While in Denmark, Mrs. BACON invited Miss JENSEN to visit them on a trip she was planning to the United States in 1968.

Miss AASE G. JENSEN arrived at the BACON residence in Des Moines. Nowa, during the early part of May, 1968. After renaining in Des Moines, Iowa, for a few weeks as a house guest of the BACONs, she desired to see the western part of the United States and made arrangements for this travel through a Greyhound Bus tour. Following this tour, she returned to Des Moines, Iowa, and during the latter part of July, 1968, accompanied Mr. and Mrs. BACON on a vacation trip to Maine.

Sometime around July 22, 1968, Miss AASE JENSEN departed the United States and returned to Denmark. Her current address is:

Miss AASE G. JENSEN Valby Langgade 482 No. 8 Valby Copenhagen, Denmark

Mrs. BACON said that Miss JENSEN is employed as a waitress at the Baltic Hotel in Copenhagen, Denmark, a job she has had for the past seven or eight years.

Mrs. BACON said that Miss JENSEN is a Danish citizen and speaks very little English. She said that when Miss JENSEN returned to Des Moines, Iowa, from Los Angeles, California, she said she was in her room at the Ambassador Hotel the night Senator KENNEDY was assassimated and had been upset by the noise, sirens and screaming that followed the shooting.





On 11/25/68, Mr. JOHN HOWARD, Deputy, Los Angeles County District Attorney, advised his office has received no "official" notification of any change in the trial date of 12/9/68, for SIRHAN B. SIRHAN. He advised, however, that speculation is that a continuance for the beginning of the trial will undoubtedly be sought by GRANT B. COOPER who is expected to enter the case in behalf of the defense of SIRHAN. It is Mr. HOWARD's opinion that due to the fact that Mr. COOPER is currently engaged in defending one of the defendants in the Friars Club trial in U.S. District Court, Los Angeles, he will not be prepared to properly represent SIRHAN on 12/9/68.

On 11/25/68, Mr. H.M. FREDIANI, Criminal Courts Coordinator for the Los Angeles County Superior Court System, confidentially advised as follows:

No action of record has taken place to date with respect to a continuance for a trial for SIRHAN B. SIRHAN. He expects, however, that on 12/3/68, all of the litigants will reappear before Judge HERBERT V. WALKER to request a continuance in the beginning trial date, which is now scheduled for 12/9/68.

Dear Sirs:

Last June when Senator Robert Kennedy was shot, I requested through our local FBI office that information be sent to you to the effect that it might be of importance to know whether Mr. Sirhan Sirhan was using one of the amphetamine drugs at the time of the incident. It was suggested that a urine sample be obtained for analysis of amphetamine content.

As you are well aware, amphetamines have become increasingly implicated in certain violent forms of behavior and especially in certain murder cases. The association of amphetamine use with violence has been of special interest to a group of us here at Duke studying this problem. We have indications that certain of the other assassination attempts were by people who were known users of amphetamines; for instance, James Earl Ray apparently was a known user of methadrine.

Because this is such a vital problem at present, we would appreciate any information that you could give us concerning either (1) the urinalysis if it was done and/or (2) information about a past history of having used amphetamines in Mr. Sirhan Sirhan's case. Since there is a possibility that this information would not be available before trial, I would appreciate a letter to this effect, if that is the case.

We would appreciate any consideration that you can give us in this matter.

interviewed by this office with the exception of MURIFL LEE, who did not actually observe the shooting of Senator ROBERT KENNEDY nor did she observe SIRHAN prior to the shooting. Interview of MURIEL LEE will be conducted by the Los Angeles Office and the results set forth in a forthcoming Los Angeles report.

It is noted that this list of witnesses does not include any technical or medical witnesses. The names of such witnesses to be used have not as yet been furnished by the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office.

For the information of the Bureau, as of approximately noon, 12/4/68, the Pasadena Police Department, who have had a fixed observation post on the SIRHAN residence in Pasadena, advised that this was now being given up. The Pasadena Police Department advises that the security measures in effect will be (1) frequent pass-bys by a police cruiser and a stop by a police cruiser at the residence at least once a day, (2) the installation of a "hot telephone" at the SIRHAN home so that anyone at the residence wishing to contact the Pasadena Police Department may do so by merely lifting the receiver.
