His career started prior to World War II, and he is well known and has a wide range of political and other contacts who support him in his work.

c. Early in his career he ran a Socialist book shop from 1930 to 1941. He has maintained the left wing associations formed at that time ever since.

d. From 1941 to 1945 he worked for the London Evening Standard as a military correspondent. During the war years some of his articles attracted attention because their prophetic accuracy indicated that he might have sources of information in high places.

e. Subsequently he became Reuters correspondent in Palestine in 1945. It was then that he started writing books along will will brother David which were aimed primarily at lauding Israeli intelligence and military accomplishments.

f. Since that time his brother David has been a career Israeli intelligence officer now specializing in the political action field.

- g. Subject himself has had close ties with the IIS ever since World War II, an association probably continuing at the present time.
- h. In 1952 Subject became editor of the Jewish Observor and Middle East Review published in England. This publication was overtly supported by its major shareholder, the Zionist Federation of Great Britain and Ireland. However, a large if not major portion of the financial support was provided directly by a covert subsidy from the Israeli Government. Even after Ben Gurion was no longer Prime Minister, this support continued from the Israeli Ben Gurion political faction of Deputy Minister of Defense Shimon Peres. Subject's periodical contained enough information undermining Prime Minister Eshkol that this continued support came to light and was obviously the cause for Subject being fired from the paper in March 1967.
- i. There should, however, be no question but that he still supports official Israeli Zionist lines in his work. For example, early in 1968 there were strong protests from American Government circles in London against his articles which appeared to be aimed at destroying relations between the United States and Arab countries. We should not rule out the possibility that the recent articles of 6 and 13 June concerning Sirhan are serving the same purpose. We will note only the last line of the 6 June article: "A finger on the trigger was in Beverly Hills, but the inspiration undoubtedly came from outside the Ambassador Hotel." This line follows a long description of Arab propaganda as seen through Israeli eyes.
- j. Subject has probably had close ties at various times in his career with British Intelligence.

NINETEEN SIXTY SIX WHILE EMPLOYED AT CORONA, CALIFORNIA, AS EXERCISE BOY. SEVERAL OTHER NAMES APPEARING IN NOTEBOOKS HAVE NOT, AS YET, BEEN IDENTIFIED AND ARE UNKNOWN TO MEMBERS OF SUBJECT'S FAMILY. NOTEBOOK MATERIAL CONTAINS MUCH DOODLING AND AIMLESS WRITING, MEANING OF WHICH CANNOT BE DETERMINED BY FAMILY. SEVERAL UNUSUAL NAMES APPEAR TO BE THOSE OF RACE HORSES. ALL LEADS DEVELOPING FROM EXAMINATION OF NOTEBOOK ARE IMMEDIATELY SET FORTH AS SOON AS DEVELOPED. INVESTIGATION CONTINUING THIS PHASE.

-- ATTENDANCE AT MEETING OF ROSICRUCIANS
ON MAY TWENTY EIGHT LAST--

LEROY CLEMENS, CHAPLAIN OF THE PASADENA CHAPTER OF THE ROSICRUCIAN ORDER, ADVISES MET SIRHAN B. SIRHAN AND HAD BRIEF CONVERSATION WITH HIM AT PASADENA MEETING ON NIGHT, MAY TWENTY EIGHT LAST. DOES NOT RECALL WHO INTRODUCED HIM TO SIRHAN; RECALLS NO ONE ESCORTING SIRHAN; AND UNAWARE AS TO WHY HE ATTENDED MEETING. WAS NOT CERTAIN WHETHER OR NOT SIRHAN WAS MEMBER. CLEMENS STATED HE IMMEDIATELY RECALLED SIRHAN DUE TO HIS UNUSUAL NAME WHEN HE OBSERVED NEWSPAPER AND TELEVISION PUBLICITY CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR KENNEDY. CLARK IDENTIFIED PHOTOGRAPH DISPLAYED TO HIM OF SIRHAN B. SIRHAN.

MRS. VIRGINIA JACKA, CHURCH MUSICIAN FOR THE PASADENA CHAPTER OF ROSICRUCIANS, ADVISED SHE WAS IN ATTENDANCE AT ROSICRUCIAN MEETING, PASADENA, MAY TWENTY EIGHT LAST, AND RECALLED SEEING END PAGE TWO

SIRHAN SIRHAN IN ATTENDANCE AT MEETING. SHE STATED AFTER WATCHING TELEVISION CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION OF KENNEDY AND SEEING PICTURES OF SIRHAN ON TELEVISION, SHE IDENTIFIED HIM AND ALSO IDENTIFIED PHOTOGRAPHS OF SIRHAN SIRHAN SHOWN TO HER BY BUREAU AGENTS.

MRS. GRACE BRYAN, MEMBER OF ROSICRUCIANS, ADVISED ATTENDED REGULAR MEETING NIGHT OF MAY TWENTY EIGHT LAST, AND MET YOUNG MALE VISITOR WHOSE NAME SHE COULD NOT RECALL BUT WHO WAS SIMILAR TO SIRHAN. INDIVIDUAL DID NOT ASSOCIATE WITH ANY PARTICULAR PERSON AT MEETING AND WAS ONLY SEEN BY HER ON THIS ONE OCCASION. PERSON AT MEETING CLOSELY RESEMBLES PHOTOGRAPH OF SIRHAN SIRHAN BUT MRS. BRYAN COULD NOT SAY IF THE TWO PEOPLE ARE IDENTICAL.

-- INTERVIEW OF AMBASSADOR HOTEL EMPLOYEES--

A COMPLETE LIST OF FULL OR PART-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE AMBASSADOR HOTEL WAS OBTAINED AND ALL INDIVIDUALS ON LIST BEING LOCATED AND INTERVIEWED TO DETERMINE IF WITNESS TO SHOOTING OR IF SAW SIRHAN B. SIRHAN AT HOTEL ON NIGHT OF SHOOTING. THIS PHASE OF INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED ON A CONTINUING BASIS UNTIL ALL SUCH EMPLOYEES HAVE BEEN LOCATED AND INTERVIEWED. THIS PHASE NEAR COMPLETION.


