



On June 11, 1968, Mr. Ira Katchen, an attorney who resides at 384 Highland Avenue, Elberon, New Jersey, advised Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that he was staying at the Hotel Esplanarde in Prague, Czechoslovakia, with his son, Julius Katchen, a pianist, on May 14, 1968. His son was playing in a recital in Prague on May 16 and May 18, 1968.

On the morning of May 15, 1968, according to Mr. Katchen, his son met some friends in the Hotel Esplanarde and they heard on the Prague radio that Senator Robert F. Kennedy had been shot in California. Mr. Katchen stated that he had heard that a tape of this broadcast can be obtained from the manager of the Hotel Esplanarde.

Anna Uhlik, 154 Brookside Avenue, Irvington, New Jersey, advised of a similar incident on June 11, 1968. She stated that on May 21, 1968, she received a letter from her sister, Marie Kadlec, Village of Raster, Post Office in Malesov, County of Kutna Hara, Czechoslovakia, advising that sometime prior to May 16, 1968, she had heard over a radio broadcast that Senator Robert F. Kennedy had been shot in the head and was not expected to recover. The letter then stated that on the following day the same radio station retracted the original report concerning Senator Kennedy and advised that an error had been made.

In addition to the above, this Bureau is in receipt from your Department of a telegram dated June 11, 1968, from the American Embassy in Singapore to the Secretary of State which sets forth a similar report from Baghdad, Iraq. This telegram states that on June 8, 1968, Mr. John A. Swede, a United States citizen, advised the Embassy duty officer that on May 17, 1968, he was dining with his wife at the Ambassador Hotel in Baghdad, Iraq. The waiter approached the Swedes and



asked if they had heard that Senator Robert F. Kennedy had been shot. During the conversation the waiter asserted that he had positively heard that Senator Kennedy had been shot in the head but at the time was not dead. He claimed he had heard the report on a special government radio broadcast that day.

It is requested that appropriate officials of the Czech and Iraq Governments be contacted to determine if these radio broadcasts were actually made. If the broadcasts were made, it should be determined, if possible, what were the original sources of this information.

Senator Kennedy was critically wounded on June 5, 1968, and died on June 6, 1968.

Reports received that Prague, Czechoslovakia, radio and Baghdad, Iraq, radio on May 17, 1968, reported that the late Senator, Robert F. Kennedy had been shot. A review of Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) records of foreign broadcasts during this period fails to indicate any such reports were monitored by CIA. Being recommended State Department be requested to contact appropriate officials of Iraq and Czech Governments to determine if any such broadcasts were made and if so the source of the original information. Senator Kennedy was critically wounded on June 5, 1968, in California and died on June 6, 1968.

On 6/11/68 Mr. Ira Katchen, an Elberon, New Jersey, attorney, advised that on May 15, 1968, he was in Prague, Czechoslovakia, with his son who was playing in a recital. Mr. Katchen reports that on May 15 Prague radio announced that Senator Kennedy had been shot in California.

Anna Uhlik of Irvington, New Jersey, has advised that she received a letter on May 21, 1968, from her sister in Czechoslovakia advising that sometime prior to May 16, 1968, she had heard a radio broadcast that Senator Kennedy had been shot in the head and was not expected to recover.

A State Department telegram dated June 11, 1968, sets forth a report that a United States citizen, Mr. John A. Swede, called on the United States Embassy in Singapore and advised that on May 17, 1968, he was at the Ambassador Hotel in Baghdad, Iraq. While eating dinner the waiter inquired if he had heard the report which had come over a special government radio broadcast that day that Senator Kennedy had been shot.

Memorandum to Mr. W. C. Swllivan RE: KENSALT

Bureau liaison requested CIA to check its foreign broadcast monitoring records on 6/12/68 to determine if the alleged Prague or Baghdad radio reports had been picked up. On 6/13/68 CIA advised that it had reviewed its foreign broadcast intercept logs for the entire month of May and could find no record of the alleged radio broadcasts from Prague and Baghdad in mid-May which announced that Senator Kennedy had been shot.

ACTION:

Due to the alleged premature reporting of the shooting of Senator Kennedy it is recommended that the attached letterhead memorandum setting forth the reports of these broadcasts be furnished to the Department of State and that the Department of State be requested to make inquiries of appropriate government officials in Czechoslovakia and Iraq to determine if these broadcasts were made in mid-May and if so, if these governments can provide us the basis on which these radio reports were made. Memorandum should be delivered by liaison.

ASSASSINATION OF SENATOR ROBERT F. KENNEDY

JUNE 5, 1968, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA

My memorandum 6/13/68 advised that Ronald Lee Augustinovich, who is incarcerated in New Jersey and described as mental case, claimed upon interview that he had found anony mous report in 1/68 naming John Birch Society as being behind assassination. Augustinovich further claimed that he gave report to Armando Fleites, anti-Castro leader in Miami, Florida. Memorandum noted that efforts were being made to locate and interview Fleites.

Armando Fleites was located and interviewed in Miami on 6/13/68. He stated he was acquainted with Augustinovich, an American who suddenly appeared at the office of his anti-Castro group in late 1967. Fleites immediately suspected Augustinovich of being a Central Intelligence Agency infiltrator because he acted very strangely. Augustinovich did not speak Spanish and had some difficulty in communicating with Fleites. The only things discussed were possible military activities of the anti-Castro group against Castro.

Fleites stated that Augustinovich never discussed U.S. political personalities with him and never mentioned Senator Robert Kennedy. He stated that Augustinovich's allegation that he furnished the report concerning the assassination plan against Kennedy is completely false. Fleites stated he never saw nor heard of any such document. Felites described Augustinovich as an apparently demented person given to exaggeration and flights of imagination. 62-582-517

Mrs. Arlene Gagnon, Secretary to William Dunfey, on June 14, 1968, substantiated the foregoing information and stated that the unknown woman caller was apparently a young person with a local accent. She did not give any identifying information about herself or the purpose of her call.

On 6/13/68 Attorney DAN EDWARDS, firm of Love, Cole, and Murphy, Colorado Springs, Colorado, advised SA RANSOM A. WHITTLE, Colorado Springs Resident Agency, that he was defending one EDWARD POLE and intended pleading POLE guilty to a forgery charge on that date. He stated POLE had indicated to him that he had information affecting the assassination of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

On 6/14/68 ID Officer TOM BUTLER, Colorado Springs Police Department, advised that EDWARD HUGHEROLE, Colorado Springs Police Department number 20937, had FBI number 554068D, and was incarcerated Lewisburg Penitentiary, Lewisburg Y-33186-NE.

POLE was interviewed by Bureau Agents at El Paso County Jail, Colorado Springs, 6/14/68. POLE at first did not desire to discuss his information in view of fact he claimed it involved La Cosa Nostra and he feared for his life. eventually furnished information stating that around Memorial Day, 1967, during breakfast meal at dining hall, Lewisburg Penitentiary, he was sitting at table next to JAMES HOFFA and overheard HOFFA make statement to his table companions, one described as (FNU) DeJOSEPH, WMA, early 40's, Italian descent, 5'10" tall, heavy build, heavy dark beard even after shaving, and second individual described as name unknown, Italian descent

with same height and build as JAMES HOFFA, 55-58 years of age, and who used to run at the penitentiary track with HOFFA. Conversation overheard was "I have a contract out on KENNEDY and if he ever gets in the primaries or ever gets elected, the contract will be fulfilled within 6 months."

Witnesses to this conversation at POLE's table were JAMES JOSEPH O'BRIEN, transferred from Lewisburg Penitentiary in early June, 1967, to Federal Penitentiary in Atlanta, Georgia; and name unknown, a bank robber who had robbed a bank at Cleveland, Ohio, had been in Lewisburg for 7 years, subsequently paroled, and after 2 years was back at Lewisburg for parole violation. This individual was originally from St. Louis and may currently be on parole to that city. He was described as a white male American, in his early 30's, 5'8" tall, slender build, black hair, and in July, 1967, was assigned to D cellblock.

Two weeks after this conversation, POLE was at clothing store and just prior to store being opened, HOFFA was at the gate of the store, waiting to get in. POLE asked HOFFA how he felt about KENNEDY and HOFFA began a tirade concerning KENNEDY's wire-tapping tactics and on this occasion, allegedly stated to POLE, "Right now KENNEDY's in no danger; but if he gets into a primary or gets elected, I won't say how or when, but he'll get knocked off." POLE stated there were no witnesses to this statement.

A taped recording has been received from captioned individual postmarked 6-10-68 with which Grantham submits no cover letter. It is believed he furnishes his name as Buford Jennings Grantham. the city directory for Asheboro indicates that B. J. Grantham resides at this listed address.

This tape begins with Grantham identifying himself as "a" servant of God, a prophet ordained in 1953," and he states he has prepared this message directed to Sirhan Sirhan, who is currently charged with the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. Grantham expresses his hope that the Los Angeles Police Department sees to it that Sirhan hears this message. First Grantham deplores violence in the land and states that crime is the result of spiritual ignorance. He then propounds at length to convince Sirhan that, according to documentation he takes from the Bible, an Arab is in reality a brother to a Jew. He calls upon Sirhan to repent, then express sorrow for his crime, and confess to the Kennedy family and others as to how FILED he has wronged God. Grantham then states that he "will be called to the United Nations as manifested by me to LBJ" and he will foretell to the United Nations that Russia will be destroyed because of its hating God. Grantham then makes a seemingly unrelated statement that there will be no election in November of this year. He says he previously sent a tape to Robert F. Kennedy so stating and he was now sending another tape to Ted Kennedy to the same effect, urging him "to get out, to get out" at this time. This rambling message then ends by "Your Servant, Buford Jennings(?) Grantham, 500 Peachtree Street, Asheboro, North Carolina."

Bufile 14-2914 reflects Bureau investigation made of B. J. Grantham, Madison, North Carolina, who was disseminating a pamphlet entitled"The Gathering Sickle of the Lord, "to various Army officials.

publication had religious ramblings which were later called to the Department of Justice's attention as being possibly seditious. The Internal Security Division advised on 11-16-56 that further investigation was not desired inasmuch as this matter was not a suitable vehicle for consideration under the Sedition Statutes. Grantham was described as being an employee of Asplundh Tree Expert Company. Associates have quoted him as having said "The U. S. Government was crooked and Russia ought to come over and take over this country and run it like it ought to be run." This Grantham was again distributing questionable material in 1960 from 536 Peachtree Street, Asheboro, North Carolina, at which time Nikita Khrushchev was visiting the United States. In this literature Grantham stated "I would count it a pleasure to destroy him and Castro myself to deliver American people and establish righteousness." Information was disseminated to the State Department on 9-16-60.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the tape be returned to Grantham without cover letter. (Holding in Correspondence and Tours Section)

2. That a card be placed in the Correspondence and Tours Section reflecting correspondent's emotional instability and recommending that future communications from him be considered on their own merits, leaning toward not acknowledging them.


