CERTIFIED A CITIZEN ON FOUR ELEVEN SIXTY ONE, DOES NOT SHOW ANY TRAVEL.

HE ADVISED THAT HE HAS BEEN IN U.S. FOR TWENTY YEARS AND RETURNED TO JORDAN FOR ONE MONTH IN MAY OF NINETEEN FIFTY SEVEN WHILE IN U.S. ARMY. HE WAS MARRIED WHILE IN JORDAN. HE HAS ARMY SERIAL NUMBER ONE SIX FOUR SEVEN ZERO TWO ONE NINE.

SALIM SALEM SIRHAN, FATHER OF SIRHAN SALIM SIRHAN ADVISED HE AND HIS WIFE MARY LAST TRAVELED TO JORDAN IN NINETEEN SIXTY TWO THROUGH NINETEEN SIXTY FOUR. HE ADVISED THAT NEITHER HE NOR ANY OF HIS RELATIVES RESIDING IN U.S. HAVE RETURNED TO JORDAN SINCE NINETEEN SIXTY FOUR.

DETROIT TEL TO BUREAU AND LOS ANGELES DATED SIX SEVEN SIXTY EIGHT ADVISED THAT SALIM SALEM SIRHAN SAW SUBJECT'S FATHER BISHARA SALAMEH KHATTAS IN JAYPEH JORDAN DURING HIS VISIT. SALIM SIRHAN AND KHATTAS ARE FROM SAME VILLAGE AND SIRHAN HAS NEVER KNOWN KHATTAS TO CESE THE NAME SIRHAN. SALIM SIRHAN DOES NOT KNOW KHATTAS FAMILY OR THEIR WHEREABOUTS AND DOES NOT KNOW SUBJECT.

The above cards were provided by Mrs. JEAN O. MORE, Records Clerk, John Muir High School, 1905 North Lincoln, Pasadena, California, to SA RICHARD H. ROSS. Mrs. MORE stated the cards contained the handwriting and handprinting of SIRHAN SIRHAN. She said that according to registration practices at the high school during the 1961 and 1962 school year, students were required to write the name of their parent or guardian and the date the form was executed. The student received the card in the early morning and was required to return the card at the end of the same school day; therefore, she is of the opinion that the writing is that of SIRHAN SIRHAN, even though the signature is in the name of Mrs. MARY SIRHAN.

The Lab is requested to conduct appropriate handwriting and handprinting analysis, utilizing the enclosed cards. These cards are to be returned to Los Angeles upon completion of examination.

BACKGROUND:

Campaign literature of Senator Robert F. Kennedy was mailed anonymously to U. S. Supreme Court Justice Earl Warren in an envelope bearing postmark May 25, 1968, at San Francisco, California. On this campaign literature appeared inked handwriting saying "Somebody shoot this Catholic Bastard" and "Somebody will blow this Catholic Bastards Head off." This anonymous mailing was obtained by Secret Service and forwarded to the Bureau with the notation that it will not be necessary for the originals to be returned to Secret Service.

ACTION:

It is requested that the FBI Laboratory conduct appropriate examination on the attached Kennedy campaign literature to attempt to identify the writer and determine if it has any significance in captioned case.

In answer to your request for information concerning Subject, we would like to submit the following information contained in our files.

a. Subject is a Swiss national, born in St. Gallen, Switzerland, 27 June 1909, of Russian Jewish parents who had emigrated to that country from the Soviet Union in 1922.

b. Subject is at the present time an able, unscrupulous free lance journalist in London, whose articles appear more often than not in the London Evening Standard. His career started prior to World War II, and he is well known and has a wide range of political and other contacts who support him in his work.

c. Early in his career he ran a Socialist book shop from 1930 to 1941. He has maintained the left wing associations formed at that time ever since.

d. From 1941 to 1945 he worked for the London Evening Standard as a military correspondent. During the war years some of his articles attracted attention because their prophetic accuracy indicated that he might have sources of information in high places.

e. Subsequently he became Reuters correspondent in Palestine in 1945. It was then that he started writing books along with his brother David which were aimed primarily at lauding Israeli intelligence and military accomplishments.

f. Since that time his brother David has been a career Israeli intelligence officer now specializing in the political action field.

g. Subject himself has had close ties with the IIS ever since World War II, an association probably continuing at the present time.

h. In 1952 Subject became editor of the Jewish Observer and Middle East Review published in England. This publication was overtly supported by its major shareholder, the Zionist Federation of Great Britain and Ireland. However, a large if not major portion of the financial support was provided directly by a covert subsidy from the Israeli Government. Even after Ben Gurion was no longer Prime Minister, this support continued from the Israeli Ben Gurion political faction of Deputy Minister of Defense Shimon Peres. Subject's periodical contained enough information undermining Prime Minister Eshkol that this continued support came to light and was obviously the cause for Subject being fired from the paper in March 1967.

i. There should, however, be no question but that he still supports official Israeli Zionist lines in his work. For example, early in 1968 there were strong protests from American Government circles in London against his articles which appeared to be aimed at destroying relations between the United States and Arab countries. We should not rule out the possibility that the recent articles of 6 and 13 June concerning Sirhan are serving the same purpose. We will note only the last line of the 6 June article: "A finger on the trigger was in Beverly Hills, but the inspiration undoubtedly came from outside the Ambassador Hotel." This line follows a long description of Arab propaganda as seen through Israeli eyes.

j. Subject has probably had close ties at various times in his career with British Intelligence.

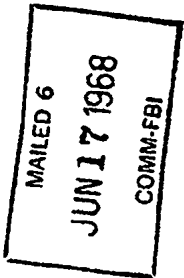
