

### Result of examination:

The conclusion was reached that the majority of the questioned writings on pages fifteen and forty-seven of notebook Ql were not written by SAIDALLAH B. SIRHAN, Kl1; by SHARIF B. SIRHAN, Kl2; or by MUNIR BISHARA SIRHAN, Kl3. While the writings on Kl1 through Kl3 are too limited and not sufficiently comparable for adequate comparison with other questioned writings on the specimens submitted previously in this case, many differences in handwriting characteristics were found.

Due to the limited nature of the writing on K10 and due to a lack of comparable handwriting, the writing of ADEL BISHARA SIRHAN, K10, could not be adequately compared with the questioned writings. Some differences were found in the writing on K10 and the questioned writings.

Specimens Kl0 through Kl3 are being returned to FBI, Los Angeles. These specimens have been photographed.

On 6/13/68, NORMAN JOSEPH KENNEDY, JR., ASN RA 16908591, currently assigned to Co. C, 2nd Bn., Medical Training Center, Fort Sam Houston, Texas, furnished the following information:

In February 1968 while he was in AWOL status, KENNEDY met an individual known as "JIMMY" who he believes is identical to the individual Los Angeles, Calif., authorities are holding for the murder of Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY.

While confined to the stockade at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., as a result of a conviction by court-martial for insubordination, KENNEDY became acquainted with one LEL MOORE. He described MOORE as a Negro male, about 22 years of age, 6'1", 160 lbs., who was also confined to the stockade as a result of two counts of AWOL and two previous escapes from MP's. MOORE was formerly assigned in Vietnam and had been stationed at Fort Leonard Wood with the SPD. MOORE advised KENNEDY that he had contacts in California who would help KENNEDY if KENNEDY went AWOL. MOORE identified his contact in California as "MORRIS" and wrote the address and telephone number on a piece of paper which KENNEDY still has. The address is shown as 1822 W. 4th St., telephone #484-1406. MOORE told KENNEDY that "MORRIS" had helped AWOLs in the past and had a source for phony identification papers.

On 2/11/68, KENNEDY Left Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., in an AWOL status. He purchased a bus ticket at Waynesville, Mo., to Kansas City, Kansas. After he got to Kansas City, he

spent the first night at the Chase Hotel. He hitchhiked from Kansas City to Los Angeles, California, arriving at the Greyhound Bus Station about 12:30 p.m. on 2/16/68. En route to Los Angeles, KENNEDY spent the second night in the jail at Wichita, Kansas; the third night at an unrecalled hotel in El Reno, Okla., and the fourth night he rode all night. On the fifth night he stayed at a truck stop located on Highway 66 near Flagstaff, Arizona.

After he arrived at the Greyhound Bus Station in Los Angeles, he was standing around deciding what to do next when he was approached by an individual who asked where KENNEDY was going. He told this individual he was looking for an address on West 4th St. and showed this individual the piece of paper bearing the Los Angeles address and phone number furnished him by MOORE. This individual then told KENNEDY he knew where this address was and he knew the person that lived there. This individual identified himself as "FRANK," last name unrecalled. He is described as a white male, 6'2' 240 lbs., brown-gray hair, 48-50 years. FRANK told KENNEDY that they should go to his place first and then call "MORRIS." KENNEDY and FRANK went to FRANK's address which KENNEDY described as an apartment located about 15 minutes from the bus station in a split level house which would be the second story from the front but the first story from the back. KENNEDY explained that the house was built into the side of a hill and was believed to be in a northest direction from the station. KENNEDY described FRANK's car as an old model 1956 Chevrolet sedan with California license.

After arriving at FRANK's apartment, FRANK made a telephone call to "MORRIS" but "MORRIS" was busy that day and could not meet with FRANK and KENNEDY. KENNEDY did not notice the number FRANK called but he noted that the phone number was written in the back of FRANK's telephone book. KENNEDY stayed at FRANK's apartment that night and the next day FRANK called "MORRIS" again. This time "MORRIS" said he was busy and would not be able to see them and for them to FRANK called "MORRIS" that afternoon and "MORRIS" call later. told them he would see them. FRANK then drove KENNEDY over to the MORRIS apartment about 2:00 p.m. KENNEDY identified this address as the same one on the piece of paper given him by MOORE, 1822 W. 4th St. When KENNEDY and FRANK arrived at the MORRIS apartment, it was noted that "MORRIS" had two guests so KENNEDY and FRANK had to wait about 45 minutes.

described one guest as a white female, 24 years of age, dyed blonde hair, 5'6" or 7", medium build, who was described as an opera singer. This individual was sitting at the piano at MORRIS' apartment, playing and singing. The other guest who KENNEDY identified as "FRENCHY" was described as a white male, 24 years, black hair, 5'11", 145 lbs., and lives in an apartment cater-corner from Echo Park.

MORRIS told these guests that he had business to take care of and the guests and FRANK then left the MORRIS apartment. KENNEDY sat at the table with MORRIS and MORRIS asked him why he went AWOL. KENNEDY had been told before by FRANK that MORRIS was opposed to the war in Vietnam and the U.S. Government. KENNEDY told MORRIS that he did not believe in the Vietnam war and that he thought it was senseless. MORRIS said he agreed and asked KENNEDY what he wanted to do. KENNEDY told MORRIS that he wanted to stay away as long as he could. MORRIS then told KENNEDY that he could obtain some phony ID papers and obtain employment for KENNEDY and that as long as KENNEDY did not get into trouble with the law he would be safe.

MORRIS has an apartment and two rooms that he rents to other people at the 4th St. address. MORRIS told KENNEDY he could stay at that apartment while he was waiting for his phony ID papers. At this point, KENNEDY decided to become friendly with MORRIS and MORRIS told KENNEDY that most of his time was devoted to the Peace and Freedom Party movement and demonstrations. KENNEDY noted that there were quite a few pamphlets and leaflets in MORRIS' apartment which were all considered anti-Dow Committee and anti-war in Vietnam. KENNEDY helped MORRIS by doing some typing and office work there at the apartment. While KENNEDY was there, MORRIS had various visitors who were representatives of the Communist Party, the "Minutemen," and other unrecalled groups. Most of these meetings involved discussions concerning planned demonstrations by the various groups and whether or not the Peace and Freedom Party would join the demonstrations and just how much support that organization would furnish the other organizations.

During these discussions they frequently referred to the phrase, "this summer when the revolution is going to break out," the details of which were unknown to KENNEDY.

About 2/19/68, there was a meeting held at the Echo Park School. MORRIS talked KENNEDY into going with him. This meeting was about the anti-Dow Committee and those in attendance were members of the various groups who had visited at the MORRIS apartment. At this meeting KENNEDY met SHAWN (ph), a member of the CP. KENNEDY described SHAWN as a white male, age 36, 6'2", 220 lbs., blond hair, and wore a mustache. SHAWN frequently offered new ideas and it appeared that everyone at the meeting looked up to SHAWN for guidance. Also discussed at this meeting was a boycott of the Dow products to be held for a period of one week beginning 4/2/68 to 4/28/68. The reason for the boycott was that Dow produces the napalm bombs which are used in Vietnam.

KENNEDY also attended several other similar meetings at different places which he is unable to identify. Sometimes these meetings were held in homes and other times in offices of one of these groups.

About a week andahalf or two weeks after the 2/19/68, meeting, MORRIS asked KENNEDY for an opinion as to whether or not he, KENNEDY, would support a demonstration. About this time MORRIS told KENNEDY that they were going to attend a \_ meeting which KENNEDY would find more interesting than the This meeting was held in an apartment near Echo Park There were only about 12 people present who included MORRIS, the secretary of the Peace and Freedom Party, SHAWN, two Mexicans that KENNEDY had never met, "JIMMY," the individual KENNEDY believes who is now held by Los Angeles authorities for the murder of Senator KENNEDY, and two or three other men KENNEDY is unable to describe. There was also a white female at this meeting, whose name KENNEDY does not know, who was about 23 years of age, about 5'6", 110 lbs. The discussion at this meeting concerned the revolution that was to come this summer. The people talked about preparations that were to be made, and SHAWN said there were certain people that the were going to be taken out of the picture. He mentioned four names, which included MARTIN LUTHER KING, Senator ROBERT F. KENNEDY,

their Attorney General for the State of California, name unknown, and a Senator from Missouri, name unknown. Someone asked why these people had to be taken out of the picture and SHAWN replied it was mostly because too many people looked up to these leaders and that their beliefs are different. These individuals were also blamed for their support of the Vietnam war.

The next morning KENNEDY telephoned his mother in Wisconsin and she said she was sick and wanted him to come home. He asked his mother to send him some money and about 3/1/68, she wired him money to come home, c/o Western Union, Los Angeles.

Shortly after KENNEDY had called his mother, MORRIS took him to an area which appeared to have been formerly an upper middle class section but was now rundown and located somewhere between Los Angeles and Orange, Calif. It was a residential district with houses sparsely scattered. drove to this house in MORRIS' light blue 1963 sedan, make unknown, automobile. After they arrived at the house, KENNEDY accompanied MORRIS to the front door and after MORRIS knocked on the door it was answered by a white male, age 48, dark brown hair, graying, partially bald in the front. individual recognized MORRIS immediately and MORRIS told him he wanted to show KENNEDY the basement. MORRIS then took KENNEDY to the basement of the house which KENNEDY described as a huge basement containing several rooms. opened the door to one of these rooms and he and KENNEDY went inside and there were about 1,000 rifles, as estimated by KENNEDY, some still in their crates and some standing in racks. KENNEDY recognized some of the rifles as being Model M-1 and some being Russian 101. KENNEDY recognized the Russian model from previous pictures he had seen and displays by the Armed KENNEDY asked MORRIS the purpose of Forces and museums. these weapons and MORRIS told him they were for the revolution. MORRIS asked KENNEDY if he recalled RAP BROWN making the statement, "It is time to go to the roofs." MORRIS said the is what BROWN meant. MORRIS volunteered information to KENNEDY that there were 35 places like this in the Los Angeles area and that the entire country is filled with places like this.

KENNEDY and MORRIS then returned to the MORRIS apartment. MORRIS told KENNEDY that "they" needed people like KENNEDY and needed more of them. MORRIS knew that KENNEDY had received money from his mother and that he was leaving to go home. KENNEDY left Los Angeles about 3/1/68, and when he arrived home in Wisconsin he told his mother the above events. KENNEDY stayed home about two or three days and then his mother drove him to Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., where he turned himself in as AWOL on 3/4/68.

KENNEDY stated that in view of what had happened to Senator KENNEDY, he had recognized the photograph of Senator KENNEDY's assassin in the paper and felt the above information should be brought to the attention of the proper authorities. He thereafter recited the above facts to the chaplain, his Sergeant, his Commanding Officer, and the Military Intelligence at Fort Sam Houston, Texas.

KENNEDY stated the only time he met "JIMMY" was at the meeting described above. He described "JIMMY" as follows: white male, dark complexion, brown and very long hair, 5'10-11", 150 lbs., dressed in dark green shirt, brown pants, wide black belt and black boots. He gained the impression at the above meeting that "JIMMY" had come to the meeting with the two Mexicans and he could furnish no more details about "JIMMY."

if he ever saw them again and throughout the interview maintained the above information was the truth.



The airmail envelope is addressed to Senator R. Kennedy and Senator Eugene McCarthy, Democratic National Headquarters, Eugene, Oregon.

It bears the postmark of West Palm Beach, Florida, dated May 29, 1968.

A line of French prose or poetry is pasted to the envelope in lieu of a return address. It reads:

A blase bird, if such a bird exists.

The printed message contained in the envelope is a portion of a page taken from a textbook edition of Julius Caesar's "Commentarii de Bello Gallico." The portion marked "K" describes a battle in which the Gauls discarded their shields and fought "with their naked bodies."

The portion marked "M" contains descriptions of war actions against the Helvetii.

### TRANSLATION FROM LATIN

Post card with airmail postage and an airmail notation addressed to Senator R. Kennedy, Democratic Headquarters, Eugene, Oregon.

The post card bears the postmark of West Palm Beach, Florida, dated May 21, 1968, A.M.

The message on the reverse side of the post card consists of two verses in Latin. They read:

I sing (celebrate) because of the compromise to be made on the swift vessel.

I was only reading the remaining part little by little.

The notation:

"(imperio) by command"

appears at the bottom of the post card.

TRANSLATOR'S NOTE:

The communication is anonymous. The verses appear to be taken from a Latin writing of the classical period, possibly Ovid. It is recalled that correspondence of a similar nature, consisting of verses taken from the classics was handled in the past. This correspondence, consisted for the most part of two or three Latin verses without any explanation.



The conclusion was reached that SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN, whose writings and whose purported writings appear on specimens Kl through K3, K8, K9, K14, and K16, wrote the hand printed address in the lower portion of page one of Q1; the hand printed address and names "SIRHAN SIRHAN" in the upper portion of page 32 of specimen Q1; and the English writing on the front of specimen Q5-F.

The available writing of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN is too limited and not sufficiently comparable with the remaining questioned handwriting on the specimens previously submitted in this matter, for the purpose of determining whether SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN wrote any of the remaining questioned handwriting. Similarities in handwriting characteristics were found in the writings of SIRHAN BISHARA SIRHAN and a number of the remaining questioned writings, including certain questioned writings on pages 20, 35, 39, 47, 51, and 53, of specimen Q1; pages 123 and 124 of specimen Q3, and the writing on Q4.

The signatures appearing on K15 are too limited to permit adequate comparison of these signatures with the questioned writings.

Specimens Kl4 is being returned to FBI, San Francisco. Specimens Kl5 and Kl6 are being returned to FBI, Los Angeles. These specimens have been photographed. The pamphlet described as "ALSO SUBMITTED" is being retained.

NOTE: For San Francisco and Los Angeles

This confirms Bureau teletype 6/17/68, addressed to Los Angeles.

If future testimony of the FBI Laboratory expert is needed, it will be necessary to utilize as a minimum number of known handwriting standards, the writings on Kl through K3, K9, K14 and K16. The Los Angeles Office should appropriately advise the District Attorney, Los Angeles, that these specimens must be

Through liaison, CIA is being advised that in the future when it has information it desires to direct to other agencies, it should do so by direct communication and not through FBI facilities.

Dear Mr. Hoover;

You more than deserve the honor given to you as "Man of the Century", and I want to send you my congradulations for your continued faithfulness to duty to protect our nation, in these times of great deception. You have been a promoter of truth and seek it as a way of life, that justice might live with us. I know that you are a modest man and I will say no more. More than this honor, it is a great comfort to me to be able to trust you and know that you are a Christian, and it is these qualities that give you the honor of being "Man of the Century".

I think that all good American citizens must do all they can to aid the work that you are trying to do, that our Nation might be a safer place for our leaders and all men. So any hint of help that I feel that might be considered, I feel it might duty to contribute to what might become part of the truth or a factor to the finding of a truth.

Almost daily I take lunch at Bard's Restaurant and about May 29th, at a back table were two young men, one of whom I believe was Sirhan. He was small, fine featured, olive skin with the bushyforelocks. I had seen him before several times in the last few years. I was told that he was from Jerusalem. He was always in the company of this same friend. I know nothing more about him, but that the picture in the paper of sirhan was very striking to the person that I have seen here in Little Rock. Please trace this and find if he had stayed in this city at various times, as much as two years ago.

I feel that there are Communists that work through such groups of young boys, beginning in such camps as the Kiwanus clubs for boys and they concentrate on underprivated ged youth. When I observed the young man that looked like sirhan, I placed him in my mind as might being a representation of this group.

I read that Sirhan asked for two books on the mystic and this is often followed by the Eastern mind. I think he will read and later practice it, for he is seemlingly of such nature and temperment. I think he will use this as a means of eventual escape, and although it seems far fetched to the western mind, he might attempt and succeed at it. For an extemple, under self-hymotism, he could feign death and lower his heart beat and pulse and even be legally thought as dead.

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And throught this means with outside friends make a disappearance with their help, between the declaration of death and the processes of pre-burial. There is a fad of three that are experimenting with this underground life and this might give those desiring escape a plausible idea. I think that Sirhan would be the type to try it, for this would have appeal to his nature. If he would succeed in such a thing, in later years, he could become a mystical leader among the Arab cults. I do not believe that he will ever be brought to final justice for the slaying of Kennedy. I think that Satan is going to have him serve his purposes in these last times. I do not feel that he was along in this act, but was carefully instructed and encouraged and it was invitableto have happened.

One of the best protective measures for all candidates to take is to have at their appearances a ready doctor, nurse and fully equipaddvan, bus or ambulance, with a clear path to it, for any physical mishap and for immediate care and professional attention. Timeis always a major factor and it might save someone, for having such convenience.

The Lord gives to those that love Him, eyes and ears to see and hear through the gifts of the Holy Spirit, that the physical cannot see and hear.

The Bible is the living word and speaks readily to the heart of those that seek to be taught, informed and comforted intthe ways of truth. Before Robert Kennedy expired from this world, I turned to Lamentations under the direction of the Holy Spirit and read Chapter five of this book. It holds much direct truth that relate to our countryls reproach. is a famine of this country for the lack of teaching and hearing the bread of life in God(s written truth. Verses 3,4,5,6,7,,8 9,12,13,15,16,17. V. 21. Turn thou us unto thee, U Lord, and we shall be turned; renew our days as of old.

For you and your faithful men of the Bureau I send Isaiah 54:17, as a verse of faith. No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord.
