Elements of persecuti

Applicant fled from the New City of Jerusalem for fear of persecution by the Jews because of race and religion. He cannot return to his home in Israel even if he wanted to and can claim no compensation for what he has lost there.

Although he is not likely to be persecuted in Jordan yet he may not be able to resettle in Jordan and will be dependent of UNRWA's assistance for many years to come.

Effect on welfare of U.S. if applicant admitted:

Mr. Sirhan is a well educated, ambitious young man who can speak enough English to make himself understood. Although he has no proper skill yet he should be able to find some employment in an Office or a Factory with which he could earn his living and become self-supporting.

His parents, brothers and sisters immigrated to USA in 1956 under the Refugee Relief Act of 1953 and are eager to have him join them.

We strongly recommend that this young man be given the chance to join his parents under the present Public Law as otherwise he will have to wait for many, many years before his turn on the Israeli quota is reached.

A CWS assurance was provided for him under RRA 1953 but this was received too late to allow the US Consul process the case under that Act.



She said she read mail and has in the past furnished some mail to FBI Agents in Washington, D. C. She said about Christmas of 1967, she came on a card, in her personal papers, which makes no sense, but has caused her some concern. She said since the captioned event, she thought she should furnish it to the FBI. It is enclosed for evaluation. She believed it might have some significance. However, this is not apparent.

Mrs. Marge Rodak told our Phoenix Office that on Wednesday following Senator Kennedy assassination, her daughter Sherrie Lynn and present wife of Djeredjiam were watching T. V. and saw photographs of subject Sirhan Bishara Sirhan. Djeredjiam was alleged to have said, "know that man" further stated "didn't I tell you (Mrs. Djeredjiam) two days ago that Kennedy was going to be shot and Humphrey would probably be shot next and Ted Kennedy shot if he runs for office." Mrs. Rodak indicated when she queried Djeredjiam regarding his statements, he refused to discuss them. It is noted Mrs. Rodak dislikes her son-in-law intensely, however, Djeredjiam's wife when interviewed, denied her husband made such statements as related by her mother. Further, it was Mrs. Rodak who speculated two days before the assault on Kennedy he would be shot and it was Mrs. Rodak voicing her opinion. Offices receiving this communication are thoroughly checking out Djeredjiam concerning the statements made so that his exact location during the pertinent period will be known. Dallas requested background in Bureau files since Dallas' old applicant file has since been destroyed.
