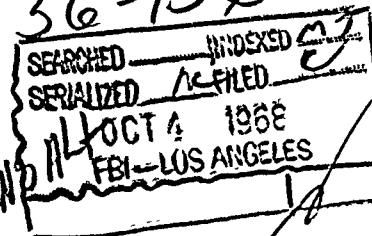

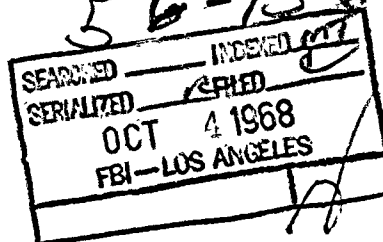

With regard to the information that the DCA, as of July, 1968, was anticipating the institution of a lawsuit against Mayor SAM YORTY concerning his linking the DCA with SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, a pretext telephone conversation was conducted by SA WALT H. SIRENE on 9/25/68. The guise used was that of an author preparing a book.

A person identifying himself as JARVIS TYNER, of the National Office of the W.E.B. Du Bois Clubs of America, stated after consulting with the organizational secretary that to date no suit had been filed against YORTY, however, the lawyers were preparing for such a lawsuit and they had a couple of "interesting arguments". TYNER could furnish no date when the suit might be filed, however, he said that a press conference would be called at the time so as to take advantage of all publicity that they could arrange. Upon further questioning, TYNER said that to his knowledge, no target date had been set for the filing of this suit. No further pertinent information was learned during this conversation.

This information is furnished to the Los Angeles Office for whatever action they deem appropriate.

AT WICHITA, KANSAS:

A review of the latest Wichita, Kansas City Directory on 9/23/68 revealed that JOSEPH SCHERR and his wife BETTY L. SCHERR, reside at 433 S. Brookside Drive and have telephone number MU 3-7457. His occupation is listed as salesman for the Bulova Watch Company.

KATHERINE PERKINS, Records Bureau, Wichita, Kansas Police Department, searched her records on 9/23/68 and advised the only records she had of a JOSEPH SCHERR, 433 S. Brookside Drive is that he was involved in a non-injury accident on 3/3/65. He was listed as 48 years of age at that time.

BERNICE SHARPLESS, Credit Bureau of Wichita, searched her records on 9/23/68 and advised that JOSEPH SCHERR and his wife, BETTY, have been in the files of the Credit Bureau since June, 1962. They formerly resided at 5859 Lakehurst, Dallas, Texas, and have three children.

Mrs. NADINE BOOHER, owner of The Malibu Riviera Restaurant at 20356 Pacific Coast Highway, Malibu, California, furnished information concerning remarks made by a HERMAN PRUJAN, whose last name is PRUJANSKY, but who is generally known by the nickname "TURK." Mrs. BOOHER stated that TRUJAN was the general manager of the restaurant but was terminated because of his general attitude and questionable integrity.

Mrs. BOOHER indicated that TRUJAN in a casual conversation said something to the effect that HOFFA had too much influence and control over the union members to allow anyone to be elected president, who had offended him, and in particular that BOBBY KENNEDY could not get elected until HOFFA was released from prison.

RE: DAVID MYERS

Information has previously been reported that MUNIR SIRHAN, brother of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, had been arrested in Flagstaff, Arizona, in 1966 with a DAVID MYERS, a PHILLIP CLEAVENGER, and a RONALD HULEN. CLEAVENGER and HULEN have been located and interviewed but MYERS has never been interviewed.

MUNIR SIRHAN was interviewed by agents of this office and could not furnish any background information on MYERS as he had only known him as a hitchhiker at the particular time of the arrest in Flagstaff, Arizona. MUNIR SIRHAN did indicate that at one time he believed that MYERS had been in the custody of a juvenile camp somewhere in Los Angeles County. Description of MYERS is contained in Los Angeles file 56-156.
