FOR INFORMATION OF SACRAMENTO, FLOYD ARMSTEAD, INSTRUCTOR, OLYMPIC COLLEGE. BREMERTON. WASHINGTON. ADVISED THAT ON THE MORNING OF JUNE AST, WHILE HE AND STUDENTS OF OLYMPIC COLLEGE WERE IN A DISCUSSION WITH NOSAYAN, A STUDENT AT OLYMPIC COLLEGE, NOSAYAN RELATED THAT THE ASSASSIN OF KENNEDY WAS "JUSTIFIED IN DOING WHAT HE DID." NOSAYAN REPRESENTED THAT HE WAS PERSONALLY ACQUAINTED WITH SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN. HAVING MET HIM IN SAN FRANCISCO. NOSAYAN ADVISED "YOU MUST REMEMBER THAT THIS TOOK PLACE ONE YEAR FROM JUNE FIFTH." AFTER ARMSTEAD RELATED TO NOSAYAN "YOU ARABS WILL NOT GET ANYWHERE BY BLOODSHED", NOSAYAN REPLIED "WE'LL BE BACK AGAIN," APPARENTLY REFERRING TO THE ARAB-ISRAEL DISPUTE.

ARMSTEAD ADVISED THAT IN PREVIOUS DISCUSSION NOSAYAN HAD INDICATED THAT HE DOES NOT HATE THE JEWS AS INDIVISUALS BUT IS AGAINST THE AGGRESSION OF ISRAEL AND THAT HE HOLDS IT AGAINST THE U.S. AND BRITAIN FOR HELPING ISRAEL.

ACCORDING TO NOSAYAN'S REMARKS TO ARMSTEAD, NOSAYAN HAS SAID THAT NASSAR IS "A GREAT MAN" AND "WE DON'T UNDERSTAND HIM."

NOSAYAN IS FROM TAIR, SAUDI-ARABIA, CURRENTLY EN ROUTE VIA PORTLAND, OREGON, TO STOCKTON, CALIFORNIA, TO ENROLL IN SUMMER SESSIONS AT THE PACIFIC UNIVERSITY. DATE OF ARRIVAL IN STOCKTON UNKNOWN.



Subject's family believes names such as SOL SONJUANINO, FIONA, PRINCE KHIADE and MAWLEDENOOR refer to race horse names.

The name GHATTAS is a SIRHAN family name which is not presently used by any member of the family.

Concerning the Arabic writing in subjects notebook, members of the family believe practically all of it is nothing more than idle doodling or practice of writing in the Arabic script having stated that little of it makes sense.

Brothers of the subject, SAIDALLAH and ADEL SIRHAN have positively identified handwriting in English, Russian and Arabic in the notebooks as that of the subject, SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN.

Most of the pamphlets found in the subjects room where identified by family members as "throw away type" such as is delivered house to house or address "to occupant" and believe none of it was received by subject through subscription. They stated that most of the material he received through the mail regarded the Rosecrucians.

On 6/14/68, Mrs. SIRHAN advised that during the latter part of 1966 while her son, the subject, was living in Norco, California and working on a horse breeding ranch, he did write her a letter in which he enclosed \$10 and asked her to take care of his mail. She stated, however, that before she could forward anything to him, he returned home the next day and picked up one piece of mail which she recalls was a pamphlet from the Rosecrucians. She stated that in this letter he did give her his address in Norco; however, she has since turned that card over to the police department and she does not remember the address of her own recollection.

ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY

At 1:30 p.m. today, Mrs. Mildred Stegall called from the White House.

Mrs. Stegall stated the President had noted United Press International (UPI) dispatch No. 84, which came across on the ticker at 12:48 p.m. today. This dispatch reads as follows:

"London - An Arab Government has passed "new and startling" information to American officials on Sirhan Sirhan, the Evening Standard reported today.

Standard Correspondent Jon Kimche, who claims close contact with Arab Governments, said the information is the result of an intensive investigation in Sirhan's background by an Arab Government, which he did not identify.

Kimche said the investigation disclosed Sirhan returned to the Middle East in 1964 for seven months four of which he spent in Damascus. He returned again in 1966 spending five months in Cairo and returned to the U.S. at the beginning of 1967."

Mrs. Stegall said the President wanted to know whether there was anything to this at all. The President indicated to her that he understood that if such data had been received it would probably have been received through State Department channels but he wanted us to check.

A check with the General Investigative Division disclosed we have received no information in this regard and the trips alleged in the news dispatch do not jibe with data thus far disclosed regarding Sirhan.

He comments concerning the general Arab mental intelligence and believes that this should not be overlooked in our investigation of the murder of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. He believes the subject should be interrogated concerning his possible affiliation with al Fatah. "Mr." used per Reading Room.

Bureau files contain no record identifiable with the correspondents; however, there are several references to al Fatah which is an Arabic terrorist organization. The Honorable J. Magar Hoover, Chief of Federal Bureau of Investigation, Washington, D.C.

Dear Sir,

I have just recently returned from Israel where I spent some time researching a book which I am writing now concerning the Six Day War of last year. Because of the tragic event that occured in Los Angeles today, I feel that I must write and hope that I can add something to the investigation in the attempted assasination of Robert F. Kennedy.

While the 'biggies' of our TV news media. Huntley. Brinkley. Cronkite, Sevaried et al, decry the hostile air in America today, and the entire nation in fact cries against the deranged mind that pulled the trigger. I would like to suggest that perhaps the mind is not so deranged. I would like to suggest that an understanding of the Arab mentality be entered into this investigation. Though it is totally abhorrent to the Western mind, assasination has long been a part of the Arab scene. It does not take too much of a stretch of the imagination to see how the Arab mind can perpetrate such a thing. It is the same mind that can place a land mine in the path of a school bus and kill two and injure 26 students; or the mentality that fires the cannon that kills a farmer while he peacefully works his fields. It is this mentality that can scream for their Jihad, their Holy War to eliminate a nation, when the rest of the world is still reeling from the effects of the genocides of World War II.

In other words, sir, this mentality which is so puzzling to our way of thinking (even the Russians cannot understand the Egyptians) could very well have been the driving force behind this man's actions. What we may consider deranged by our standards could be a perfectly acceptable, indeed even an honorable performance, by Arab standards.

I understand the suspect has been in the U.S. for eleven years and has been associated with Arab student activities. So I may not have anything to offer you. Yet, I would offer only as a suggestion that this man's possible connections with al Fatah or similar terrorist organizations from Jordan or other Arabian nations not be overlooked.

I watched the debate between Kennedy and McCarthy and the statement that Senator Kennedy made concerning our helping Israel,
was by itslef innocuous. But to the Arab mentality it could
easily have started the fuze that set this man off. Nasser of
Egypt could easily arouse his Arabs to a frenzy of blood lust
with a few words. So I am simply saying that one should not 1968
overlook the Arab mentality in trying to analyze this thing.
Please consider this, and also question the suspect about any
possible ties with al Fatah.

Los Angeles has been instructed to expeditiously pin down this and to immediately locate and interview those Cubans alleged to have seen Sirhan.

On June 6, 1968, Mrs. Helen Schodowski, 4483 Webster, Ecorse, Michigan, no telephone, advised she has been employed at the Alpine Motel, 26131 Michigan Avenue, Inkster, Michigan, for two and one-half months. Since her employment there, a Mr. Barovkian (phonetic) has been staying in unit number 25. He has a typewriter in his room and on June 6, 1968, while she was cleaning his room, she observed an unfinished letter in the typewriter addressed to "Queenie". The letter indicated this was the third time he tried to write to her. The letter contained derogatory remarks about Senator Kennedy, referred to him as an SOB., and stated he deserved what he got. The letter contained a question asking if she sent the dumb Arab to do the job.

Mrs. Schodowski then found the following letter in the trash basket, which was torn in four pieces:

Hi;

Hey, what gives out there? How come you have to import some dumb arab to shoot the senator from NY? It figures an arab did it, he screwed it up. I heard the news this moring at 5230. You can bet your butt if I had shot at him or him in body, he'd be dead. It figures, if he hadn't been shot out there, he would have been shot somewhere else. Shame, I have to admit. Now this makes him a hero. Oh by the way, I used to have a beer at that place. Ambassador, wasn't it?

Your letter came Monday, but I was too tired to go and pick it up. Late last night, read it. I must say, Sharon is no longer the little teenager I met out there and in Niagara, but quite the young and attractive young lady. Mari picked out a graduation gift for her, and I bought it. Sent it cut last Saturday past. It may not look like much, but it is solid gold. Hope she likes it.

As for the Florida trip, forget it! A little rider on the prize such as buying property when you get out there.

I'm trying to get John to come here, but who is to take care of him while I'm working? That is the part that bothers me. So far, no apartment. I did put \$300 deposit and rent on a place, but haven't received a call yet.

Weather has finally settled and I'm back to work. Turning balck as coal and sleeping at nights.
