INTRODUCTION: APPARENTLY THIS COLLISION OCCURRED AS DRIVER "A" WAS SOUTHBOUND ON HILL AVE. ATTEMPTING TO EVADE ARREST. HE APPARENTLY LOST CONTROL OF THE VEHICLE AND STRUCK THE CURB AND TREE ON THE EASTSIDE (WRONG SIDE) OF THE STREET.

PHYSICAL EVIDENCE: SEE PHOTOS 39 AND 41 TAKEN BY INV. L.A. REYNOLDS.
SEE ATTACHED SKETCH.

STATEMENTS: DRIVER "A" UNCONSCIOUS AT THIS TIME.

WITNESS #1. COMBS CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICER BADGE 3022
LA CANADA C.H.P. STATION, SY.0-6231. DRIVING UNIT 8110.

"AT 01:15 HRS. I WAS W/B ON WASHINGTON BL. WHEN I OBSERVED A 60 FORD CONV. INTENDING TO MAKE A LEFT TURN TO GO N/B ON WESLEY. HE HAD HIS HIGH BEAMS ON & FAILED TO DIM THEM WHEN I REQUESTED HIM TO DO SO BY BLINKING THOSE ON THE PATROL VEH. SUB. THEN TURNED N. ON WESLEY AND I SWUNG A "U" ON WASHINGTON AND WENT N/B ON WESLEY BEHIND THE SUB. VEH. I TURNED ON MY RED LIGHT AND THE SUB. REFUSED TO STOP. HE BEGAN DRIVING IN AN ERRATIC MANNER AS IF HE WAS NOT CO-ORDINATED. I BLEW MY HORN AND MY PARTNER TURNED THE WHITE SPOT INTO THE SUB. REAR WINDOW. SUB. THEN MADE A L/H TURN ON HOWARD TO GO W/B AT APPROX. 50 M.P.H. ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE ROADWAY, THROUGH A BLVD. STOP SIGN ON HILL. S/B ON THE LATTER WHERE HE LOST CONTROL AND STRUCK THE CURB AND A TREE RESPECTIVELY ON THE E/SIDE OF HILL. SUB WAS RENDERED UNCONSCIOUS AND HIS PUPILS WOULD NOT REACT TO LIGHT.

WITNESS #2 JENSEN C.H.P. OFFICER BADGE 2984
RELATED THE SAME SET OF CIRCUMSTANCES AS DID HIS PARTNER COMBS.

CONCLUSION: APPARENTLY THIS COLLISION OCCURRED AS DRIVER "A" LOST CONTROL OF HIS VEHICLE WHILE TURNING LEFT FROM HOWARD ST. TO HILL AVE. AT AN UNSAFE SPEED AND CRASHED INTO THE CURB AND JUMPED SAME AND STRUCK A TREE IN THE PARKWAY. WAS APPARENTLY ATTEMPTING TO EVADE APPREHENSION BY THE C.H.P. OFFICERS WHO WERE IN DIRECT PURSUIT.

HAVING TURNED LEFT ON HOWARD TO SOUTHBOUND ON HILL IT APPEARED THE VEHICLE CONTINUED IN THE LEFT TURN ARC WITHOUT EVER COMING OUT OF THE TURN AND JUMPED THE CURB ON THE EASTSIDE AND STRUCK A TREE. THE WINDSHIELD OF THE VEHICLE WAS SMASHED DIRECTLY IN THE MIDDLE FROM THE INSIDE APPARENTLY BY SIRHAN'S HEAD. IT APPEARED THAT HE APPARENTLY SLID OUT FROM BEHIND THE WHEEL IN THE LEFT TURNING MOVEMENT AT AN UNSAFE SPEED.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

REQUEST THAT THE JUVENILE BUREAU ARRANGE FOR AN APPEARANCE DATE IN THE JUVENILE TRAFFIC COURT AT A LATER DATE. NO CITATION WAS ISSUED AT THE SCENE DUE TO THE CONDITION OF THE DRIVER. FURTHER ACTION PENDING FOLLOW-UP CONTACT WITH DRIVER "A" SIRHAN, BY TRAFFIC INVESTIGATOR.

THE COMPLAINT AGAINST [REDACTED] SHOULD CHARGE HIM WITH:

- V.C. 22350 AND 22351 & UNSAFE SPEED 50 M.P.H. IN A 25 M.P.H. ZONE.
- V.C. 14601A DRIVING ON A SUSPENDED PERMIT.
- V.C. 22450A FAILURE TO STOP AT BLVD. STOP SIGN.
- V.C. 21650 FAILURE TO DRIVE ON RIGHT HALF OF ROADWAY.
- V.C. 21407A HIGH BEAMS

FURTHER INVESTIGATION: CONTACTED THE VICTIM'S MOTHER FROM THE ST. LUKES HOSPITAL, PASADENA. SHE CAME TO THE HOSPITAL ALONG WITH HER DAUGHTER AIDA.

MOTHER: MARY SIRHAN F, W, 50 SAME ADDRESS AS SON.

TALKED WITH MRS. SIRHAN AT THE HOSPITAL. SHE STATED THAT HER SON HAD GONE TO BED ABOUT 11:00 P.M., AND SHE HAD NO IDEA THAT HE HAD LEFT THE HOUSE. SHE FURTHER STATED THAT HE HAD HIS DRIVING PERMIT SUSPENDED BY JUVENILE COURT TRAFFIC DIV. AND SHE HAD THE PERMIT IN HER PURSE. THE BACK OF THE PERMIT WAS STAMPED AND THE SUSPENSION WAS FOR THE PERIOD OF 10/25/63 TO 11/24/63, AND INITIALED J.C.B.

AIDA SIRHAN STATED SHE HAD THE KEYS TO HER BROTHER'S VEHICLE IN HER POCKET IN A DRESS AND SHE HAD ADVISED MUNIR THAT SHOULD HIS BROTHER SAIDALLAH COME TO THE HOUSE FOR THE CAR, THAT MUNIR WAS TO GIVE HIM THE KEYS. 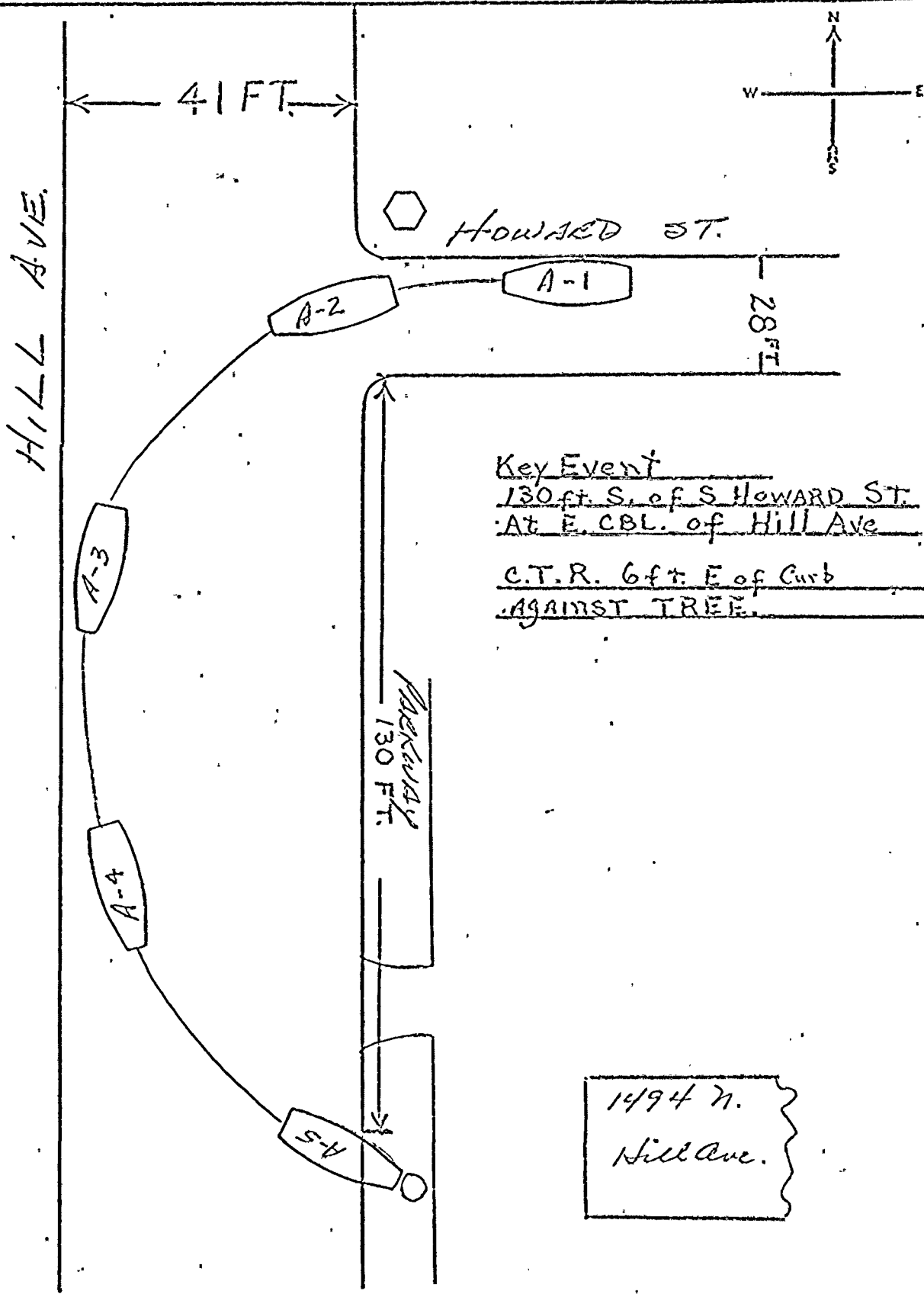

WHEN HE RETURNED TO SOMERS HOUSE TO PICK UP HIS BOOK, HE SAW THE PHOTO'S AND REMOVED THEM AT THE SAME TIME. THAT HE AND [REDACTED] HAD TRIED TO RE-PRODUCE THEM, RUN OUT OF CHEMICALS, AND HAD TAKEN HIS BROTHERS CAR WITH-OUT PERMISSION TO GO TO A DRUG STORE FOR MORE CHEMICALS. WHILE DOING SO HE HAD THE ACCIDENT (CASE# 390461).

WE QUESTIONED [REDACTED] AS TO HOW HE HAD OBTAINED THE PHOTOGRAPHS, HE STATED THAT SOME TIME BACK A FRIEND OF HIS WAS BURGLARIZING CARS, HE HAD GIVEN THE PHOTOGRAPHS TO [REDACTED] WHEN IT APPEARED THAT HE WAS GOING TO BE CAUGHT. [REDACTED] AT FIRST REFUSED TO IDENTIFY THIS "FRIEND", BUT LATER SAID IT WAS FRANK SALAS, WHO HE BELIEVES IS PRESENTLY IN CUSTODY IN SOME JUVENILE DETENTION LOCATION. THE ABOVE CONVERSATION TOOK PLACE IN THE PRESENCE OF [REDACTED] MOTHER. IT WAS APPARENT TO THESE OFFICERS THAT SOMERS VERSION WAS NOT TRUE, BUT IN HIS MOTHERS PRESENCE HE WAS RELUCTANT TO TALK AT LENGTH.

IT WAS LEARNED TODAY THAT [REDACTED] WAS BEATEN BY [REDACTED] AT 10:30PM ON 11-12-63 PRESUMABLY AS A RESULT OF THE AFORE MENTIONED EVENTS. THIS INCIDENT WAS NOT REPORTED FORMALLY TO THE POLICE BY THE VICTIM, BUT BY [REDACTED] SISTER.

SO FAR AS THIS OFFICE CAN DETERMINE THIS INCIDENT INVOLVES ONLY JUVENILES AS MENTIONED IN THE REPORT, THEREFORE THE MATTER IS REFERRED TO JUVENILE BUREAU FOR ADDITIONAL FOLLOW-UP. IT WOULD BE VICE BUREAU'S RECOMMENDATION THAT ALL SUSPECTS LISTED BE CITED TO THE JUVENILE BUREAU TO RESOLVE THE MATTERS OF POSSIBLE STOLEN BICYCLES, THEFT OR BURGLARY OF THE CIGARETTES, REPRODUCING AND DISPLAYING LEWD PHOTOGRAPHS, AND THE ALLEGED BEATING OF [REDACTED]

Upon my arrival at the above location I contacted GREEN, and she related the following: At approx. 12:10 PM this date GREEN was standing in front of her home, when she heard the sound of breaking glass. GREEN then observed [REDACTED] standing on the sidewalk in front of 1250 N. Sierra Bonita. Upon investigating GREEN found [REDACTED] in the house at that location.

I contacted [REDACTED] who stated that he, and ROACH were on their way to school when [REDACTED] wanted to go into the "Haunted house". [REDACTED] stated that he did not want to go with [REDACTED] so he waited for him on the sidewalk.

I contacted [REDACTED] who stated that "All the kids at school told him the house was haunted, and that no-one lived there". [REDACTED] stated that he found an open window, and climbed in. As he entered the building his foot struck a panel of glass in a cokecase door/breaking it.

I again contacted GREEN, and she stated that it is very common for children to enter the building.

At this time I had [REDACTED] return to school, and I accompanied [REDACTED] home. I contacted MC REYNOLDS who is [REDACTED] grandmother, and I advised her of the incident. MC REYNOLDS stated that she would see that [REDACTED] did not enter the house again, and that she would take the necessary disciplinary action.

It is my opinion that this building should be inspected by the Building Department, and the Fire Department, as there are several open windows that juveniles could climb in.

It is also my opinion that no follow-up action need be taken towards [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] due to their co-operative attitude, and the attitude of MC REYNOLDS.
