Dear Sir:-

The attached article - printed and on the newstand before Senator Kennedy's murder - gives clear evidence that the oil rich Arabs are employing their millions to endanger the lives and property of all of us - by using their wealth to incite the Negro.

I am sending this to you as it is the function of government to protect all of us, and only by specific and forceful action by all, can this obligation be met.

The Arabs are not only not satisfied that 6,000,000 Jews were killed by the Nazis - they are not only not satisfied that they have for 20 years been killing farmers and other residents in Israel - but confident that we here will take no concrete action of importance - they have even incited their nationals in the United States to murder those non-Jews - such as Senator Kennedy - who have opinions about Israel - about its right to exist - that the Arabs do not share.

In addition their doing so creates division, destruction and havoc here and abroad which is a great help to our enemies - whose aim is to destroy us - the Communists.

With you, we wonder who will be next after President Kennedy who was killed by someone who lived in Russia for years - after Martin Luther King Jr was killed by someone who had been in Mexico and possibly Cuba - who will be killed after Senator Kennedy, who was killed by an Arab?

Will it be Senator Edward Kennedy - or Senator McCarthy - our President or Vice-President - or will it be the Governor of California - who so eloquently quoted the Talmud the other night on the Joey Bishop show?

Who will be the next victim - anyone who resists Communist terrorization - who will be safe - who will be able to speak freely - if we continue to allow our laws to be violated, and our country to be subverted?

Punishment is prescribed by law not only for the murderer, not only for those who incite to riot, not only for those who try to destroy our government - but if it is found that some foreign government is attempting to murder yet more American leaders - to destroy yet more property - to incite race against race - class against class - religion against religion in this country - with a view of starting a civil war here too, and destroying our freedom and liberties - then that country should be brought to the World Court, and we should sever our relationship with them - and withdraw recognition from that country

Growing Wave of Anti-Semitism Shows Arab Financial Backing

NEWARK — A serious rise in anti-Semitism in parts of the Newark Black community is believed to stem from Arab instigation and funds. The racism, which has manifested itself in crude, blatantly anti-Jewish leaflets distributed in predominantly Negro schools was revealed to the JEWISH PRESS by the Jewish Defense League (Corps), a newly organized group which infiltrates and exposes racist and anti-Semitic groups.

The leaflets were first distributed on March 22, 1968 at South Side High School in Newark. They read as follows:

"Take Notice

This Black Man You Call 'Nigger' is Hamitic Arab and the Arab world will protect its kin!

No More Abuse!

If Black men are further abused in this America (sic) the Arab American will declare an all out war (jihad) against the Zionist Jew in this America!

Call our bluff!"

The leaflet was signed, simply, "The Arabs."

Jewish Defense League (Corps) officials believe that the leaflet is the work of a group of young Negro students who have been organized by Black Power racists. The latter in turn are being funded by various Arab sources.

Yet another manifestation of anti-Semitism with a probable Arab-financial source has been revealed by the League. It has released testimony by Captain Charles Kinney of the Newark Police Department concerning possible instigators of

last year's disastrous Newark riots.

Captain Kinney revealed that in the spring of 1967, one Colonel Hassan Jeru Ahmed appeared in Newark with some of his followers. Hassan, really Albert Roy Osborne, has a lengthy criminal record and has served time in prisons in the District of Columbia, Virginia and Pennsylvania. He heads the "Black Man's Volunteer Army of Liberation located at 910 Kennedy Street NW in Washington, D. C.

Hassan, according to Kinney "is extremely anti-Semitic and refers constantly to the International Jewish-Communist conspiracy."

Though constantly short of funds, Kinney revealed that Hassan showed up in Newark and was able to move into headquarters at 107 South Orange Avenue in Newark where he proceeded to try to block the building of the proposed New Jersey College of Medicine and Dentistry. According to the police official "it was not known or it is not known who sponsored Hassan's entry onto the Newark scene but it is known he was out of funds prior to his arrival."

The Jewish Defense League revealed to the JEWISH PRESS an "Open Letter to Americans" written by Hassan. It reads like something from Julius Streicher.

"America's deadly enemy," writes Hassan, "the people that are using blackmen and blackwomen to support themselves is, **The International Jewish Conspiracy . . .** Black Americans have lived for years as a blind pawn in the fantastic and deadly game that this conspiracy of Jews is playing to control America . . ."

On May 22, 1967 Hassan and several followers appeared at a meeting of the Newark Central Planning Board called to discuss the proposed college.

Following an emotional speech in which he said, "we are going all the way to stop the school," Hassan kept calling the chairman a "Tom" and a "House Nigger." After a witness testified in opposition to Hassan's views he lunged at the court stenotypist, tore the transcript from the machine and overturned the speaker's lectern. He was ejected but not arrested.

Hassan remained in Newark during the riots and returned to Washington in August of 1967.

On 6/5/68, DOMINICK FUENTES, Manager, Placement Centre Agency, 1061 East Tremont Avenue, Bronx, N.Y., telephonically contacted the New York Office and advised that he had seen a photograph in the "New York Daily News" of the individual being held by the Los Angeles, California Police Department in connection with the shooting of Senator KENNEDY and he believed this individual was possibly identical with one LUIS GEHEVA HERNANDEZ who had appeared at his agency on 3/25/68 with a JOSE LOPEZ seeking employment.

FUENTES was subsequently interviewed by Buagents on 6/5/68 in an effort to identify the then unidentified assailant. FUENTES said he was 90% sure the assailant and HERNANDEZ were identical. He said that HERNANDEZ who spoke no English and who spoke poor Spanish appeared at his agency with LOPEZ who spoke fluent Spanish. They sought any type of work available. HERNANDEZ initially

said that he was from Puerto Rico but after FUENTES, who is Puerto Rican, told him he did not believe he was from Puerto Rico because of his poor Spanish - HERNANDEZ then said that he was from South America. FUENTES asked him for his visa or other papers but HERNANDEZ stated all his papers were in his luggage which he did not have with him.

While at the agency LOPEZ and HERNANDEZ inquired about a place to stay and LOPEZ stated that he had a friend at 845 Hoe Avenue, Bronx, New York, who would probably get them a room at that address.

LOPEZ filled out a job application card for both HERNANDEZ and himself. On HERNANDEZ' card, he showed the age of HERNANDEZ as 28 years, address as 845 Hoe Avenue and the social security number as [REDACTED]. On his own card, LOPEZ showed his age as 22 years, his address as 845 Hoe Avenue, and his social security number as [REDACTED].

HERNANDEZ and LOPEZ then left the agency and never recontacted FUENTES.

Los Angeles will also note that these investigative reports contain background information concerning members of this family. An apparent discrepancy is noted in that the mother's file states she has four children, all accompanying her whereas the file of BISHARA SIRHAN states that he had six children, none of whom would accompany him. It is believed that this is explained by the difference in dates of these respective reports.

On 6/6/68 SHAFIK KRADSHEH, an instructor in the Arabic Dept. at Defense Language Institute, West Coast Branch, at Monterey, Calif., furnished the following information to SA RICHARD J. ROMANSKI, one of his students at DLI:

KRADSHEH has been an instructor at the language school since 11/62. He was born at Nadaba, Jordan, on 9/10/29. He came to the U. S. in October, 1953, and after living in Pasadena and Los Angeles, Calif., from 1953 to 1962, he came to teach at the Monterey language school. KRADSHEH received his U. S. citizenship on 1/4/63. On 12/21/64 he submitted an application to the Bureau for the position of translator. Further background information on KRADSHEH, including residence addresses, are furnished in this application which is on file at the Bureau.

KRADSHEH advised that while he was attending Pasadena City College in 1957, he was introduced to SHARIF SIRHAN at Pasadena. He advised that SIRHAN was a recent immigrant from Jordan who had arrived in the U. S. with an older brother, SAADALLAH SIRHAN. KRADSHEH does not recall whether he ever met SAADALLAH SIRHAN. KRADSHEH stated that he had no knowledge of any member of the SIRHAN family from Jordan, but only came in contact with them for the first time in Pasadena in 1957. He said he was an occasional acquaintance of SHARIF SIRHAN and never developed any close friendship with him.

He stated that SHARIF SIRHAN, in his opinion, did not express any extremist views on the Arab-Israeli question or the relationship of the U. S. foreign policy to this question, but always appeared to take a moderate position on the matter, inasfar as KRADSHEH is able to recall. KRADSHEH has no knowledge of any organization to which SHARIF SIRHAN might have belonged during the period of their acquaintance. KRADSHEH stated that to his knowledge SIRHAN had no connection with any Palestinian nationalist organization back in Jordan. KRADSHEH does not recall ever having met SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

In 1963 KRADSHEH, who at that time was living in Monterey, Calif., travelled to Pasadena with his uncle, MAJED QUOSSOUS, who was visiting from Jordan. MAJED QUOSSOUS knew the SIRHAN family from Jordan. KRADSHEH stated that his uncle knew the family much better than he, himself, did. They traveled to the residence of the SIRHANS in Pasadena and visited with Mrs. SIRHAN briefly. At that time none of the other members of the family were at home. KRADSHEH's uncle, MAJED QUOSSOUS, returned to Jordan shortly thereafter and is presently residing there. The last time KRADSHEH saw SHARIF SIRHAN was around 1958. Other than the brief visit in 1963, KRADSHEH has had no other contact with the family.

NOTE:

Los Angeles Office received information which set forth relationship between Sirhan, the killer of Senator Kennedy, and Walter S. Crowe, a current member of the Communist Party at Los Angeles. Crowe told an informant that he had talked with Sirhan two weeks ago and attempted to recruit him into the CP but that Sirhan had not engaged in any CP or subversive activity. Crowe on interview on 6/6/68 admitted knowing Sirhan since the 6th grade and in seeing him in March, 1968. He claimed that Sirhan never made threats against anyone although he was pro-Arab. He was not questioned concerning his CP and subversive activity. Los Angeles being instructed to reinterview him particularly as to the allegation he attempted to recruit Sirhan into the CP. Memo C.D. Brennan to W.C. Sullivan 6/7/68 captioned "Kensalt" sets out the above information and the fact that this teletype is being sent.
