Noyes also expressed considerable suspicion as to how and why Russell Parsons was selected to represent Sirhan in the recent trial. He stated that it has come to his attention that Parsons had a considerable dislike for Robert Kennedy, because of Kennedy's alleged investigation of Parsons when he, Kennedy, was with the United States Senate Rackets Committee.

Noyes also advised that he has listened studiously and many times to the tape recording made of the interview with Sirhan by Dr. Diamond, at which time Sirhan was under hypnosis. One of the names mentioned by Sirhan, while under hypnosis, was "Kathleen". According to Noyes, when the name of "Kathleen" was mentioned by Sirhan, Dr. Diamond immediately made a reference to one Kathleen Rafferty, not further identified by Noyes. Noyes suggested that the "Kathleen" mentioped by Sirhan could be a reference to the late Kathy Fulmer, recently found a victim of an overdoes of narcotics in allos Angeles motel, and who died in the Los Angeles County General Hospital. On the morning that Fulmer died at the hospital, Jack Fox received an anonymous telephone call advising him that Kathy Fulmer was dead. The anonymous caller furnished no further information and the caller has not been identified. Noyes has determined that one Jose Onilla visited Fulmer while she was in the hospital and prior to her death. He did not, however, have an opportunity to talk to her since she was comatose and never regained consciousness before she died.

With respect to the recent prosecutive activities conducted by District Attorney Jim Garrison of New Orleans, Louisiana, Noyes suggested that Garrison failed in his prosecutive efforts because the Eugene Bradley of North Hollywood, whom Garrison suspected was in reality Jim Braden, mentioned above, who has also used the alias of Gene Bradley.

Noyes explained that on the day of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, in Dallas, Braden was present in that city, was interviewed by a Deputy Sheriff of the Dallas Sheriff's Office, at which time he advised that he had been in the Texas Book Depository building or some other building, attempting to make a telephone call.

Upon learning of the foregoing, Noyes telephonically contacted Sheriff Bill Decker of Dallas, approximately one week ago, at which time Decker expressed surprise to be advised that Braden had been in Dallas on the day of the assassination. Noyes desired to know if Jim Braden and Eugene Hale Brading were known to authorities to be one in the same person. No comment was made regarding that specific question.

On May 6, 1969, Noyes had advised that the Eugene Hale Brading to whom he referred to on May 5, 1969, has FBI Number 799 431.

In addition to the foregoing, Noyes was advised that his continuing investigation into the activities of Brading, who is now better known as Jim Braden, has developed that Empire Oil Company owns 50 percent of another firm known as Bonanza International. The base company is Empire Crude Oil Company and it is with this organization that Braden is currently affiliated.

He stated that the Empire Company apparently has an office at 3925 Oneida Street in Denver, Colorado. Noyes explained his investigation is continuing since he is still of the opinion that Braden is the individual whom District Attorney Jim Garrison of New Orleans, Louisian, was referring to in his recent prosecution of Clay Shaw rather than Eugene Bradley of North Hollywood whom Garrison had insisted was the person he was looking for. Noyes again reiterated his contention that Jim Braden was in some way involved in the assassination of the late President John F. Kennedy in Dallas, Texas in 1963.

On May 12, 1969, Noyes again telephonically advised, on an extremely confidential basis, that he has spoken with Robert Kaiser, an investigator for the defense team who represented Sirhan Bishara Sirhan. Kaiser is also writing a book concerning the assassination and has advised Noyes that he has seven reasons which he considers valid to suspect

that a conspiracy actually did exist. Noyes proposed to Kaiser that Kaiser contact Sirhan and specifically ask him whether he, Sirhan, had actually attended a meeting of the Black Panthers in Los Angeles prior to the assassination of the late Robert F. Kennedy on June 5, 1968.

Kaiser subsequently contacted Noyes and advised that he had interviewed Sirhan which interview was recorded on tape. When Kaiser asked Sirhan whether he had ever attended a Black Panther meeting, Sirhan became considerably upset; denied he had ever attended such a meeting, but told Kaiser that he had, in fact, visited the Black Muslim Temple in Los Angeles.

On May 5, 1969, Kaiser furnished information which he alleged came from a source whom he described as a former officer in the Black Panther organization in Los Angeles. That information was to the effect that Sirhan had been observed by the aforementioned former member of the Black Panther at a meeting of that organization approximately one month prior to June 5, 1968. /Noyes advised on May 12, 1969, again on an extremely confidential basis, his former Black Panther source is Shermont Backs. He stated that Banks is no longer affiliated with the Black Panther Party because he refused to go use a gun on one previous occasion. Noyes alleges that Banks is currently "hiding out" in the CBS facility in fear of his life. Noyes explained he could make Banks available for interview by FBI Agents.

Noyes again chose to discuss the Dallas, Texas, assassination of the late President Kennedy and stated with respect to Jim Braden that he, Noyes, had learned that Braden had an appointment with Lamar Hunt in Dallas on November 20, 1963, and was scheduled to leave Dallas on November 21, 1963.

Noyes also stated he learned from his New York CBS affiliate that there is a midwest publishing house which prints the literature paid for and put out by H.L. Hunt of Hunt Foods.

Noyes explained that in December 1968, former FBI Agent William Turner approached him in Los Angeles and attempted to sell to CBS the "Zapruter film". Noyes at that time was skeptical and checked with the legal staff at CBS, KNXT-TV, 6121 Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles, California. One of the attorney's for CBS is also a lawyer for Life magazine and advised Noyes that the "Zapruter film" is a copyright document owned by Life magazine publication and that Turner very possibly did not have legal possession which would permit CBS, KNXT-TV, 6121 Sunset Boulevard, Los Angeles, to exhibit it. Noyes learned later that KTLA-TV ran the "Zapruter film", but it was not adaptable for TV.

At about that time, Turner advised Noyes that he had sent one Jim Rose (a Turner associate) to 280 Beverly Drive, Beverly Hills, California, in an attempt to locate Braden. While there, Rose was allegedly told that Braden was not in town and was not expected back for a month. Rose obtained the names of the occupants of the building from the building directory which includes J.M. Arnoff, Gerald Chase and Wallace Host, three of the individuals previously mentioned by Noyes on May 5, 1969.

Noyes explained that Turner's price for the sale of the "Zapruter film" to him was to be installed as an investigator for CBS. Noyes explained that CBS had eliminated their investigative staff approximately two years ago and no longer has such an organization. Noyes did not negotiate with Turner for the film based upon legal advice from the studio's attorney.

He stated that Turner also advised that Braden had been in Dallas, Texas, and had moved to Los Angeles from that city shortly after the assassination of the late President John F. Kennedy.

Noyes claims to have been in contact with Robert Finen, current Secretary of Health and Welfare. Concerning his beliefs regarding Braden, he explained that Finch is extremely concerned with the various militant groups functioning throughout the United States since Hew is responsible for the funding money for the programs under the auspices of the Federal Government.

The "Zapruter film" referred to herein is the movie film taken of the presidential motorcade in Dallas in December 1963, by Abraham Zapruter which was apportedly sold to Life magazine.

Enclosed herewith for the Bureau are 22 copies of an LHM concerning information furnished by PETE NOYES. Two copies each of this LHM are likewise being made available to Dallas and New Orleans for information and any action deemed appropriate by those Divisions.

For the information of the Bureau, Dallas and New Orleans, PETE NOYES is the managing editor at KNXT-TV, a CBS affiliate, 6121 Sunset Boulevard, Hollywood, California. NOYES is currently producing the news show entitled "The Big News" which originates from Los Angeles. NOYES on 5/6/69, requested an opportunity to speak with a Special Agent of the FBI and U.S. Attorney W. MATTHEW BYRNE concerning some information he had developed in the course of investigation conducted by he, PETE NOYES, and JACK FOX, another KNXT-TV associate. Information which NOYES stated he obtained pertained to the recent investigation conducted concerning the assassination of the late Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

In addition to the information contained in the LHM and for the additional information for the Bureau, Dallas and New Orleans, NOYES is admittedly in the process of preparing a book for publication. It is his desire to emphasize in his book the assassination of the late President JOHN F. KENNEDY in Dallas in November 1963, and for that reason, information contained herewith is being made available to Dallas. In addition, NOYES is of the opinion that the EUGENE BRADLEY, who recently figured prominently in the activities in New Orleans concerning the prosecution of CLAY SHAW by New Orleans District Attorney, JAMES GARRISON, is acutally EUGENE HALE BRADING, FBI Number 499 431. It is the contention of NOYES that BRADING is the individual whom GARRISON actually wanted rather than the EUGENE BRADLEY of North Hollywood.



AL-SANOUSSI attended several court sessions of the recent trial of SIRHAN SIRHAN, as a newspaper correspondent for a paper in Kuwait.

According to MC DEVITT, the LAPD has no information in their files on MOHAMMED AL-SANOUSSI and he is desirous of obtaining any available information regarding him.





On 6/25/69, JOHN CHRISTIAN, who has previously contacted this office, telephonically contacted SA R.J. LA JEUNESSE, JR., and furnished the following information:

He directed a letter on 6/2/69, to Mayor SAM YORTY, of Los Angeles, requesting that YORTY intervene with the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), concerning the information he, CHRISTIAN, has previously discussed with members of the LAPD. CHRISTIAN was referring to his previous contacts with the LAPD, regarding an alleged conspiracy between JERRY OWEN and SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, in the assassination of the late Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. As a result of his letter, Mayor YORTY had BOB STEVENS, of YORTY's staff, contact CHRISTIAN on 6/9/69, and on 6/12/69, CHRISTIAN claims to have had a three hour meeting with STEVENS, as a representative of Mayor YORTY.

CHRISTIAN commented that Mayor YORTY on the "premiere show", entitled "The Walking Bible", which appeared on Channel 13, on 6/15/69. CHRISTIAN stated the show entitled "The Walking Bible", is aired by JERRY OWENS; and a regularly scheduled TV program appearing on Channel 13.

CHRISTIAN claims that TV time for the show costs \$750 per half hour, and the show has a contract with Channel 13, on what he characterized as a "TFN", basis, which is, according to CHRISTIAN, a "Till Further Notice" contract. In addition to the above cost, there is a cost of \$1,000 per program for video taping, an estimated cost for talent of \$750 per show, totaling approximately \$2,500 per show.

The TV show is managed by PAUL MEBB, a producer, whose only other account is the Audio Bible Studies.

CHRISTIAN stated he was bringing the foregoing to the writer's attention, because he does consider the program "The Walking Bible" to be a "cover conduit", through which a lot of money could be passed. CHRISTIAN claims that OWENS has no sponsor for the program, has not attempted to solicit funds to support the program, and therefore, according to CHRISTIAN, apparently has an independent source of money to support the program.

CHRISTIAN stated that in his opinion, there definitely exists a conspiracy between SIRHAN and OWENS, and that OWENS has received a large sum of money for his participation in the conspiracy.

CHRISTIAN also commented that apparently, Mayor YORTY did not know who OWENS was, or anything about him, prior to agreeing to appear on OWENS' TV show. The foregoing is being made a matter of record, inasmuch as it is anticipated CHRISTIAN will continue to contact the Los Angeles Office concerning his beliefs, with respect to an alleged conspiracy.

JABARA was present in Los Angeles during the trial of SIRHAN.

It is noted that GEORGE EDWARD SHIBLEY is the subject of Bureau file 100-49214, Los Angeles file 100-7370. His residence is listed as 2171 North Linden, Long Beach, California, and it is noted that GEORGE HECKERT, Chief Investor, State Bar of California, 601 Mc Allister, San Francisco, California, advised on 5/3/67, that SHIBLEY was a member of the Southern California Chapter of the National Lawyer's Guild.

He had received in the mail, from an anonymous source, a document which he represented to be a "report" pertaining to the investigation of the assassination of the late President JOHN F. KENNEDY.

NOYES advised that the report bore the name of "SAIC JOHN RICE". In as much as the writer recognized the foregoing as a representative of the United States Secret Service. NOYES was so advised.

On 7/15/69, Assistant Special Agent in Charge STEWART KNIGHT, United States Secret Service, Los Angeles, California, was advised of the foregoing and stated he would contact NOYES. KNIGHT advised, however, that the document which NOYES referred to as a "report" is part; of the archives pertaining to the assassination of the late President KENNEDY and as such accessible to the public.

On 7/14/69, JOHN CHRISTIAN, who has previously contacted the writer concerning this investigation, telephonically advised, in substance, as follows:

He recently received a letter from Los Angeles County District Attorney EVELLE J. YOUNGER. The letter was in reply to one CHRISTIAN alleges he had previously directed to YOUNGER. In his letter to YOUNGER, CHRISTIAN stated he told YOUNGER he had information concerning a conspiracy in connection with the assassination of the late Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY. CHRISTIAN has maintained all along that the conspiracy exists between JERRY OWENS and SIRHAN B. SIRHAN and has been attempting to interest various law enforcement agencies in his theory. In previous contacts with CHRISTIAN, he has failed to produce any information not already known to the Bureau, the Los Angeles Police Department, and/or the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

CHRISTIAN stated that in the letter he received from YOUNGER, the District Attorney referred CHRISTIAN to the Los Angeles Police Department or the FBI with any information he felt he might possess. CHRISTIAN claimed that he requested that YOUNGER "compare notes" with him pertaining to JERRY OWENS' aspect of the investigation. CHRISTIAN further characterized YOUNGER's letter to him as "snotty or snide", and stated that YOUNGER's response is out of "blind obedience" to the investigation.

It is pointed out that CHRISTIAN has continuously insisted that a conspiracy exists between OWENS and SIRHAN. He has attempted to impose his beliefs on the Los Angeles Police Department, which agency has rejected his premise; the office of Mayor SAM YORTY, who has likewise failed to respond, and the office of the Los Angeles County District Attorney.

BEN HERRICK, Proprietor of the Lock, Stock, and Barrel Gunshop, San Gabriel, California, advised the Los Angeles Office on 7/22/69, that he and his wife DONNA were both questioned in connection with the Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY assassination case.

HERRICK stated that on 7/22/69, his wife left their home at 9436 East Pentland, Temple City, California, at approximately 1:30 P. M. en route to the gunshop and had not arrived there or returned home up until the time of his call, which was at 11:30 P.M. on 7/22/69. HERRICK stated he did not feel that there was any connection between the SIRHAN Case and his wife's disappearance, and that there was no indication of any abduction. HERRICK stated that he knows of no reason why his wife would have left him and has made a report to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office concerning this matter.

It is noted that HERRICK and his wife operate the Lock, Stock, and Barrel Gunshop, San Gabriel, California, where on 6/1/68, SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN bought .22 caliber ammunition. A sales receipt of the gunshop was found in SIRHAN's car when the car was located a few hours after the assassination parked in the vicinity of the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles.

When first questioned DONNA HERRICK indicated that she recalled that SIRHAN had been in the gunshop in approximately April of 1968, accompanied by two other individuals. Mrs. HERRICK was not in the gunshop on the date when SIRHAN actually purchased the ammunition on 6/1/68.

BEN HERRICK also stated when first interviewed that he had recalled SIRHAN coming into the store on approximately 4/15/68, accompanied by two other individuals and indicated that this was the same individual which he identified as SIRHAN, who had been in the store on 6/1/68. The actual sale of ammunition was made by LARRY KENNETH ARNOT, who was a salesman in the store and who also indicated that two individuals accompanied SIRHAN at the time of this purchase. Later ARNOT was given a lie detector test and admitted that he had lied concerning the fact that SIRHAN was accompanied by two other individuals when he came to the store on 6/1/68. In fact, ARNOT admitted that he had no recollection of the sale to SIRHAN, but did verify that he had made out the sales slip. ARNOT indicated that it had been at the suggestion of Mrs. HERRICK concerning the three individuals, that had caused him to so believe that three individuals had come into the store.

This information is being set out for the information of the Bureau and has been furnished to the Los Angeles Police Department Unit interested in the KENNEDY Assassination Case.

These two individuals are better known as "the brothers" and have been operating in the Tijuana, Mexico area for years. They are wanted by both local and Federal authorities in Los Angeles and are considered major narcotic peddlers. Informant further advised that she just received some information from a source (reliability unknown) that Robert Hernandez was shot in the head some time ago and is now having a great deal of eye trouble. According to her source, Robert Hernandez now visits an eye doctor on a regular basis in either Chula Vista or National City, California (name of doctor unknown). She said that his wife, Helen, takes him over the border (location unknown) and to the doctor.

On 7/8/69, the above information concerning "the brothers" was furnished to Inspector Donald W. Read, Internal Revenue Service Los Angeles. Read, a former Federal Narcotics officer, is known to have an interest in the brothers. He in turn, furnished the information to the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs who hold warrants for Juan and Robert Hernandez.

District Court at Los Angeles concerning card cheating at the Friars Club, Beverly Hills, California.

COOPER was charged with two counts of criminal contempt of court in connection with his pessession of the transcript in question.

# Sirhan Lawyer Among 11 Indicted

Attorney Grant B. Cooper, chaif defense counsel for convicted murderer Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, and two other attorneys were among 11 persons indicted in connection with unlawful possession and use of a secret grand jury transcript during the Friars Club card cheating trial.

Cooper, former president of the Los Angeles Bar Association, yesterday was charged with two counts of criminal contempt of court along with Attorney William Marshall Morgan while the third lawyer, James P. Cantillon, is faced with a single contempt charge.

If found guilty, the three could be fined or imprisoned at the discretion of the court, there being no set penalty for the offense. Richard G. Sherman, a fourth attorney, was also indicted for triminal contempt of court and obstruction of justice not related to illegal possession of the trapscript.

Sherman was charged in a separate indictment with attempting to silence witnesses in the Friars Club trial last year and acting as a go-between to transmit bribes to witnesses.

Three defendants in the Friars Club case, Maurice H. Friedman, Manuel (Ricky) Jacobs and Twyman Warner Richardson were indicted for conspiracy in possession of the transcript.

Others accused of conspiracy were Raymond Bernard Cohen, manager of the Scribe Reporting Service which is under contract to furnish trial proceedings to the U.S. District Court; (Continued on Page A-2, Col. 1)

The following is a statement of facts in re information obtained and recorded by the undersigned in an official police investigation, and is a part of an official Police Report on file in the Pasadena Police Department. This investigation included personal observations; the observations of other Police Officers and/or Officers from the California Highway Patrol, L.A. County Sheriff's Office, and

measurements, interviews with the parties to the traffic collision herein referred to, and interviews with all available witnesses who were reported to the undersigned at the time of this investigation.

As a result of these interviews it is believed that the following persons will testify as follows if called as witnesses:

- 1. PASADENA POLICE OFFICER D.E. HYZY

  each party to this collision of his or her full and complete constitutional rights; that in his opinion each party understood them; and that each of them voluntarily waived those rights, and stated that he wished to make a statement concerning this collision without being represented by an attorney.
- 2. MR. THEODORE BARDON HOWN STATED THAT HE IS TUENTY SEVEN YEARS OF AGE AND IS EUPLOYED AS A TRAFFIC OFFICER FOR THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL AT 2201 VIA COMPO AVE IN MONTEBELLO. THAT HE WAS OFF DUTY AND WAS AT THE ORANGE JULIUS STAND AT 1519 N. LAKE AVE, IN THE CITY OF PASADENA ON THE EVENING OF MARCH 27, 1969. THAT HE WAS SITTING IN THE OUTSIDE PATIO AREA FACING LAKE AVE. THAT HE OBSERVED A WALE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING THE STREET IN A WARKED CROSSWALK FROW EAST TO WEST ON LAKE AVE. THAT HE OBSERVED A VOLKSWAGON SOUTHBOUND ON LAKE AVE, IN THE NUMBER ONE TRAFFIC LANE, TRAVELING APPROXIMATELY 30 TO 35 WILES PER HOUR. THAT HE OBSERVED THAT THE PEDESTRIAN NOR THE DRIVER OF THE W SAW EACH OTHER. THAT HE SAW THE W STRIKE THE PEDESTRIAN IN THE WARKED CROSSWALK AND SAW THE VICTIM HURLED INTO THE AIR. THAT HE RAN TO AID THE VICTIM AND SAW THE DRIVER IMMEDIATELY PULLIOUSE TO THE SIDE OF THE ROAD, PARK HIS CAR AND COME BACK TO THE SCENE.
- 3. MR. SADALLAH B. SIRAN (UNABLE TO ADVISE HIM OF HIS RIGHTS TO REMAIN SILENT OR QUESTION HIM DUE TO HIS CONDITION.)
- L. MR. MURRAY ALLEN WILLIAMS: STATED THAT HE IS EIGHTEN YEARS OF AGE AND LIVES AT 266 W. VENTURA ST. IN ALTADENA, CALIFORNIA. THAT HE WAS DRIVING A 1969 VOLKSWAGON SOUTHBOUND ON LAKE AVE IN THE CITY OF PASADENA ON THE EVENING OF MARCH 27, 1969. THAT HE WAS ON HIS WAY TO SCHOOL AT PASADENA CITY COLLEGE. THAT HE SAW NO ONE ON THE STREET UNTIL HE WAS AT THE CROSSWALK AT HOWARD & LAKE. THAT HE FIRST NOTICED THE PEDESTRIAN IN THE WARKED CROSSWALK, AND AT THAT TIME HE WAS UNABLE TO STOP AND STRUCK THE PEDESTRIAN. THAT HE THEN STOPPED HIS VEHICLE AND CASE EACK TO THE SCENE. (SEE ATTACHED WRITTEN STATEMENT)

### PHYSICAL EVIDENCE

KEY POINT WAS ESTABLISHED BY WITNESS HOUN POINTING OUT LOCATION. CTR OF THE VICTIM WAS 9º SOUTH OF THE SOUTHERN WOST PORTION OF THE CROSSWALK. NO SKID WARKS OR DEBRIS IN THE STREET. VICTIM WAS LYING WITH HIS HEAD IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION. DAMAGE TO THE VW CONSISTED OF A LARGE DENT IN THE DRIVER'S DOOR AND THE OUTSIDE REAR VIEW WIRROR TURNED DOWNWARD. PHOTOS # 55 & 56 TAKEN AT THE SCENE, & PHOTOS # 67 & 68 TAKEN LATER AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VEHICLE INVOLVED SHOWING DAMAGE.

SIRHAN, SHARIF BISHARA M235 696 E. HOWARD ST. BOOKING NO: J 114984

LESS OF HIS CONDITION OR IFFTHE PROPER AUTHORITIES WOULD ALLOW OR PROHIBIT HIS ACTION, THIS OFFICER FELT THAT HE SHOULD BE PRESENT AT ST. LUKES HOSPITAL AT THE TIME OF SIRHAN'S VISIT THERE. I INTERSECTED WITH SIRHAN AT LAKE AND WASHINGTON AND HE ACTUALLY FOLLOWED THE POLICE UNIT FROM THAT POINT TO THE PARKING LOT AT ST. LUKES.

I ACCOMPANIED SIRHAN INTO THE HOSPITAL AND WENT WITH HIM TO THE FRONT DESK WHERE WE MET THE NIGHT SUPERVISING NURSE WHO TOCK US TO THE INTENSIVE CARE WARD. THE NURSE CHECKED WITH THE ON-DUTY PERSONNEL AS TO SADALLAH'S PRESENT CONDITION AND THEN SHOWED SHARIF INTO THE WARD.

I FOLLOWED HIM INTO THE WARD AFTER ABOUT A 30 SECOND DELAY AT THE NURSES COUNTER JUST OUTSIDE THE WARD.

INSIDE THE WARD WAS SADALLAH SIRHAN IN A SEMI-CONSCIOUS STATE. AROUND HIS BED WERE CARPENTER, BEARDSHEAR AND RAINES. HIS HEAD WAS BANDAGED, HIS LEG WAS COVERED WITH BLANKETS WHICH WERE SUPPORTED AWAY FROM HIS BODY BY A PROTECTIVE HOOP AND HE WAS BEING INJECTED WITH FLUIDS. THERE WERE THREE OTHER PATIENTS IN THE SAME WARD.

SIRHAN HAD MOVED TO A POSITION ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE BED (LOOKING FROM THE FOOT) NEAR THE UPPER BODY OF SADALLAH. HE WAS SHOUTING IN A DEMANDING TONE SUCH PHRASES AS, "IF YOU KNOW THAT YOU'RE DOING WHY CAN'T YOU TELL ME WHAT'S WRONG." CARPENTER ATTEMPTED TO EXPLAIN THAT IT WAS KNOWN THAT SADALLAH HAD A FRACTURED SKULL AND A BROKEN LEG AND POSSIBLY OTHER INJURIES. SIRHAN CONTUNUED TO SHOUT AND I NOTED MOVEMENT FROM THE PERONS IN THE OTHER BEDS. THE NURSES, RAINES AND BEARDSHEAR ATTEMPTED TO QUIET HIM VERBALLY BUT HE CONTINUED.

SIRHAN THEN REACHED DOWN AND STARTED TO REMOVE THE BLANKETS FROM THE BODY OF SADALLAH AND NURSE RAINES TOLD HIM TO LEAVE THE BLANKETS ALONE AND REACHED OVER TO PUT THE BLANKETS BACK INTO THEIR PROPER POSITION. RAINES WAS STANDING ON THE SAME SIDEOF THE BED AS SIRHAN BUT NEARER THE FOOT OF THE BED. SIRHAN THEN STRUCK AT RAINES WITH HIS LEFT ARM IN A BACKHAND STROKE. RAINES DUCKED TO HIS LEFT AND THE BLOW JUST MISSED HER RIGHT CHEEK AND RIGHT SHOULDER. AT THAT MOMENT RAINES TURNED AND STARTED TOWARD THE TELEPHONE. I GRASPED SIRHAN FROM BEHIND IN A CHOKE NOLD AND TOOK HIM TO THE FLOOR. CARPENTER ASSISTED ME ANDERINGING HIS ARMS BEHIND HIM AND PLACED THE HANDCUFFS ON HIM.

I THEN TOOK SRHAN TO THE POLICE UNIT IN THE PARKING LOT. HE WAS SHOUTING SO'LOUD THAT HE WAS PLACED INSIDE THE CAR TO WAIT FOR THE TRANSPORTING UNIT AS IT WAS FELT THAT HE WOULD WAKEN THE PATIENTS IN THE HOSPITAL.

OFFICERS NICHOLAS AND OLQUIN ARRIVED SHORTLY AND TOOK SIRHAN TO THE CITY JAIL WHERE HE WAS BOOKED ON THE CHARGES OF PC 240-ASSAULT AND PC 415-DISTURBING THE PEACE. IT WAS FELT BY THIS OFFICER THAT SIRHANS' SHOUTING IN THE INTENSIVE CARE WARD WAS SUFFICIENT TO WARRANT THE CHARGE FOR DISTURBING THE PEACE. IT IS REQUESTED THAT THE CITY PROSECUTOR ISSUE A COMPLAINT FOR THE LISTED CHARGES.
