the individual appearing at left of photograph on page four appears in any additional pictures in his possession.

In Serial 1623 RICHARD SNYDER was recontacted on 7/30/68 and he made available twelve negative film strips representing photographs he took during 12/16/65 at Delano, California. The negative for the photograph was not in his possession since this negative was given to "American Opinion" magazine and never returned.

Prints of these negatives were made and a study of the prints fails to reflect any similarity between the grape strikers and the individual seated to the left side of the photograph on page four.

Serial 1624 reflects the 12 negative film strips were returned to Sacramento Office for return to SNYDER. The photographs were reviewed with negative results concerning SIRHAN.

Serial 1264 reflects that DAVID AVERBUCK, Attorney and SALLY DE WITT, Office Manager, both with United Farm Workers Organizing Committee, 102 Albany, Delano, California, were exhibited the pertinent photograph on July 1, 1968. Both stated the individual in the photograph was unknown to them. On July 24, 1968 DAVID AVERBUCK was recontacted and advised he had exhibited the pertinent photograph to various Union officials and members without effecting an identification.

Sergeants SANDLIN and PATCHETT, Los Angeles Police Department Special Unit-Senator and Special Agents of the FBI who have personally observed SIRHAN SIRHAN in court appearances have advised that the photograph on page four of the booklet is positively not identical with SIRHAN SIRHAN.

In view of the fact that all logical investigation has been completed in this phase of the investigation with completely negative results coupled with the fact that officers have advised the photo is not identical with SIRHAN SIRHAN, it is recommended that this phase be terminated.

Enclosed for the Bureau is one photograph of the custodial facilities in which SIRHAN B. SIRHAN is being detained at the Hall of Justice, Los Angeles, California. The left half of the photograph, under the numeral 2, depicts SIRHAN's general living quarters. This portion of his cell is furnished with a permanent steel cot with mattress, a porcelain wash basin and polished metal mirror. To the right on the photograph, under the numeral 1, is the portion of SIRHAN's quarters containing the necessary sanitary facilities. The foreground portion of the photograph is the corridor in which SIRHAN is permitted to exercise daily. Both ends of this corridor are enclosed.

For the information of the Bureau, the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Special Unit which has been handling the investigation into the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY is curtailing some of their activities with respect to this investigation. Of the 23 men assigned, two of the Lieutenants have been returned to general assignment, though remaining available for special assignments with the unit on a part-time basis. The LAPD team preparing the case are coordinating their reports at this time with the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office so that all interviews conducted by the FBI and the LAPD will be coordinated.

The District Attorney's Office for Los Angeles County is preparing the list of tentative witnesses which they hope to

utilize in the forthcoming trial of SIRHAN. They have broken the witnesses down into approximately three categories:

(1) Witnesses who will be used in the trial and whose testimony will be available to the defense under the proper motion before the Court.

(2) Witnesses who might be of possible interest to the defense attorneys and to the trial but who will not be used by the District Attorney.

(3) Individuals who have been interviewed but who contribute nothing toward either the prosecution or the defense of SIRHAN.

The District Attorney's Office has taken the position that nothing will be made available except through the proper channels of the Court. The prosecutive team for the District Attorney's Office at this time consists of Chief Deputy District Attorney LYNN COMPTON and Deputy District Attorneys JOHN HOWARD and DAVID FITTS. Any participation on the part of Los Angeles County District Attorney EVELLE YOUNGER has not yet been decided upon. The current estimate of the length of the trial on the part of the District Attorney's Office at this time is 12 weeks.

The defense has investigators attempting to locate any persons who might have served SIRHAN liquor at the Ambassador Hotel on the night of 6/4/68. This is apparently in connection with the previously reported information that SIRHAN allegedly paid a \$20.00 tip to an individual in the MAX RAFFERTY Campaign Headquarters at the hotel for serving him a drink. No such person or incident has yet been uncovered. Hotel officials have been informed by the District Attorney's Office that there is no restriction on making available to the defense a list of employees so that such employees may be interviewed by the defense.

(Detective Sergeant) GUS FEDERLY, Assistant to Under-Sheriff WILLIAM MC CLOUD, Los Angeles County, advised on a confidential basis that the only individuals visiting SIRHAN are his mother, MARY SIRHAN, and his brothers, MUNIR and ADEL. However, none of these individuals have visited SIRHAN alone. They are always accompanied by his attorney, RUSSELL PARSONS.

In addition, MICHAEL MC COWAN, who is acting as a private investigator for the defense, also visits with SIRHAN. Among the visitors permitted by PARSONS is ROBERT KAISER, who is listed as an investigator. KAISER is reported to be a former photographer and writer for "Time Magazine" and is believed at this time to be gathering information for articles, stories or books concerning SIRHAN to be written at a later date. It has previously been indicated that PARSONS has apparently assumed the position of legally representing the SIRHAN family in any publications to be prepared.

At the present time the Los Angeles Division is current in its investigation, and a current report is being prepared. The bulk of the outstanding investigation at the present time is to report the results of the interviews of out-of-state guests at the Ambassador Hotel, as requested by the LAPD. The results of these interviews will be incorporated in an additional report.

The Bureau will be kept advised of current events, and it is to be noted that the forthcoming October 4 hearing in this matter may not be held, in view of the appointment of a trial Judge during the past week. This information was furnished to the Bureau previously.

DIETER W. BAYER, 1332 Grand Avenue, Pacifica, California, home telephone 355-0251, appeared at the San Francisco Office of the FBI with a reprint and said that he believed SIRHAN B. SIRHAN appears in the photograph of Page 4.

BAYER said he has been trying to contact GARY ALLEN in Los Angeles through the John Birch Society and has been unable to do so to date. He hoped that ALLEN would be able to reveal the source of the picture as the article does not show this.

BAYER further indicated that he is an amateur photographer and he enlarged this picture and is satisfied in his own mind that it is identical to SIRHAN.

BYER said that he obtained the reprint from a public source, stating that he is collecting articles on communism in this country. He is an escapee from East Germany and has been in this country since 1961.

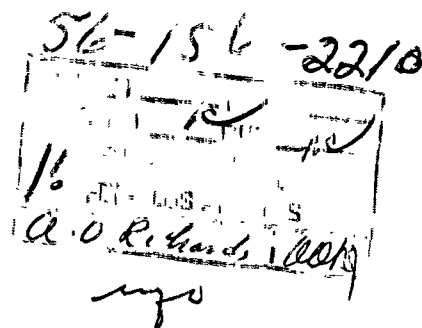

dx Re airtel from Director to Los Angeles 8/5/68, (56-156-1647 Page 3, Item 5), which requests the identity of the Los Angeles fireman who visited HANS PETER BIDSTRUP, electrician at the Ambassador Hotel, who was working in a sound booth in the Venetian Room at the hotel approximately 10 PM on 6/4/68. Ascertain from the fireman whether he could identify the male Caucasian who was having a conversation with BIDSTRUP at the time. Resolve whether or not this male Caucasian was or was not SIRHAN SIRHAN.

Regarding the above lead, SA LESLIE F. WARREN interviewed BIDSTRUP and FD-302 was dictated on 8/14/68. He furnished a description of the fireman in question.

WILLIAM F. GARDNER, former Chief Security Officer who was at the Ambassador Hotel on 6/4/68, identified Inspector CECIL LYNCH of the Fire Prevention Department of the Los Angeles Fire Department, as a person who could identify the fireman on duty in the Venetian Room on 6/4/68, described by BIDSTRUP. Results of interview with GARDNER appear in FD-302 dated 8/19/68.

Inspector CECIL LYNCH identified the fireman in question as MICHAEL D. WHARTON of the Fire Prevention Bureau at 7166 West Manchester Avenue, Los Angeles, (see FD-302 on LYNCH dated 8/20/68).

WHARTON was interviewed 9/17/68 (see FD-302 dated 9/19/68).

DOUG DILTS, former UPI News Reporter, interviewed 7/9/68 regarding KENSALT, claimed he had talked with several persons in the Embassy Room at the Ambassador Hotel, Los Angeles, shortly after the shooting of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY, Et Al. Names, but no addresses, of these persons had been obtained by DILTS.

Two of the above persons mentioned by DILTS were RICHARD ORFALEA, who was in the company of DAVID ROCHE. Both claimed they had seen a man thought to have been the man who shot KENNEDY in the Embassy Room near the podium.

RICHARD ORFALEA, interviewed by San Francisco at 455 Eddy Street, San Francisco, in August 1968, revealed ORFALEA not acquainted with anyone by the name of DAVID ROCHE but had attended the Senator KENNEDY's campaign party at the Ambassador Hotel on 6/4/68, P.M., and 6/5/68, A.M., with PATRICK MC LAUGHLIN. The latter could be reached through his parents in Los Angeles, MC LAUGHLIN being currently in Memphis, Tennessee.

VIRGINIA (Mrs. FRANCIS H.) MC LAUGHLIN, 969 South Keniston Avenue, Los Angeles, phone 939-1664, advised on 9/26/68 that her son, PATRICK MC LAUGHLIN, had attended the affair at the Ambassador Hotel with RICHARD ORFALEA, and

I have completed a lengthy and detailed examination and comparison of the handwriting contained in the two spiral notebooks and other related papers in the SIRHAN matter with and against the accumulated exemplar writings of SIRHAN SIRHAN.

At the time of my preliminary report, August 22, 1968, it was anticipated that additional exemplar writings of SIRHAN would be located and identifiable, but none has been found. Thus, the complete examination and comparison has been carried out with the same exemplar materials but with considerable additional time being spent upon it.

My original opinion concerning the signature of SIRHAN SIRHAN in the "sign in" sheet, at the SAN GABRIEL RIFLE RANGE, dated June 4, 1968, has been strengthened considerably by the additional time spent in the overall examination. Too, the lengthy inter-comparison of writing in the spiral notebooks has been of great value and a much firmer opinion concerning that writing has been reached.

Therefore, at this time I wish to state my opinion concerning all the writings and the examination thereof.

It is my specific and unqualified opinion that SIRHAN SIRHAN is the person responsible for the writing of his name on the "sign in" sheet at the SAN GABRIEL RIFLE RANGE. It is also my specific and unqualified opinion that he is the person responsible for more than 90% of the writings found in the two spiral notebooks.

To explain the 90% opinion, the remaining 10% of the writing relates to obscure words and phrases that have been written in a manner unlike that found in the identifiable exemplar writing. Observation and evaluation of the notebook writing as a whole indicates a writer who apparently "experiments" with his writing construction from time to time.

Further, it is my specific and unqualified opinion that he in particular, wrote the words on pages 15, 17, 21, 26, 35, 39, 47, in the Pasadena City College notebook and pages 123, 124, 125, and 126 of the larger notebook.

Such would be my testimony in court.
