


Enclosed for Los Angeles are 22 copies of an FD 302 reflecting the investigation to locate and interview VINCENT M. GUAGHAN.



Mrs. NADINE BOOHER advised that she resides 11141 Mansel, Inglewood, California, and that she owns and manages the Malibu Riviera Restaurant, 20356 Pacific Coast Highway, Malibu, California.

Mrs. BOOHER stated that the only recollection she has of a conversation wherein something may have been mentioned concerning both HOFFA and KENNEDY would have been some considerable time prior to the KENNEDY assault and murder. Mrs. BOOHER said that she had formerly employed one HERMAN RRUJAN, whose true last name is PRUJANSKY, but who is generally known by the nickname "TURK". PRUJAN had been the General Manager of the restaurant; however, was terminated because of his general attitude and questionable integrity. He last worked during mid-May of this year and has not been seen since that time. Mrs. BOOHER said that PRUJAN had told her he formerly was in business in Detroit, Michigan, and had several dealings, not more specifically described, with JIMMIE HOWFA. She said that in a casual political conversation, PRUJAN (TURK) said something to the effect that "HOFFA has too much influence and control over the union members to allow anyone to be elected president who had offended him and in particular that BOBBY KENNEDY couldn't get elected unless HOFFA were released from prison.

Mrs. BOOHER, who advised she is also known by the name of NADINE SKAFF, furnished her date of birth as June 8, 1918. She said she has no knowledge or information which she considered would be of any pertinent interest in connection with the KENNEDY murder and that any comment made by her concerning KENNEDY and HOFFA would have been based on the general topic of political campaigns and elections. She added, however, that she is aware of the fact that her former employee, PURJAN, has been under investigation by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office in connection with the theft or sale of stolen TV sets. She could not be more specific regarding this.

On 9-17-68 MRS. FRANCES EVANS, 11125 Hibbing, Cerritos, Calif., recontacted advised as follows:

She attended an adult education class in Introduction to Philosophy from Sept. 1967 to Jahuary 1968 at Fullerton Junior College; instructor, KIM NAFFA. In addition to the classes there were discussion groups made up of State College teachers, teachers, members of NAFFA'S class and interested individuals. NAFFA had many Arab friends that attended the discussion sessions that were not members of this class. They discussed current problems in the mid-east and their problems with the Zionists and the like.

NAFFA did not appear as radical as some off the people present but does support the Arab viewpoint. Those in attendance that night and on other occassions generally had the viewpoint that there is a revolution now in progress in the world and on the campuses which they favored. These people if not pro-Communists were at least one world advocates.

After one of the discussion groups in November 1967 at NAFFA'S home, 408 Barry Pl., Placentia, unlisted telephone 714-528-1170, 3 or 4 Jordanians came there from Pasadena, Calif., some were studying engineering at Pasadena City College. One of those from Pasadena spoke with quiet desperation about how has fathers land and home had been taken from them twice by the Zionists and to the effect that to heck with Philosophy if the Communists would help them why not go with them. She said she is 99% sure this was SIRHAN SIRHAN who she later saw on TV.

EVANS was not sure who else was there, maybe SIRHAN'S brother, possibly TED VJARDIS, Economics Prof., Cal. State Fullerton, a Greek and perhaps JOHN BUTTON, a teacher and one world advocate; Grography, Cary State Julianian.

MRS. EVANS, a housewife, two children said she is registering Cal. State Fullerton this semester to further her education, one year at Unio. Texas.

MRS. EVANS said that a Jewish friend of hers said they considered NAFFA a public relations man for Jordan and that he speaks at many affairs because of his moderate views.

Persons interviewed in connection with the investigation conducted in the San Francisco area have indicated that BILL BEAR is presently in the Seattle, Washington, area but they have no specific information through which he could be located.

ANTHONY GRICCO Manager, Continental TV, Inc., 3300 Broadway, Oakland, California, has advised that WILLIAM BEAR was employed by him as a salesman for about two months. BEAR left without giving notice about the middle of August and has not been seen since by GRECCO. GRECCO in fact owes BEAR \$90 in commissions which he would be happy to pay him if BEAR would get in touch with him. Approximately six weeks ago GRECCO received a telephone call from a Muntz TV dealer in Seattle asking for references in regard to BEAR and indicated that BEAR was then employed by him. GRECCO does not recall the name of this dealer but stated he is probably the only Muntz TV dealer in Seattle.

SHIRLEY MARSH advised that she has not seen BILL BEAR for about six weeks to two months, and that she has heard he is somewhere in the feattle area. She went on to say that he has a brother, JOHN BEAR, who resides in Des Moines, Washington, but she does not know the addess of this brother and he does not have a telephone. JOHN BEAR, however, has a girlfriend, name unknown, who lives in Des Moines, Washington, who has telephone number 878-4099. She also advised that BILL BEAR's mother, name not known, resides in Rupert, Idaho, and has telephone number 436-4581.

It was also ascertained from MARSH that at the time BEAR disappeared from the San Francisco area he was in possession of an automobile owned by hep. This vehicle is described as a two-door 1964 Thunderbird medium tan in color, and bearing California license-CYS 1524 MARSH has heard nothing from BEAR since he left and she has been unable to get in touch with him.

assigned to Company C, 1st Battalion, U. S. Army Medical
Training Center, Fort Sam Houston, advised that on June 4-5,
1968, he resided at 513 Ocean Boulevard, Manhatten Beach,
California. His present home address is 235 25th St.,
Hermosa Beach, California. He advised he is a graduate of
the University of Southern California at Los Angeles in
June, 1967, and in June, 1968, was working for the Manhatten
Beach City School District as a substitute teacher, fourth
through eighth grades.

He advised he arrived at the Embassy Room about 7:45 p.m., June 4, 1968, With him in his car was his girl friend CAROL FENBURY, 2216 Strand, Manhatten Beach, California, and his brother ROBERT R. HODGES, 531 21st St., Manhatten Beach, California.

In a second car was his brother DAVID HODGES, 235 25th St., Hermosa Beach, California, and the latter's girl friend JANET LOWRIE, who iscemployed at the Westrey Nursery School. Also in that car were DEKKER RAWLINGS and his wife SHARON RAWLINGS who live in Manhatten Beach.

The two cars arrived with their occupants within five minutes of each other.

LINDA LEE HODGES, wife of ROBERT R. HODGES, had gone to the Embassy Room earlier and stayed later than the others of the party.

From approximately 7:45 p.m. until about 11:30 p.m., all of the party were together, standing between the TV cameras and the entrance to the corridor from which Senator KENNEDY was expected to enter the Embassy Room.

HODGES remembered that at about 10:30 or 10:45 p.m., he saw a man with bushy dark hair, slight build, about 5'5" tall, dressed in an old jacket, dark dirty-looking pants, walking from the direction of the corridor doors toward the podium. He said he lost sight of this individual in the

crowd, and that he really saw only the back of his head. He said that this man was not moving in a definite direction, but appeared rather to be wandering.

He said this individual attracted his attention because he was the only unkempt person in the room; everyone else there was dressed in business clothes and looked clean and well kept. He said that he remembered remarking to his girl friend CAROL FENBURY, "How do you suppose he got in?" He said he was not sure, but that CAROL may have seen this individual also.

HODGES said that none of the members of his party had a camera. He did not remember seeing any girl in a polka dot dress.

HODGES viewed a photograph of SIRHAN B. SIRHAN, and stated he could not identify the unkempt person he had seen as being identical with the photo of SIRHAN.

He said that since the hour was getting late and it appeared they would not be able to see Senator KENNEDY, he, CAROL FENBURY, and ROBERT HODGES left about 11:30 p.m. in their car and the others with the exception of LINDA LEE HODGES left in their car at the same time. He said that his car was on the freeway returning to Manhatten Beach, California, when they heard the announcement of the shooting on the radio.

HODGES said that CAROL FENBURY is employed by the Torrance City School District. His sister-in-law, LINDA LEE HODGES, is a substitute teacher employed by the Lennox School District. His brother, ROBERT R. HODGES, is a law student attending a private law school near Long Beach, the name of which he could not remember. His younger brother DAVID HODGES is a student at El Camino Junior College.
