Dear Sir,

I have a theory on Robert Kennedy's shooting that I would like you to know about. I grew up in Kansas City; I was only vaguely aware of Mafia activities until I roomed with an Italian girl from Kansas City while we were in college. She was at that time dating an Italian boy who was definitely a member of the Mafia. (To my knowledge, she no longer dates him; she was even somewhat afraid to tell him she no longer cared to see him.)

However, one night my roommate and I were intimately talking, and the subject of current events came up. As you know, murderers names are very well-known by all of the Mafia, but never spoken to anyone outside of the Mafia. She said this boy knew the name of Sam Palma's killer, as did many Mafia members. (He didn't tell her so she could truthfully say she didn't know. Also, she didn't want to know.) In addition, my roommate mentioned that it was Mafia knowledge that they had arranged John F. Kennedy's death through Lee Harvey Oswald.

According to my roommate, J.F.K. had made some rather large promises to labor, and had failed to keep them. Also, Robert Kennedy had been too powerful an adversary for organized crime to feel comfortable with. So, the Mafia decided to take action against Robert Kennedy by killing someone very close to him ---- John F. Kennedy. This, they felt, would serve as a warning to Robert Kennedy not to meddle further with organized crime. REC- 59 1/2 - 5 X7

Upon hearing about Robert Kennedy's attempted assassination, it suddenly occured to me that perhaps organized crime had begun to fear Kennedy's ascention to power. They waited until after the crutial California primary to see if Kennedy would be a formidable contender for the Presidency. Another idea that suddenly came to mind was the similar "dead end" backgrounds of Lee Harvey Oswald and the would-be assassin of Robert Kennedy. My roommate had said Oswald had been picked because his background misleadingly pointed to Communism. Surhan's, or whatever his actual name is, background could be misleadingly pointing to the Middle East. It would be convenient for the Mafia to choose a killer who had no criminal recerd, and therefore no fingerprints on file with the F.B.I.

This theory could be perfectly worthless; on the other hand, if it has shed any light upon this string of senseless assassinations, I am glad to have helped my country in a small way in this time of turmoil.



On June 9, 1968, Jerry DeLaVega, 1863 - 9th Avenue, San Francisco, telephone 566-3814, appeared at the office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, San Francisco with Robert Richardson, 1144 Cervantes Street, Pacifica, California. DeLaVega is a Yellow Cab driver and made available a bronze-colored disc with a short wire attached which gave the impression of being some sort of fusing device for military ordnance, exact nature of which is unknown. This device had been discovered by DeLaVega on the floor of his cab immediately after he had left his fare at the San Francisco International Airport.

DeLaVega related the following circumstances:

He was driving his cab on Saturday, June 1, 1968, the day of the Robert F. Kennedy and Eugene McCarthy Debate on television. He was parked in front of the Hilton Hotel, San Francisco, at approximately 4:30 p.m., when a man giving him the impression of a businessman entered his cab. The man asked DeLaVega where he could locate a couple of girls who would like to help him out by "putting Kennedy on". DeLaVega understood this to mean that the man was going to play a joke on Kennedy. The man said he wanted the girls to present some flowers to Kennedy.

DeLaVega drove the man to the vicinity of the University of San Francisco looking for a couple of girls and found none. DeLaVega suggested they might find someone in the Haight-Ashbury District of San Francisco. DeLaVega said the man seemed to be a complete stranger to San Francisco. He drove the fare to Stanyan and Haight Streets and picked up a white female juvenile, about 17 to 20 years old, medium build, long dark hair, wearing casual sports clothes. The girl agreed to present the flowers to Kennedy. They drove about a block more and located a white male juvenile, about the same age, with a large German Shepherd dog. The male is described as 5 feet 8 inches tall, 125 to 130 pounds, wearing dark brown clothes. The male agreed to accompany them in presentation of the flowers. Both the girl and male were complete strangers to his fare.

After picking up the two individuals at his fare's request, they drove back to the Hilton Hotel to pick up the flowers. The man went into the hotel and after waiting some time returned to the cab with two green boxes of long stem yellow roses. He sat in the front seat with the driver while the other two were in the back with the dog. The man instructed that they drive to KGO television station where Senators Kennedy and McCarthy were to appear.

DeLaVega observed the man remove the flowers from the boxes and from a brown leather attache case he removed several of the same type of bronze-colored discs, possibly 10 or 12 all wired together with what appeared to be florist wire and wired this group of discs to the yellow roses. He repeated this with the other roses and another group of the discs. The metal discs had apparently been prepared ahead of time and each was wired with wire wrapped around the center of each disc, this being separate from the fine wire soldered to each disc. The man stated that these devices were "bugging devices" and indicated he was not sure but believed the fine wire was going to a telephone some way and the disc fit into the telephone.

The man gave each bunch of the roses to the girl and boy and instructed them to go to each entrance and give them to Kennedy. This was done so that if Kennedy missed one the other would be able to give him the flowers.

DeLaVega said he drove to the television station, parked his cab on Polk Street and all three individuals left the cab and disappeared into the crowd about the time Senators Kennedy and McCarthy arrived. They were gone about 10 to 15 minutes. All three returned to the cab and the girl said she had personally given Kennedy her bunch of the roses. Disposition of the other bunch of the roses is unknown to DeLaVega. The girl said to the man that the discs were apparent to persons in the crowd and several of the people in the crowd seeing the bouquet said "Hey, it's bugged".

DeLaVega said the man seemed pleased that Kennedy had gotten the roses and he observed him pay each of the other two passengers five dollars plus some one dollar bills.

Some time during the cab ride the man had mentioned that McCarthy had gotten a similar bouquet in Los Angeles and he had come up here especially to present the flowers to Kennedy in San Francisco.

After the flowers had been given, the man asked DeLaVega to take him to the San Francisco International Airport after he dropped off the other two. They drove back to the Haight-Ashbury District and the male with his dog got out. The female asked if he could drop her off at home in San Bruno inasmuch as they were going to the airport.

DeLaVega said he took her home and believed he might possibly be able to locate the house again saying that it was in a group of tract homes. He is not sure and he did not record the address any place. He then drove the man to the San Francisco International Airport and believes he delivered him to the United Air Lines area. Cab fare was about \$18, and the man gave him \$35 and told him to keep the change. He described the unknown male fare as a white male American, about 50 years old, 5 feet 8 inches to 5 feet 9 inches tall, weighing 200 pounds, athletic build,

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The attache case he carried was of cowhide color and was a square-cornered case with a handle at the top and dividers and carried various papers as well as the metal discs.

On June 10, 1968, Major Edward Hardy, Sixth Amry Headquarters, Ordnance Section, Explosive Disposal Program, Presidio of San Francisco, examined the metal disc and could not identify it as an explosive device or component of any explosive device. He examined the contents of the device and noted that the black powder contained therein was not an explosive material.

On that same date the disc was examined by Archie B. Savage, Special Agent, Army Intelligence, Presidio of San Francisco and he could not identify it as any type of recording device with which he was familiar and did not, in fact, believe it to be a recording device.

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On June 10, 1968, at 9:00 AM, the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) reported that one Arlington Robert Scott, 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa., telephonically contacted CIA Headquarters at 4:00 AM on June 8, 1968, and requested assistance and equipment from the CIA in that he needed help to go to California to see Senator Robert F. Kennedy's assailant was properly punished. Scott alleged he could not be certain that the assailant would not get off and since Senator Kennedy was the only friend of the Negro, he wanted to make sure Sirhan Sirhan would receive proper punishment. Scott was advised by the CIA to stay in Pittsburgh and to contact the local office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation if he had any information to offer.

On June 12, 1968, Arlington Robert Scott, 2919 Bedford Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa., telephone 683-8063, advised that early in the morning on Saturday, June 8, 1968, he telephonically contacted the CIA in Washington, D. C., and spoke to a man whose name he cannot recall. Scott said he called because he was angry over the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy and is concerned the assailant, Sirhan Sirhan, will not receive the punishment he deserves since he is not a citizen of the United States., He feels diplomatic pressure will be applied by Jordan which will result in Sirhan receiving a lighter sentence than he deserves. Scott said Sirhan killed Kennedy and, therefore, he should die also. said Sirhan will be killed by a "suicide squad" prior to going to trial, but would not elaborate on who will make up the "squad."

Scott was evasive when questioned if he personally plans to attempt any action against Sirhan, but admitted requesting assistance and equipment from the CIA in order that he could travel to California. Scott stated he will not incriminate himself by saying he plans to take some type of action against Sirhan nor would he say he is not going to attempt such an action.

Scott said he is practicing with a high-powered rifle equipped with a telescopic sight, which belongs to his Chinese girl friend, whose name he refused to give. Scott also stated that the feeling he has about Sirhan also applies to James Earl Ray, the accused assassin of Martin Luther King, Jr. Scott expressed hostility toward George Wallace, former governor of Alabama, and Pittsburgh Mayor Joseph Barr, but would not specifically state what he feels should be done about these individuals. However, Scott implied that both Wallace and Barr should be handled Scott described in the same fashion as Sirhan and Ray. himself as a "fanatic" and said he was treated at the State Mental Hospital in Petersburg, Va., from December 2, 1952, through April 13, 1953, for mental instability. He also stated he was treated at the Veterans Administration Hospitals in Roanoke, Va., during the late 1940's and early 1950's and in Pittsburgh, Pa., in 1967 for mental instability, and at St. Francis Hospital, Pittsburgh, Pa., in 1967 for the same reason. Scott said he served in the United States Army in 1946 through 1947 under Army serial number 123070733 and was given a medical discharge for being mentally unstable. Scott further stated he has had several operations in the past including one for ulcers and said he currently has scars on his lungs, which will prevent any future operations. Scott said he has little to live for and would willingly give up his own life in order to help his race.

ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA JUNE 5, 1968

The Visa Section, American Embassy, Rome, Italy, advised on June 11, 1968, that GIUSEPPE PIRAINO, an Italian citizen born February 4, 1930, at Vicari, Palermo, Sicily, applied for a visitor's visa to the United States. PIRAINO was in possession of Italian passport No. 3991591 issued April 15, 1965, by the Italian Consulate, Basle, Switzerland. He furnished his address as Via Vittorio Veneto 6, Busso, Campobasso, Italy.

PIRAINO indicated the purpose of his visit to the United States was to contact the family of the late ROBERT F. KENNEDY and furnish them with information regarding SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, whom newspapers have identified as Senator KENNEDY's assailant. PIRAINO indicated in his application that the KENNEDY family would pay for his travel to the United States although he admitted he did not have authority from the KENNEDY family. He displayed a letter dated May 19, 1968, written by PHILLIP M. WRONKA, the late Senator KENNEDY's staff assistant, which acknowledged PIRAINO's telephone call early in May, 1968. WRONKA's letter informed PIRAINO that he could not clearly understand him over the telephone and suggested PIRAINO write another letter to him directly rather than to Senator KENNEDY.

The Visa Section did not issue a visa to PIRAINO.

PIRAINO was interviewed at the American Embassy, Rome, Italy, on June 11, 1968, and furnished the following information:

In approximately July, 1965, PIRAINO traveled to Copenhagen, Denmark, for the purpose of finding employment. After about one week of searching, he foundhimself in the vicinity of the central railroad station in Copenhagen and there encountered a dark, swarthy man about 1.65 to 1.67 meters in height. This individual had black, curly hair, black eyes and a deep olive complexion. PIRAINO said he is convinced after seeing photographs

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of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN in the newspapers that SIRHAN and the man he met in Copenhagen are one and the same person. PIRAINO does not recall the man's name but was told by him that he came from Naples, Italy, and PIRAINO noted that he spoke with a Neopolitan accent. According to PIRAINO, he never heard the individual speak English nor did this person ever mention that he had been in the United States. PIRAINO noted that the man was traveling with an Italian passport but declared that false passports were very easily obtained.

PIRAINO said he became quite friendly with this individual who displayed to PIRAINO a cut he had received across the abdomen in a fight over a girl in Germany. PIRAINO said the cut, which was on the right side of this man's abdomen, was still giving him pain. Several days later, PIRAINO and the individual proceeded to Stockholm, Sweden, where they remained for about three days. The last time PIRAINO saw this individual was in Stockholm when he was visited by a young Italian male who was accompanied by a young girl with blond hair. The three left Stockholm in the latter part of July, 1965, and he has not seen or heard from them again.

PIRAINO believes the young blond girl is the same person whom newspapers have reported is wanted for questioning by the Los Angeles Police Department. He said he is unable to furnish any other identifying data concerning the dark, swarthy male he met in Copenhagen or the blond girl.

Throughout the interview with PIRAINO, he often expressed his admiration for the United States of America and how he longed to reside in the United States. He said that ever since President JOHN F. KENNEDY was assassinated in 1963, he has been obsessed with a feeling of impending tragedy for other members of the KENNEDY family. He said he has sent at least eight letters to Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY prior to his assassination disclosing his desire to enter the United States. Although he could furnish no facts to substantiate his feeling, he said he felt certain something was going to happen to Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY prior to his assassination on June 5, 1968.
