Similarities in handwriting characteristics were found in the writings of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN and a number of the remaining questioned writings, including certain questioned writings on pages 20, 35, 39, 47, 51, and 53 of specimen Q1; pages 123 and 124 of specimen Q3, and the writing on Q4.

The signatures appearing on K15 are too limited to permit adequate comparison of these signatures with the questioned writings.

This is to request Laboratory examination of handwriting appearing on Kennedy campaign literature forwarded to Earl Warren, U. S. Supreme Court and furnished to this Bureau by Secret Service.

## BACKGROUND:

Campaign literature of Senator Robert F. Kennedy was mailed anonymously to U. S. Supreme Court Justice Earl Warren in an envelope bearing postmark May 25, 1968, at San Francisco, California. On this campaign literature appeared inked handwriting saying "Somebody shoot this Catholic Bastard" and "Somebody will blow this Catholic Bastards Head off." This anonymous mailing was obtained by Secret Service and forwarded to the Bureau with the notation that it will not be necessary for the originals to be returned to Secret Service.

## ACTION:

It is requested that the FBI Laboratory conduct appropriate examination on the attached Kennedy campaign literature to attempt to identify the writer and determine if it has any significance in captioned case.
