The envelope, Q25, contains fragments of a watermark which may be a part of the watermark "KRETONE" which appears in paper sold by the SS. Kresge Company. A six cent U.S. postage stamp which came from a roll of stamps was attached to Q25. *delete*

Results of the fingerprint examination of Q25 and Q26 are being furnished separately.

It was found that the handwriting on Q25 and Q26 is not comparable with the known handwriting specimens submitted in the KENSALT case. While an adequate comparison could not be conducted, differences were noted in handwriting characteristics in Q25, Q26, and the known handwriting in the KENSALT case.

The detailed physical characteristics of Q25 and Q26 are being retained for future reference.

Los Angeles will include the results of the FBI Laboratory examination in its investigative report concerning this matter.

The questioned handwriting on Q1 and Q2 was compared with the Anonymous Letter File without effecting an identification with any prior submission. Copies are being added thereto.

No indented writing or watermarks were found in Q1 and Q2.

Specimen Q1 is an airmail envelope containing four "DEUTSCHE BUNDEPOSTE" postage stamps. Two of the stamps are thirty pfennig denomination, one stamp is twenty pfennig denomination and one stamp is ten pfennig denomination. Q1 measures approximately 6.4 by 4.5 inches. The name and address on Q1 were written in black ink with a ball-point pen. Specimen Q2 is a sheet of ruled white, air-weight paper bearing gray printed lines measuring approximately 0.4 inches apart. The message on Q2 was written in blue ink with a ball-point pen.

Q1 and Q2 are being returned separately. These specimens have been photographed.

Although there is no proven scientific basis for accurately determining qualities such as age, education, occupation, regional accent, etc., on the basis of a limited voice sample, the following subjective aural impressions based on the voice quality and language usage of the unidentified caller, are set forth:

The voice of the anonymous caller is that of a mature male, possibly between the ages of 35 to 45. Although the thoughts which he expressed are somewhat disorganized and vaguely stated, it is believed that the caller is intelligent and well read but probably has little if any formal education.

The accent of his initial comment seems to be somewhat affected "hillbilly;" but, thereafter, his accent can be broadly characterized as Southwestern United States. His speech patterns are idiomatic and do not appear to be contaminated by foreign influence.

It is noted that the anonymous caller, with the exception of his initial comment, pronounces his words fully without swallowing syllables or clipping word endings, particularly final (r).



Remarks:

The analysis and comparison of voices for speaker identification is conducted to provide investigative guidance.

Due to intermittent background sounds and a poor signal to noise ratio, the utterances recorded on K21 were not suitable for voice comparison purposes. A comparison of the utterances of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, designated as K20, with the voice of the anonymous caller to Radio Station KNEW, Oakland, California, designated as Q27, has been made. The K20 utterances differ in significant characteristics from the anonymous voice on Q27. It is not likely that they could be the same speaker.
